

## Mann Ki Baat: PM Modi urges people to stay guarded against COVID-19, Omicron

### Self-awareness, self-discipline are strength to fight against new variant: PM

New Delhi, Dec. 26

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has urged people to stay guarded against COVID and the Omicron variant. Addressing the nation in his Mann Ki Baat programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi said scientists are studying the new Omicron variant and getting new data everyday. He stressed that in such a situation, self-awareness and self-discipline of the people are the country's strength in fighting against the new variant. He stated that it is this collective strength that will defeat



COVID. He called upon people to step in the year 2022 with this sense of responsibility.

Prime Minister said that it is because of everyone's efforts that India could fight the pandemic. He

took pride that when one compares India's vaccination figures with the rest of the world, it feels that the country has achieved a huge feat. He said crossing the 140 crore vaccine dose mark is an

achievement of each and every Indian. He emphasised that this shows the trust of every Indian in the system, in science and in scientists.

The Prime Minister remembered Group Captain Varun Singh who was flying the helicopter that fell prey to a mishap this month in Tamil Nadu. Country's first Chief of Defence Staff, General Bipin Rawat and his wife also lost their lives in the incident.

The Chief Secretary also reviewed the functioning of all Departments including ANIDCO, Medical. He asked Doctors to be aware of the number of lactating mothers and pregnant women. The pending works by APWD and issue of the dumping of waste and construction materials

at different sites was also pointed to the Departments and a report will be taken after 20 days.

The Chief Secretary directed to form an Informal Island Development & Monitoring Committee with senior local officers of the Island and they would coordinate and meet once in 15 days every month. If this is successful, then it would be put on every area or every group of areas, where all officers would give inputs to the progress of inter-departmental coordination

and of land encroachments, etc.

The Chief Secretary also directed APWD to complete its ongoing works. He further asked SDM/AC to visit Shaheed Dweep, Swaraj Dweep and other Islands regularly.

Improvement and development of rural road network, encroachment by bigger resorts, encroachments on Govt. property, repair of rural roads to be focused. The Chief Secretary also asked the people of the Islands to keep the Island neat and clean.

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## Two positive cases detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Dec. 26

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 429 passengers who arrived here yesterday, two positive cases have been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2121 passengers arrived, out of which, 1672 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 449 passengers (includes 15 international travellers) and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 152 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 57 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 5 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative, a press release from the Directorate of IP&T said.

During the joint patrolling, it was found that 4 dinghies with 17 fishermen were fishing inside the Jarawa Reserve Area. Acting swiftly, the patrolling team apprehended all the 17 fishermen and seized their dinghies. On checking, around 750 kgs of fish, fuel, solar panel, GPS, 06 Nos. empty drums, plastic jerricans, gas stove, buckets, pipes and other

fishing articles were recovered from their possession.
