Return of Taliban has implications for India

The dramatic events in Kabul over the weekend have shocked India, which seemed quite unprepared like much of the world for a precipitous collapse of the government headed by Ashraf Ghani, Through the last few weeks, Delhihad stiffened it opposition to the Taliban and doubled down its support for Kabul.
This was reinforced by the broader Indian elite and popular sentiment in favour of Kabul. The genuine warmth for the Afgha people and a deep commitment for their welfare might have prevented India from recognising the weaknesses of the government in Kabul. Delhi had also perhaps overestimated the domestic political support in Washington for a strong posture against the Taliban and the Biden Administration's ability to manage the end-game of its plan to withdraw all troops from Afghanistan. While a post-mortem of the developments in Afahanistan must take place at an appropriate time, Delhis current focus must be on addressing the immediate challenge confronting it in Afghanistan. As a non-permanent member of the UN Security Council. Delhiwill have a voice in shaping the international debate on the situation in Afghanistan. India also chairs the Taliban Sanctions Committee of the UNSC and wi have an important role in framing the international response to the Taliban's demands for the lifting of all sanctions against its leaders. India also must step up its diplomatic outreach to all the major powers and key regional actors to develop political and policy coordination in responding to the dynamic situation in Afghanistan. Meanwhile, delivering international humanitarian assistance to the large number of Afghan people displaced by fighting in the last fewweeks must be taken up as a high priority at the UN. The final challenge is domestic. As Islamabad triumphalism at the successful re-installation of the Taliban begin torise and Pakistan-based jihadi groups turn their attention to Kashmir, tensions are bound to rise on India's western borders. Delhimust maintain vigil against a resurgence of cross-border terrorism that could quickly destabilise Kashmir and escalate the conflict between India and Pakistan.

Former India footballer Olympian Chandrasekharan dies aged 86

Chandrasekharan, who played as a defender, was a member of the Indian team in the 1960 Rome Olympics, the last time the country participated in football at the Games.

Former India footballer C Chandras ekharan, popularly known as Olympian Chandras ekharan inhis home state Kerala, died at he age of 86 in Kochi on Tuesday. He had been suffering from dementia for a decade or so Chandrasekharan, who played as a defender, was a member of the Indian team in the 1960 Rome Olympics, he last time the country participated in football at the Games. At 46, skating nomad-turned-Olympian Oberholzer inspiring youth, impressing mum

Dallas Oberholzer, 46, competed in the teenager-dominated sport in Tokyo but the South African is a pioneer who overcame his Apartheid upbringing to find new converts among the coloured population

under his arm and nothing in his pockets, Dallas Oberholzerwalked into Isithumba — the Zulu v illage between Durban and Pietermaritzburg—in 2001. There, he wowed the kids with tricks and flips and in return, South Africa's skateboarding nomad was gifted a piece of land by the village elders piece of land by the village eders. By 2009, the piece of land, overlooking the Umgeni river in the Valley of a Thousand Hills, had grown into a homestead comprising th-roofed huts and a skale park. That y ear, the youth camp attracted Tony Hawk, the name synony mous with the sport. The American visited the village and was so enamoured by the skills of the Zulu kids that he Oberholzer too was revelling in the festivities, skating down the street to the shops when he was arrested. "I had been arrested for arrested."I had been arrested for skating before. This time, I was jailed and asked to pay the bail to getout." Oberhotzer tells The Indan Express. "Ten years later, my county asked me to representitat the Olympic Games. That's how

ridiculous skateboarding could be." Oberholzer, 46, competed at skateboarding's Olympic debut in Tokyo. He was the oldest member of Team South Africa and the second-



oldest participant in the youngest sport, Fellow 46-year-old Rune The Danish Destroy er' Glifberg pipped him by eight months. Oberholzer says the veterans made it a perfect show case for skateboarding. "Idon' think ever again there will be a 40-y ear-old skateboarder at the Olympics. You'd be lucky if a 30year-old makes it. So, it was just lovely that the introduction to skateboarding was such a mixed bag of people," he says. "It wasn't bag or people, "ne says. "It wasn't predictable." Oberholzer's men's park event was won by an 18-year-old from Australia. The combined ages of the podium in the women's street and park events were 42 and 44 respectively. Just like the spin of the universe, the skateboarding universe too spins fast. Things are moving faster and getting more technical. Thesey oung athlets from the start, they see things that are really good," he says. "Whereas

when I started, we aimed for things that are very average now. Their progression, theirtrajectory is just through the roof compared to my steady progression." It had taken him to 50 countries but with little to show for it. He moved to Durban to trainata Tony Hawk-designed skate park. The search for ambition and direction brought him to Isithumba direction brought him to Isithumba in 2001, which remains his on-andoff shelter. "I am the only white person in a 30km radius. person in a 30km radius. Everybody thinks I'm crazy," he says. "Everybody wanted to know why I wanted to live there. My parents talked about the negatives of living here but got over it later. Some comments would be backhanded, stufflike 'good that you are helping the blacks' but for me. this was a place to have fun, to build a safe space for skaters." A white South African schooled

Oberholzer found black peers during his skating runs, and stirred into action once Nelson Mandela came to power. "Mandela basically said to power. Mandea basically said to everyone in South Africa, dow hat y ou can do, share what y ou hav e. All I did was share what I had, which was skateboarding and the culture. It helped me get over my culture. It helped me get over my Apartheid upbringing," says Oberholzer. "It was theway to fight the good fight, to show that skateboarding is a legitactivity to keep the youthout of rouble. I also was just on a personal mission to get it accepted, because I went through so much ridicule." He through so much naticule.
