

PM announces repeal of all three farm laws; Appeals to protesting farmers to call off agitation

New Delhi, Nov. 19

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said that the Government has decided to repeal all three farm laws. Addressing the Nation this morning, Shri Modi announced that the laws will be repealed in the upcoming Winter Session of Parliament. He said, the three laws were for farmers' benefit but the Government couldn't convince a section of farmers despite best efforts.

The Prime Minister



said, the goal of three farm laws was to empower farmers, especially the small farmers. He appealed to protesting farmers to call

to our success.

Shri Scindia said that the Government does not work in silos, and the Whole-of-the-Government approach has helped the Ministry tackle the Covid-19 effectively, and convert the crisis into an opportunity. The domestic

aviation sector suffered a lot during the period. The Government set up 9 advisory groups, covering a wide array of sub-sectors like Airlines, Airports, MROs, Flying Training Schools, cargoes, Ground handlers, Aircraft manufacturing, and their meetings have been yielding good results.

Directorate of CS& CA to provide free LPG connections to low-income families under PMUY

Women belonging to economically weaker family urged to apply for new connection

Port Blair, Nov.19

The Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) is an ambitious scheme providing LPG connection to women belonging to economically weaker section. The main beneficiaries of the scheme are women belonging to poor families not having LPG connections in their household. The majority of the rural population and families belonging to this section are still using fossil fuel

to cook their meals. The usage of fossil fuel results in serious health hazards for women of such families.

In the first phase, the Govt. of India covered a population of 8 crore households till 1st May, 2016. To cover the remaining households eligible under the scheme, the Govt. of India in the Union Budget for 2021-22 kept the provision for an additional coverage of

Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) is one of the Flagship Schemes of the Govt. of India. The scheme is being implemented in these Islands since 2016. The scheme envisages providing insurance coverage to the farmers for crop loss arising out of natural calamities. The PMFBY supports sustainable income in Agriculture sector by

providing financial support to the farmers who suffer crop-loss due to unforeseen events. The scheme ensures flow of credit to the agriculture sector and stabilizes the income of the farmers.

The PMFBY has been presently notified for implementation throughout A&N Islands for Rabi season 2021-22. Under the scheme, pulses & vegetables crop is

presently notified for insurance.

Maximum scale of finance fixed for Pulses is Rs. 48,150 per Ha. (for Green & Black Gram) and for Vegetables viz. Bhindi (Rs. 1,15,900 per Ha.), Lobia (Rs. 99,157 per Ha.), Tomato (Rs. 1,46,820 per Ha.), Brinjal (Rs.1,23,850 per Ha.), Watermelon (Rs.94,350 per Ha.) & Cauliflower

Subsidy for construction / procurement of deep sea fishing vessels under PMMSY

Fisheries Deptt. urges interested beneficiaries to approach nearest Zonal Fisheries Office

Port Blair, Nov. 19

The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Fisheries, Govt. of India has communicated Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), modalities of implementation and approved three types of standardized designs for construction / procurement of deep sea fishing vessels

developed by the Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL) under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY).

Under this scheme, Govt. of India is providing subsidy assistance @ 40% for General category and 60% for Women and ST category with maximum ceiling of unit cost Rs. 120 lakhs. The implementation of the scheme is through

respective District Level Committees (DLC) of South Andaman, North and Middle Andaman and Nicobar District.

The approved models for construction / procurement of deep sea fishing vessels are C-BOSS 40:40m3 fish holding capacity of unit cost Rs. 120 lakhs; C-BOSS 70:70 m3 fish holding capacity of unit

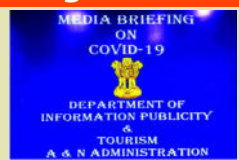

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Trinket cattle, A Danish colonial leftover

