"With this in mind, 29 labour laws have been converted into 4 simple labour codes". This will ensure the empowerment of workers via minimum wages, job security, social security, and health security, he added.

The Prime Minister reiterated the need to change as per the changing scenario. He emphasised the need to take full advantage of the fourth industrial revolution by taking quick decisions and implementing them rapidly. In the light of platform and on 27th & 28th August, 2022 more. The entry fee for the gig economy and online facilities, the Prime Minister stressed the need to be alive towards the emerging dimensions of work. "Right policies and efforts in this area will help in making India a global leader", he said.

The Prime Minister highlighted that the country's Labour Ministry is preparing its vision for the year 2047 in Amrit Kaal. Reiterating that the future needs flexible workplaces, a work-from-home ecosystem, and flexible work hours, the Prime Minister said that we can use systems like flexible workplaces as opportunities for women's labour force participation. Recalling his address to the nation on the 15th of August from the ramparts of the Red Fort, the Prime Minister said that he has called for the full participation of the nation's women power. He added, "By making the right use of women power, India can achieve its goals faster." The Prime Minister also emphasised the need to think in the direction of what can be done for women in the newly emerging sectors in the country.

clay for idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be encouraged, allowed and promoted.

There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic bio-diversity. Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.

There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.

The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20ft in height.

Materials used in worship like flowers, vastras(clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).

>Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line(irrespective of its depth) in identified places with permission of District Administration only. Single use plastic should not be used during celebration.

West Bengal and Odisha have two Universities each, including Indian Institute of Alternative Medicine, Institute of Alternative Medicine and Research, Nababharat Shiksha Parishad and North Orissa University of Agriculture Technology.

The list also include Badaganvi Sarkar World Open University Education Society of Karnataka, St. John's University of Kerala, Raja Arabic University of Maharashtra, Sree Bodhi Academy of Higher Education of Puducherry and Christ New Testament Deemed University of Andhra Pradesh. - "Managing Committee" means Managing Committee of a School or any specific Educational Institutions constituted under the aegis of Association of Catholic Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- "Minority Christian Educational Institution" means an Educational Institution established and administered by the Christian Minority having the right to do so under clauses (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India.
- "Educational Institution" means all Institutions run by the Association of Catholic Andaman & Nicobar Islands and engaged in imparting both formal and non-formal education.
- "Aided Institution" means any Educational Institution formal or informal receiving Grant-in-Aid in full/partial in the form of payment of Salary/Wages or maintenance grant etc. from the Andaman and Nicobar Administration / Government of India.
- 2. Number of Posts and Scale of Pay:-

The number of posts and the Scale of Pay attached thereto shall be as specified in paragraphs 2 to 4 of the Schedule –I, annexed to these rules.

Method of Recruitment, Age Limit and other Qualifications etc. :-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in paragraphs 5 to 14 of the Schedule annexed to these rules (Schedule-I).
