A&N Administration receives second modern passenger ship 'MV Nalanda' constructed by CSL

New vessel to join shipping fleet of DSS soon; to strengthen waterways transportation

Port Blair, July 6

The A&N Administration in order to provide better shipping services to the Islanders, especially in Southern Group of Islands has placed order for construction of two 500 passengers cum 150 ton cargo vessels with Cochin Shipyard Limited (CSL). Accordingly, the first vessel in this series christened as 'MV Sindhu' has joined the A&N Shipping fleet last year. Another vessel, 500 passenger cum 150 ton cargo vessel 'MV Nalanda' built at Cochin Shipyard will join the DSS's Shipping fleet soon. The Cochin Shipyard Limited



(CSL) has handed over the newly constructed vessel to the A&N Administration and it is expected that the vessel will sail from Cochin after completing all other formalities. MV Nalanda, once inducted will give further boost to the efforts of the

cabins, 32 first class cabins, 36 second class cabins, 74 seats and 346 Bunk class. Smart Engineering and Design Solutions (India) Limited has provided the basic design services for the vessels.

The Ship building contract for the ship was signed between A&N Administration and M/s Cochin Shipyard Ltd. in March 2016, keeping in line with the Govt. of India's 'Make in India' policy. The vessel is primarily intended for operation between Inter-Island and occasional voyage between the Island and the mainland, DSS sources informed DT.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands Cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with both doses of vaccine reaches 6,83,959

Port Blair, July 6

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,83,959 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,588 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years. 24,583 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14

years have been administered both doses of vaccine. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 27,789.

A total of 96 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 88 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 3 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12 to

14 years, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18 to 44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 45.

Agricultural exports touching Rs. 3.75 lakh crores a good sign: Minister

New Delhi, July 6 (PIB)

The Union Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar virtually inaugurated the joint conference of the Indian Council for Research on International Economic Relations (ICRIER) and National Stock Exchange (NSE) from Gwalior today. On this occasion, Shri Tomar said that as a result of the hard work of farmer brothers and sisters and farmer friendly policies of the Government, today India stands among the top two producers in the world in terms of most agricultural products. He said that India's organic products are in demand across the world and despite the adverse conditions like corona epidemic, agricultural exports from India touching Rs. 3.75 lakh crores is

a good sign. In such a scenario, we must sustain the quality of our agricultural products and ensure it meets the global standards.

The conference on "Getting Agricultural Markets Right" has been organized jointly by ICRIER, one of the leading economic think tanks of the country, and the world's largest exchange, - NSE. The chief guest, Union Minister, Shri Tomar said that India is a country with diverse climate and there is a possibility of very favourable weather for farming.

"Our agriculture sector is very strong, which stands tall even in adverse conditions. Recently, even during the Covid crisis, when the whole world had almost come to a standstill, then despite the lockdown, all agricultural activities like sowing, harvesting, marketing etc. continued uninterrupted. Indian

agriculture sector is vast and a majority of our population depends on agriculture, so necessary changes have been made by the Government for its progress and scholars also keep supporting the Government through their suggestions, all of which will benefit the agriculture sector. Several initiatives have been taken under the leadership of Prime Minister in the last 8 years for the development and management of agriculture. India administers more than 198 crore 20 lakh COVID vaccine doses



New Delhi, July 6

More than 198 crore 20 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far. The Health Ministry said, more than nine lakh ninety-five thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours. During the same period, sixteen thousand one hundred and fifty-nine new COVID cases were reported in the country.

India's Active caseload currently stands at over one lakh fifteen thousand and it is at 0.26 percent. The recovery

rate is currently at 98.53 percent. A total of 15 thousand 394 people recovered in the last 24 hours and with this, the total recoveries touched over four crore 29 lakh. The Ministry said, the Weekly Positivity Rate stands at 3.84 percent and the Daily Positivity Rate is at 3.56 percent. A total of 86 crore 49 lakh COVID tests have been conducted in the country so far. In the last 24 hours, more than four lakh 54 thousand tests were conducted. (Source: india.gov.in)

(i) These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, DIET, Department of Education (Group "A" post in the DIET of Department of Education), Recruitment Rules, 2022
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **NUMBER OF POSTS, ITS CLASSIFICATION AND LEVEL IN PAY MATRIX:-** The number of said post, its classification and level in Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, AGE LIMIT, QUALIFICATIONS ETC. :-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in the Columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. **DISQUALIFICATIONS:-** No Persons--

5. **POWER TO RELAX:-** Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so do he may by order for reason to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, if necessary, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class of category of persons.

6. **SAVING:-** Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. from time to time in this regard.