Trinket cattle is an endangered cattle breed of Trinket Island, one of the picturesque islands of Andaman. These cattle are thought to be of Danish leftover during their dynasty in Nicobar archipelago. Early historical documents suggest that Nicobar Island was the capital of Danish colony from 1756-1768. During their initial span of colonization, they introduced some cattle for milk purpose and it was a myth that the cattle were of European origin. After series of episodes of colonization in Nicobar Island by Austrians, British, Danish and Japanese dynasty when the island was finally handed over to the indigenes (Nicobarese), the so-called Trinket Cattle became semi feral in nature due to food habit of the tribe. The island was left abandoned by the aboriginal tribe after Great Sumatra earthquake and Indian ocean Tsunami since 26th day of December 2004. Therefore, the herd of cattle became totally feral in nature. In a recent survey, it has been found that around 150 of the descendants of the cattle are present in the Trinket Island. The cattle are of medium sized, horned, strong and not docile /wild nature in nature. The colour of the animals varies from white, black and brown. The average adult body weight of the cattle ranges from 250-400 kg. Molecular signature of the cattle indicated that Trinket cattle belong to Bosindicus (I) or zebu type cattle. Immediate conservation efforts are very much needed to save these endangered cattle from extinction. Benefit: These cattle are very much adapted to the local microenvironment of Nicobar. of the flights. He thanked a number of them who have drastically cut the rates, saying that they have gained larger air traffic movement within a short period of the reduction. He said that the sector has large cost-benefit ratio and also huge employment potential. Shri Scindia also called upon them to facilitate new airports by swiftly handling the land allotment issues. He said that the Ministry will be doubling the Airports and taking the number to 200 plus by the year 2023-24. The Minister emphasised on setting up at least one heliport in each district in collaboration with States/UTs. On the issue of seaplanes, the Minister said that the States should provide Capital support for this initiative.

On the issue of drones, Shri Scindia said that it is Prime Minister's vision to have a leadership role for the country in the sector, and rules have been framed for promoting it. Production Linked Initiative in the sector will provide further push. Similarly, new initiatives have been taken in the sectors of MRO, Flying Training Organizations, Last Mile Connectivity, Cargo handling, Krishi Udaan, so that the bottlenecks are removed, and the sector gains the growth and pre-eminence.

Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment, Dr Virendra Kumar and Minister of State for Civil Aviation Gen (Dr) V K Singh (Retd) also addressed the inaugural session. Various State Ministers and senior functionaries participated in the discussions on the sector, and deliberated on the issues threadbare. Secretary, Civil Aviation, Shri Rajiv Bansal and senior officials of Ministry of Civil Aviation and states and UTs were among those present on the occasion.

one Crore eligible households under the PMUY scheme which will be implemented in a time bound manner by IOCL in co-ordination with their authorized LPG distributors in this UT. The Ujjwala 2.0 aims to provide deposit-free LPG connections to those low-income families who could not be covered under the earlier phase of PMUY.

Along with a deposit free LPG connection, Ujjwala 2.0 will provide first refill and Hotplate free of cost to the eligible beneficiaries. Also, the enrolment procedure will require minimum paperwork. In Ujjwala 2.0 migrants will not be required to submit ration cards or address proof. A self declaration for both 'family declaration' and as a 'proof of address' will suffice.

In this regard, it is requested to all those women belonging to economically weaker family and not owning LPG connection, to apply to the LPG distributor for a new connection. (Rs.2,15,350 per Ha.). Total sum that can be insured against possible losses is arrived at by multiplying the scale of finance with the area covered.

As per the guidelines of PMFBY, 1.5% for Pulses & 5% for vegetables of the sum insured is to be paid by the farmers as insurance premium for availing subsidy under the scheme. However, in case of Andaman & Nicobar, farmers need to pay only 0.5% of the sum insured while the remaining amount is additionally borne as subsidy.

PMFBY covers risks of losses arising from either of the possibilities of prevented sowing, sowing to harvesting (due to drought, dry spell, flood, inundation, pest, diseases, landslide, natural fire, lightening, storm, hailstorm, cyclone etc.), post-harvest losses up to two weeks after harvesting. It also compensates the farmers against localized calamities affecting isolated farms in notified area/single peril risk. Less than expected average yield due to mid-season adversity viz. floods, prolonged dry spells and severe drought etc. is also compensated for under PMFBY.

