able to feel this ease. Common people should not have to struggle in their dealings with the Government, benefits and services should be available to them without hassle. "Taking the dreams of the common man to a level of resolve is the responsibility of the system. This Sankalp (resolve) should be taken to Siddhi (completion) and that should be the goal for all of us. We should be there to handhold at every stage in this journey of Sapna (dream, to Sankalp (resolve) to Siddhi (completion)", he added. Secondly, given the growing stature and changing profile of India, it is imperative that whatever we do, that should be done in the global context. If we don't follow the activities at the global level, it will be very difficult to ascertain our priorities and focus area. We need to develop our schemes and governance models keeping this perspective in mind, the Prime Minister said. The Prime Minister emphasized that our systems and models should keep on getting updated at a regular speed, we cannot deal with the challenges of today with the systems of last century. Thirdly, he said "Wherever we are in the system, our prime responsibility is the unity and integrity of the country, there cannot be any compromise. Even local decisions should be measured on this touchstone. Every decision of ours should be evaluated on its capacity to provide strength to the country's unity and integrity. 'Nation First' should always inform our decisions.

Underlining the difference between the typist and sitar player, the Prime Minister emphasized the need to live an examined life, a life of dreams and enthusiasm and purpose. "I want to live every moment so that I can serve and help others to live well", he said. Shri Modi exhorted the Officers to live beyond the beaten path and think out of box. Reform in governance should be our natural stance, he continued, governance reforms should be experimentative and as per the needs of the time and country. He referred to reduction of obsolete laws and number of compliances as one of his key priorities. The Prime Minister said that we should not change only under pressure but should try to improve pro-actively. We should not be governed by the regulations and mentality that emerged in the period of scarcity, we should have an attitude of abundance. Similarly, we should anticipate rather than just react to the challenges. PM emphasized that "during the last 8 years, many big things have happened in the country. Many of these campaigns are such that there is behavioral change in its origin". He said he is not of the temperament of Rajniti but of Janniiti.

He concluded by requesting the Officers to adopt the key reforms in their personal lives. For example, whether cleanliness, use of GeM or UPI is there in their own life or not.

The trainees were provided with training on value addition to Fish, Prawn etc using modern technology, preservation techniques, packaging techniques etc. Awareness on the various machineries, equipments and tools used in the fish processing units and practical demonstration was also provided to the trainees. During the training programme, resource persons from NABARD, Fisheries Department and Industries Department provided vital information about various schemes being implemented by Government of India and UT Administration.

In order to control air pollution, dry waste and hazardous waste are collected and further baled and transported to mainland for disposal as per NGT guideline which will further decrease the carbon foot print in the locality.

The officials informed the team that various activities are being done such as segregation of wet waste and its further processing at Compost Yard. The officials also briefed about the functioning of Faecal Sludge Treatment Plant & merits of the Bio Re-mediation Centre as per the compliance of Waste Management Rules. The Chairperson insisted the Councillors and the officials to sensitize the general public to maintain the city clean and hygiene, a press release from PBMC said.




