First G20 Energy Transitions Working Group Meet begins in Bengaluru

Union Minister calls upon G20 partners for united fight against global warming and climate change

Bengaluru, Feb. 5 (PIB)

Union Minister for Power and New and Renewable Energy, Shri R.K. Singh has called upon the G20 member countries to join together in countering the challenges posed by global warming and climate change. Delivering the key note address at the first Energy Transitions Working Group (ETWG) Meeting in Bengaluru today, the Minister said that India now stands committed to reduce emissions intensity of GDP by 45 percent by 2030 from 2005 level. He said, the country also aims to achieve close to 50 per cent cumulative electric power installed capacity from non-fossil fuel-based energy resources by



2030. Noting that India has been ranked amongst the top five performing countries in the Climate Change Performance Index, Shri R.K. Singh informed that the country's per capita greenhouse gas emissions are far below the world average of 6.3 tCO₂e in 2020. Various energy saving schemes of the Government have led to 267.9 Million Tonnes of CO₂ reduction per year, resulting in an estimated cost savings of \$ 18.5 Billion, he added.

Later, addressing media persons the Minister said that India will not compromise with the present availability of energy base and will explore all feasible sources to achieve energy security. The ETWG Meeting will serve as a preparatory forum to draft roadmap for this, he added.

In his special address, Union Minister for Parliamentary Affairs, Coal & Mines, Shri Prahlad Joshi underlined the need for international

Allocation in Budget FY 2023-24 for Department of Fisheries marks an overall increase of 38.45% over the Budget of FY 2022-23

Allocation is one of the highest ever annual budgetary support for the Department

New Delhi, Feb. 5 (PIB)

While presenting the budget for FY 2023-24, Union Finance Minister, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman in her speech has announced allocation of an amount of INR 2248.77 crore as against the corresponding figure of INR 1624.18 crore during 2022-23 and INR 1360 crore during 2021-22 for the Department of Fisheries. It marks an overall increase of 38.45% over the budget of FY 2022-23 from the last one and is one of the highest ever annual budgetary support for the Department.

Further, she has announced a new sub-scheme named Pradhan Mantri Matsya Kisan Samridhi Sah-Yojana (PM-MKSSY): Central Sector Sub-scheme under PMMSY with targeted investment of INR 6,000 crore with the objective to enhance further the

earnings and incomes of fishermen, fish vendors and micro & small enterprises engaged in fisheries sector. PM-MKSSY envisages focussed intervention to bring about formalization of the fisheries sector and this includes digital inclusion, fisheries and facilitating access to

institutional finance for investment and working capital, incentives to bring about system and institutions to reduce risk in aquaculture and incentivizing microenterprises operating in fisheries and aquaculture sector to

work on value-chain efficiencies, incentivizing micro and small enterprises to establish supply chains for delivery of safe fish products to consumers, thereby expanding the domestic market and incentives for creation and maintenance of jobs for women in the sector.

Union Budget allocates over Rs 44,000 crore for higher education: UGC Chairman

New Delhi, Feb. 5 UGC Chairman, Shri Mamidala Jagadesh Kumar has said that Union Budget has allocated over 44 thousand crore rupees for higher education. He said this is 7.9 per cent higher than the previous year's

allocation. This is to overcome the learning losses of the Covid-19 pandemic and inject more digital technology into higher education for more access and equity. The UGC Chairman said the increased fund allocation will

accelerate the implementation of NEP 2020. He added that this will bring further dividends to the students to make them employable and strengthen efforts in making India a knowledge-based economy. (Source: india.gov.in)

Anaemia Mukht Bharat Programme being implemented successfully by Directorate of Health Services in Isles

Port Blair, Feb. 5

The 'Anaemia Mukht Bharat Programme' was launched by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoH&FW), Government of India, to accelerate the decline of anaemia in various age groups by intensifying strong initiatives to further strengthen the already present mechanisms as well as develop new ones to reduce anaemia.

In A&N Islands, 'Anaemia Mukht Bharat Programme' is being implemented successfully by the Directorate of Health Services through Schools, Anganwadi Centres, Health & Wellness Centres and VHND platforms. It has significantly reduced the prevalence of anaemia across various age groups.