The enrolment under the scheme is voluntary. All farmers including tenant farmers are eligible for coverage. The cutoff date for the enrolment under the scheme for Rabi 2021-22 is 15/01/2022. The farmers have to approach the SBI or Co-operative Bank of the concerned areas alongwith land records and enroll under the scheme.

After enrolment, any losses to the crop arising out of risks covered in the PMFBY need to be mandatorily reported within 24 hours to the Insurance Company (National Insurance Company) directly or through Department of Agriculture or Department of Revenue.

Over 115 crore 23 lakh doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered in the country so far

New Delhi, Nov. 19

More than 115 crore 23 lakh COVID-19 vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, over 72 lakh 94 thousand doses were administered yesterday. India reported over 11 thousand new cases during the last 24 hours. India's Active caseload stands at one lakh 26 thousand 620. Active cases account for less than one per cent of total cases and it is currently at 0.37 per cent, the lowest since March last year. The Ministry said, the recovery rate is currently at 98.28 per cent and it is highest since March last year. Over 12 thousand people recovered in the last 24 hours and total recoveries touched three crore 38 lakh 97 thousand 921. (Source:india.gov.in)

cost Rs.135 lakhs with refrigeration facilities; C-BOSS 70:70 m3 fish holding capacity with unit cost of Rs.150 lakhs.

The Government assistance will be limited for the unit cost of Rs. 120 lakh as per the prevailing Operational Guidelines of PMMSY irrespective of the aforesaid models.


The detailed drawing and designs for above mentioned models are available with various Offices of Department of Fisheries. The beneficiary has to construct the deep sea fishing vessels from any fishing vessel building yard empanelled by Andaman and Nicobar Administration and the empanelled yards should use any of the three standardized designs for building the deep sea fishing vessels. The Andaman and Nicobar Administration is in the process of floating Expression of Interest for empanelling the boat building yards and the list of building yards will be communicated after finalizing the qualifying yards.

Further, it is to inform that the beneficiary has to follow the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Procurement of Deep-Sea Fishing Vessels issued by Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways vide OM. dated 08.02.2021 and circulated vide this Department's letter of even No. dated 31.3.2021 and may adopt the framework/models for implementation of the scheme as issued by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways vide its O.M. dated 18th May, 2021 for procurement of the vessel. The documents are available with the Directorate of Fisheries, Zonal Fisheries Offices and all Sub Stations of the Department of Fisheries.

All the interested beneficiaries have been requested to approach nearest Zonal Fisheries Office / Fisheries Sub Stations for further details about the drawing and designs, SOP and application form to avail subsidy under PMMSY for procurement of deep sea fishing vessel. 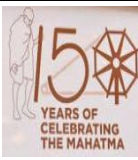

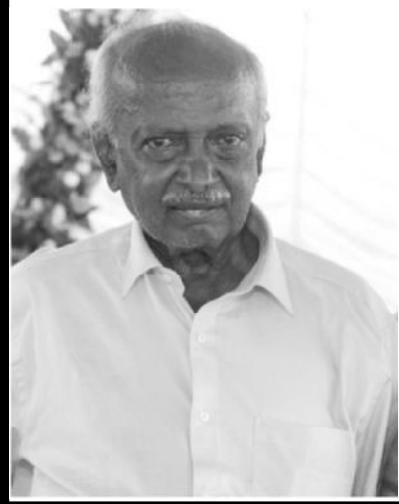

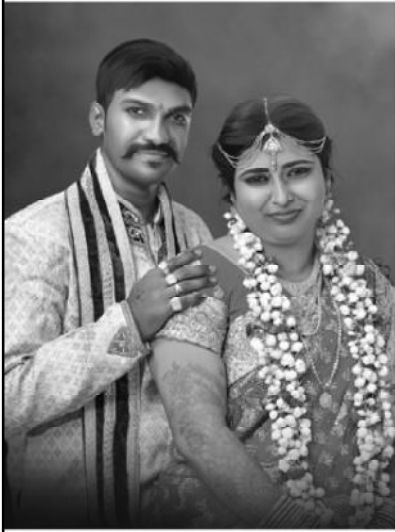
