PM addresses National Labour Conference of Labour Ministers of all States and UTs

India's labour force has huge role to play in realizing India's dreams & aspirations to build a developed nation in the 'Amrit Kaal': PM

New Delhi, Aug. 26 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has addressed the National Conference of Labour Ministers of all States and Union Territories via video conferencing yesterday. Union Ministers, Shri Bhubender Yadav and Shri Rameshwar Teli and Labour Ministers of States were among those present on the occasion. The Prime Minister emphasised that India's labour force has a huge role to play in realizing India's dreams and aspirations to build a developed nation in the Amrit Kaal, and with this thinking, the country is working continuously for



crores of workers from the organised and unorganised sector.

The Prime Minister reiterated the various efforts by the Government like Pradhan Mantri Shram-Yogi Maandhan Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan

Jyoti Bima Yojana that have given a kind of security cover to the workers. These schemes have assured the labourers of the recognition of their hard work and contribution. The Prime Minister also said, "the Emergency Credit Guarantee Scheme,

according to a study, saved 1.5 crore jobs during the pandemic." He continued "We are seeing that just as the country supported its workers in their time of need, in the same way, the workers have put their full strength into recovering from this epidemic." The Prime

Minister said that today India has once again become the fastest growing economy in the world, so a lot of credit goes to our workers, he said. The Prime Minister pointed out that the e-Shram portal is one of the key initiatives to bring the labour force into the ambit

of social security. In just one year, about 28 crore workers from 400 areas have been registered on the portal. This has especially benefited construction workers, migrant labourers, and domestic workers. He requested all the Ministers to integrate State portals with the e-Shram portal.

He further added that in the last eight years, the Government has taken the initiative to abolish the laws from the period of slavery that reflect the slavery mentality. "The country is now changing, reforming, simplifying such labour laws.", the Prime Minister said.

UGC declares 21 Universities as fake



New Delhi, Aug. 26

University Grant Commission (UGC) has declared twenty-one universities as fake. In a letter, UGC said that 21 institutions are functioning in self-styled manner across the Country, which are not recognized by the Commission. Making aware the students, UGC said that these institutions

are not empowered to confer a degree.

UGC said, the highest eight such fake Universities are functioning in Delhi and four in Uttar Pradesh. It said that the remaining nine fake Universities belong to the States of Karnataka, Maharashtra, Kerala, West Bengal, Odisha, Puducherry and

Packaged commodities should be sold on MRP; stringent action to be taken against shopkeepers tampering MRP

The Consumer Protection Act, 2019 has been enacted to provide protection of the interest of consumers and to safeguard their rights to be informed about the price of goods, products & services inter alia. To protect consumers against any unfair trade practices, all the dealer/shopkeepers of this UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands who are selling goods in packaged form should carry mandatory declarations in a conspicuous manner such as Manufacturer/Packers name &



the packaged commodity not confirmed to the mandatory declarations such as packers /manufacturers name, name of the

commodity, net weight, MRP etc. as prescribed under the aforementioned Act/Rules will be viewed seriously and stringent action as deemed fit will be taken against the offenders.

For any violation on selling any packaged commodities beyond MRP, tampering of MRP, non conformity of mandatory declarations etc. noticed by any consumer, may call on toll free Helpline number 14445/18003454445/180003454000 or written complaint against the unfair trade practitioner/

Andaman and Nicobar Idol Immersion Rules 2018 were published in the Andaman and Nicobar Gazette No. 23 dated 05-03-2018 in compliance of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 06-10-2017 in O.A 51/2016/EZ.

The Rules framed covers the general guidelines on idol making, ban on use of synthetic colors, height of super structures and idols.

In this connection, Chairman, A&N Pollution Control Committee, Shri Ankit Yadav, IAS has issued a Public Notice today

directing all the Idol Makers and Puja Committees to follow certain guidelines.

The guidelines are:

> Idols should be made from natural materials as described in the holy scripts. Use of traditional

"With this in mind, 29 labour laws have been converted into 4 simple labour codes". This will ensure the empowerment of workers via minimum wages, job security, social security, and health security, he added.

The Prime Minister reiterated the need to change as per the changing scenario. He emphasised the need to take full advantage of the fourth industrial revolution by taking quick decisions and implementing them rapidly. In the light of platform and gig economy and online facilities, the Prime Minister stressed the need to be alive towards the emerging dimensions of work. "Right policies and efforts in this area will help in making India a global leader", he said.

The Prime Minister highlighted that the country's Labour Ministry is preparing its vision for the year 2047 in Amrit Kaal. Reiterating that the future needs flexible workplaces, a work-from-home ecosystem, and flexible work hours, the Prime Minister said that we can use systems like flexible workplaces as opportunities for women's labour force participation. Recalling his address to the nation on the 15th of August from the ramparts of the Red Fort, the Prime Minister said that he has called for the full participation of the nation's women power. He added, "By making the right use of women power, India can achieve its goals faster." The Prime Minister also emphasised the need to think in the direction of what can be done for women in the newly emerging sectors in the country.

clay for idol making rather than baked clay, Plaster of Paris (POP) etc. shall be encouraged, allowed and promoted.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of POP in idol making till it is established that the POP has no negative impact on the water quality and aquatic bio-diversity.

> Painting of idols should be discouraged. In case idols are to be painted, water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes are to be used.

> There shall be a complete ban on the use of synthetic colour for painting of idols that would require immersion as part of final ritual of the festival.

> The height of the super structure of the idol shall be less than 40 ft. and the idol also shall not exceed 20ft in height.

> Materials used in worship like flowers, vastras (clothes), decorative materials (made of paper and plastic) etc. should be removed before immersion of idols. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting at designated sites whereas the non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills or as prescribed by the local Municipal Authority or local body. Clothes may be sent to local orphanage(s).

> Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line and high tide line (irrespective of its depth) in identified places with permission of District Administration only.

> Single use plastic should not be used during celebration.

Uttar Pradesh comes second with four fake universities. These include: Gandhi Hindi Vidyapith, National University of Electro Complex Homeopathy, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose University (open university), and Bhartiya Shiksha Parishad.

West Bengal and Odisha have two Universities each, including Indian Institute of Alternative Medicine, Institute of Alternative Medicine and Research, Nababharat Shiksha Parishad and North Orissa University of Agriculture Technology.

The list also include Badaganvi Sarkar World Open University Education Society of Karnataka, St. John's University of Kerala, Raja Arabic University of Maharashtra, Sree Bodhi Academy of Higher Education of Puducherry and Christ New Testament Deemed University of Andhra Pradesh. COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Two COVID positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, out of which, one incoming flight passenger who arrived here yesterday was tested positive. Today, 10 flights with 1285 passengers arrived, out of which, 1155 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 83 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 12 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 34 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 13 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.
