

Centre shuts down MDMA formed to probe Rajiv Gandhi assassination case

Port Blair, Oct. 18: The Central government has closed the Multi-Disciplinary Monitoring Agency (MDMA) which was constituted about 24 years ago to investigate the larger conspiracy behind the assassination of former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi. The order to disband the MDMA, which was functioning as part of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), was issued in May.ln 1998, the MDMA was established for a period of two years on the M.C. Jain Commission's recommendation to probe the wider conspiracy behind the assassination by a LTTE suicide bomber at a rally in Tamil Nadu's Sriperumbudur on May 21, 1991. New Delhi, Oct 18: As 9,500 Congress delegates across the country voted on October 17 to choose between Mallikarjun Kharge and Shashi Tharoor as their next party chief, outgoing Congress president Sonia Gandhi said she had been "waiting" for this day for a long time. For the first time in the past 24 years, no member of the Gandhi family is a candidate for the Congress party's top post. While Mr. Tharoor pitched himself as the candidate for change, Mr. Kharge is being seen as the "establishment" candidate for his proximity to the Gandhi family. Voice of reason

Bombay high court has sent a strong message on the sanctity of due process and procedural safeguards by acquitting ex-Delhi University professor GN Saibaba and five others given life terms on charges of membership of the banned CPI(Maoist) and "aiding" and 'abetting' its activities. The wheelchair-bound Saibaba was jailed in 2014 and convicted in 2017. Section 45 of UAPA has two key safeguards to prevent wrongful implication of innocents by the police. Both, Bombay HC noted, were

UAPA judges must await prosecution sanction before taking cognisance of chargesheets. This prosecution sanction, in turn, must be considered and granted by government only after an independent authority conducts a "review of the evidence gathered in the course of investigation and makes a recommendation". But the trial court framed charges against Saibaba before prosecution sanction arrived. The Director of Prosecution reviewing the chargesheet recommended prosecuting the accused without giving any reasoning. HC wondered how a few "laconic" sentences helped the prosecution sanctioning authority make informed decisions. The conviction was struck down, citing a constitution bench ruling that a trial proceeding without valid sanction would stand vitiated.

The judges exhorted the state to fight terrorism with "unwavering resolve" but said the rule of law must tower over loud refrains that "the end justifies the means, and that the procedural safeguards are subservient to the overwhelming need to ensure that the accused is prosecuted and punished". They signed off by warning that "empirical evidence suggests departures from the due process of law foster an ecosystem in which terrorism burgeons and provides fodder to vested interests whose singular agenda is to propagate false narratives." Karim Benzema won the men's Ballon d'Or for the first time after a brilliant season with Real Madrid capped by the Champions League and Spanish league titles.

on Monday won the women's trophy for the second straight year following another standout season with Barcelona.

Benzema had his best season ever at Madrid, being the top scorer in both leagues. He scored 44 times for Madrid, including 15 in Europe's top competition, and equaled Ral Gonzlez as the club's secondhighest scorer behind Cristiano

Benzema, at 34, became the oldest winner since the first recipient in 1956, Stanley Matthews.

"Age is just a number for me," he said.

"People play until their later years now and I still have this burning desire. It is this drive that has kept me going and never allowed me to let up.'

Benzema won ahead of Sadio Man and Manchester City playmaker Kevin De Bruyne. Man played for Liverpool last season and joined Bayern Munich in the summer.

Benzema became the fifth Frenchman to win it after Raymond Kopa, Michel Platini, Jean-Pierre Papin and Zinedine Zidane, who was crowned in 1998, the year France won its first World Cup.

Benzema was not part of the France squad that triumphed at the 2018 World Cup in Russia but, barring an injury, will compete at the tournament in Qatar next month.

"There were much more difficult moments for me, when I was not selected (with France) and I did not give up," Benzema said after Zidane, his former coach at Madrid, handed him the trophy.

"I am really proud of my career. This is the Golden Ball of the people.'

Leading an attack that also included Vincius Jnior and Rodrygo, Benzema played a crucial role last season to drive Madrid to a recordextending 14th European title, and his fifth since he joined from Lyon in 2009. The Frenchman was the tournament's top scorer and found the net when it really mattered, with 10 of his goals in the knockout stages.

Putellas scored 42 goals and delivered 22 assists last season. She became the first player to win the award twice.

With Barcelona, she won the Spanish League and reached the Champions League final. She has been sidelined since July after injuring her left knee and

Deschamps last year ahead of the undergoing surgery on the eve of Women's European the Championship.

"When I got injured I didn't think I'd be here today, but it makes me proud to get recompense for all that hard work, she said. I miss playing so much and doing what I like to do the most."

Putellas beat out fellow forwards Beth Mead of Arsenal and England and Sam Kerr of Chelsea and Australia for the award at the ceremony in Paris. A panel of international journalists chose the winners.

In other awards, the Kopa Trophy for the best under-21 player went to 18-year-old Barcelona midfielder Gavi, while Robert Lewandowski won the Gerd Miler award for the best striker of the year.

The Lev Yashin award for best goalkeeper went to Real Madrid's Thibaut Courtois.

Ballon d'Or organisers added a humanitarian prize named after the late Brazil midfielder Socrates. The trophy went to Man for his charity work in Senegal including building a hospital and school donations.



Govt raises minimum support price for six rabi crops

Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs approved the increase in the Minimum Support Prices (MSP) for six rabi crops for 2023-24. The decision has come ahead of the elections in BJP-ruled Himachal Pradesh and Gujarat

The government increased the MSP to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce. "The absolute highest increase in MSP has been approved for lentil (masur) at Rs 500 per quintal followed by rapeseed and mustard at Rs 400 per quintal. For safflower, an increase of Rs 209 per quintal has been approved. For wheat, gram and barley, an increase of Rs 110 per quintal, Rs 100 per quintal respectively has been approved. Information and Broadcasting minister Anurag Thakur said, "The increase in MSP for rabi c crops for marketing season 2023-24 is in line with the Union Budget 2018-19 announcement of fixing the MSP at a level of at least 1.5 times of the all-India weighted average cost of production, aiming at reasonably fair remuneration for the farmers. The maximum rate of return is 104 per cent for rapeseed and mustard, followed by 100 per cent for wheat, 85 per cent for lentil; 66 per cent for gram; 60 per cent for barley; and 50 per cent for safflower." The government said that since the year 2014-15, there has been a renewed focus on increasing the production of oilseeds and pulses. The oilseeds production has increased from 27.51 million tonnes in 2014-15 to 37.70 million tonnes in 2021-22. Pulses production has also shown a similar increasing trend. The seed mini-kits programme is a major tool for introducing new varieties of seeds in the farmers' fields and is instrumental for increasing the seed replacement rate. "The government's priority is on increasing production of oilseeds and pulses and thus fulfilling the objective of Atmanirbhar Bharat," Thakur said. - Source: Theweek