The Anaemia Mukht Bharat programme divides its target group into six beneficiary groups via the means of six interventions



and six institutional mechanisms to achieve its goal of reducing anaemia under the POSHAN Abhiyan. These target group beneficiaries are Children (6-59 months), Children (5-9 years), Adolescent boys and girls (10-19 years), Women of reproductive age (20-49 years), pregnant women, and Lactating women.

Anaemia Mukht Bharat programme is covered through

6 Strategic Interventions. They are prophylactic iron & folic acid (IFA) supplementation; deworming; intensified year-round behaviour change communication campaign; Testing & Treatment of Anemia, with focus on Pregnant Women & School-Going Adolescents; Mandatory Provision of Iron & Folic Acid Fortified Foods; Intensifying Awareness, Screening & Treatment of Non-Nutritional Causes of Anemia in Endemic Pockets, with special focus on Malaria, Haemoglobinopathies & Fluorosis.

This programme was first launched in 1970 as the National Nutritional Anaemia Prophylaxis Programme (NNAPP) and in 2018 it has been changed to 'Anaemia Mukht Bharat', a press release from DHS received here said.

General Public as well as Stakeholders have been informed that A & N Administration will be conducting a State Level Disaster Management Exercise (Tatpar-23) in A & N Island on 09.02.2023 in coordination with National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA). General public have been requested not to panic and follow do's & don'ts as given below:

Before & During

- Find out if your home is in a danger area.
- Know the height of your street/ house above sea level and the distance from the coast.
- Coastal areas within 1 mile (1.6 km) of the sea and less than 25 ft (7.5m) above sea level are most at risk; make an early assessment of the best route to higher ground.
- People living along the coast should consider an earthquake or a strong ground rumbling as a warning signal.
- If a "tsunami watch" turns into a "tsunami warning," prepare to evacuate your home.
- As the tsunami nears the coast, the waves slow down and increase in height.
- Before the first wave reaches the shore, the sea may be dramatically 'moved back' away from the shoreline.
- Remember, Successive waves appear at intervals of 5 to 90 minutes and the first wave is usually not the largest; the following ones may cause more damage.
- Try and climb a raised platform or climb the highest floor .of any house or building which you might see.
- Make evacuation plans and a safe route for evacuation. Stay away from the beach.
- Never go down to the beach to watch an approaching storm surge.
- Listen to a radio or television to get the latest information and be ready to evacuate if asked to do so.
- Familiarize yourself with warning signs, such as a sudden change in the level of coastal waters.
- If you hear an official warning, evacuate at once. Return home only after authorities' advice it is safe to do so.
- Stay away from any structures that may have been weakened by the earthquake.
- Tsunamis often cause severe floods; make sure that you are prepared to cope.
- Keep your car filled with fuel so that you can drive to safety quickly.
- Help those who need assistance to move to safety.

After

- Stay tuned to battery- operated radio for the latest emergency information.
 - Help injured and trapped persons. Provide for first aid.
 - Stay away from flooded and damaged areas until officials say it is safe to return.
 - Enter your home with caution.
 - Use flashlight when entering damaged houses, Check for electrical short circuit and live wires.
 - Check food supplies and test drinking water.

collaboration to achieve universal access to clean energy. "Indians believe in nature-friendly lifestyle and practices rather than its exploitation. Reduce, Reuse and Recycle are the concepts of our life; and Circular economy is an integral part of our culture and lifestyle", the Minister added.

The first ETWG Meeting under India's G20 Presidency will focus on six major priority areas such as Energy Transition through Addressing Technology Gaps; Low-cost Financing for Energy Transition; Energy Security and Diversified Supply Chains; Energy Efficiency, Industrial Low Carbon Transitions and Responsible Consumption; Fuels for Future (3F) and Universal Access to Clean Energy and Just, Affordable, and Inclusive Energy Transition Pathways. "One Earth, One Family and One Future" is the theme of the event.

More than 150 participants including G20 countries and nine special invitee guest countries are participating in the three-day event along with the World Bank, Asian Development Bank, United Nations Environment Program (UNEP) and many other international organisations.
