

PM launches PM Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission

Through PM Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission an entire ecosystem for services from treatment to critical research will be created in every corner of the country: PM

New Delhi, Oct. 25 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched PM Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said the country has achieved a major milestone of 100 crore vaccine doses in its fight against the corona epidemic. "With the blessings of Baba Vishwanath, with the unwavering glory of Maa Ganga, with the unshakable faith of the people of Kashi, the campaign of free vaccine for all is progressing successfully", the Prime Minister said.

The Prime Minister lamented that in post-independent India, health infrastructure did not get the required attention for a very long time and citizens had to run from pillar to post for proper treatment, leading to worsening of the condition and financial strain. This led to a persistent worry about medical treatment in the hearts of the middle class and poor people. Those whose governments remained in the country for a long time, instead of the all-around development of the country's healthcare system, kept it deprived of facilities.



The Prime Minister said that PM Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission aims to tackle this deficiency. The aim is to strengthen the critical healthcare network from village to block to the district to the regional and national level in the next

4-5 years. Describing the initiative taken by the government under the new Mission, the Prime Minister said that there are 3 major aspects of the Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission to address the different gaps in the health sector of the country. The first is related to the creation of elaborate facilities for diagnostics and treatment. Under this, Health and Wellness Centers are being opened in villages and cities, where there will be facilities for early detection of diseases. Facilities like free medical consultation, free tests, free medicine will be available in these centres. For serious illness, 35 thousand new critical care-related beds are being added in 600 districts and referral facilities will be given in 125 districts.

The second aspect of the scheme, the Prime Minister said, is related to the testing network for the diagnosis of diseases. Under this mission, the necessary infrastructure will be developed for the diagnosis and monitoring of diseases. 730 districts of the country will get Integrated Public Health labs and

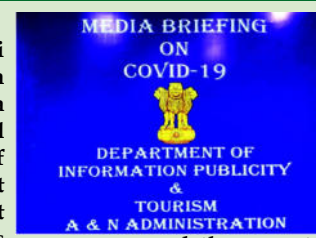

Media briefed on COVID-19

Secretary (IP&T) urges unvaccinated persons to get themselves vaccinated as shield against the virus

Port Blair, Oct. 25

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh addressing the media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 530 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 940 passengers arrived, out of which, 520 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 420






and all were found negative. RAT was also conducted on 30 passengers commuting by boat. At helipad, 9 passengers were tested and all were found negative.

The Secretary further stated that today till 3 pm, 406 persons were vaccinated, out of which 387 were in the age group of 18-44 years. The Secretary also urged unvaccinated persons to get themselves vaccinated as a shield against the virus.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Star jasmine (Jasminum nitidum) - a potential loose flower

Star jasmine or shiny jasmine (*Jasminum nitidum*) is a potential loose flower and known for its year round production. The origin of this species is Admiralty Islands of Papua New Guinea. Since the geographical origin of the species is from Island, this is well adapted to grow in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The flowers are very attractive, mild fragrant and produced in clusters. The flower buds are dark purplish in colour when immature and the colour is changed to pinkish purple as they mature.

Opened flowers are snow white and star shaped flower with 10 petals which are leaner, longer and spread out. Open sunny situation is best for cultivation of this flower crop for quality flower production. This crop can be grown in open field and also in pots. The spacing to be adopted is 75 cm between plants and 1.0 m between rows. The plant is propagated through air layering and cuttings. Flower buds will initiate six months after planting, however, the economic yield will be obtained from second year onwards. The yield per plant is 2-2.5 Kg per plant (two years after planting). Heavy bloom is produced during summer in Island conditions. The harvesting stage is the matured bold bud stage with pink tinge.

Benefit: *Jasminum nitidum* is a versatile crop with wide commercial utilities and hence will be one of the potential crop to exploit in the Island.

Over 102 crore doses of COVID vaccine administered so far

New Delhi, Oct. 25

India has administered over 102 crore 31 lakh doses of COVID vaccine so far under the Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Union Health Ministry said, more than 12 lakh 31 thousand vaccine doses were administered in the last 24 hours.

The Ministry said, 18 thousand 762 COVID patients recovered during the last 24 hours and the national recovery rate stands at 98.18 per cent. Till now, more than three crore 35 lakh people have recovered from COVID-19. The country reported 14 thousand 306 new cases in last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload is around one lakh 67 thousand. The active cases constitute less than one per cent of the total cases and it is currently at 0.49 per cent, the lowest since March last year. The daily positivity rate stands at 1.43 per cent. The Ministry said, the testing capacity across the country continues to be expanded and more than 60 crore seven lakh COVID-19 tests have been conducted so far. (Source: india.gov.in)
