Port Blair dated the 10 January 2022

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 10 (2)(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive Committee (NEC) directs vide order of Ministry of Home Affairs dated 27th December 2021 to consider implementation of normative framework, as conveyed vide advisory of MoHFW's vide D. O. Letter no. D.O.No.Z.28015/318/21-EMR dated 21st December 2021 as per Annexure-I until 31st January 2022 and to take necessary measures, under relevant provisions of the DM Act, 2005.

**AND WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 24 (1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairperson, Union Territory Disaster Management Executive Committee for the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands has ordered to ensure compliance of Containment measures for COVID-19 as well as increased detection of the Variant of Concern (VoC), "OMICRON" in different parts of this Union Territory as per the advisory issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) dated 21st December 2021 for ensuring strict compliance prescribing a normative framework for taking evidence based containment measures at District/Local Level for the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and shall remain in force till 31st January 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of powers vested u/s 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in order to enforce strict compliance of the National Directives on COVID-19 in South Andaman District, the undersigned prescribe the following fines for the violation of the Lockdown Guidelines and the National Directives on COVID-19 Management issued by the MHA:-

1.	Non-wearing of face cover in public places, work places and in public transport	Rs.1000/-
2.	Spitting in public & work places	Rs.600/-
3.	Violation of social distancing norms by individual (s) in public places, work places, etc.	Rs.400/-
4.	Violation of social distancing norms by shop owners in their establishments	Rs.4000/-
5.	Violation of National Directives with respect to Marriage	Rs.20000/-
6.	Violation of National Directives with respect to funeral/last rites.	Rs.5000/-
7.	Consumption of liquor in Public places	Rs.10000/-
8.	Consumption of paan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public places	Rs.600/-

9.	Overcrowding in shape / ask-11: 1	D 5000/
10	Overcrowding in shops/establishments	Rs.5000/-
10.	Overcrowding in taxi/auto	Rs.2000/-

All Sub-Divisional Magistrates, Executive Magistrates, Revenue officials of the rank of Patwari and above, Sanitary Inspectors of the PBMC, Panchayat Secretaries of the RD department, Food Safety Officers, GST Tax Inspectors and police personnel of the rank of the constable and above are hereby authorised to impose and collect fines as mentioned above. However, this does not bar any other legal action that may be attracted due to violation of any other Act/Law/Rule in force.

Further, all the fines collected by the sanitary officers of the PBMC shall be remitted by them into the concerned revenue head of Municipal Council. Similarly, the fines collected by the Panchayat Secretaries of the RD department shall be remitted into the receipt account of the concerned Panchayat. Officers of the Police and the Revenue Department shall remit the amount with the SDM office into the Government account under Major Head 0070, Other Receipts.

A daily statement of the fines collected by all concerned should be remitted by 5.00 PM everyday to this office for information and record.

This order shall come into immediate effect and shall remain in force till further orders.
