

PM CARES for Children Scheme extended up to Feb.28

New Delhi, Feb. 22 (PIB)

The Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India has extended the PM Cares for Children Scheme till 28th February, 2022. Earlier the scheme was valid till 31st December, 2021. A letter in this regard has been written to all Principal Secretaries/ Secretaries, Women and Child Development, Social Justice & Empowerment Department of all States and UTs with a copy to all District Magistrates/



District Collectors for necessary action.

All eligible children can now be enrolled till 28th February, 2022 to avail benefits of PM CARES for Children Scheme. The scheme covers all children who

have lost: i) Both parents or ii) Surviving parent or iii) legal guardian/ adoptive parents/single adoptive parent due to COVID-19 pandemic, starting from 11.03.2020 the date on which WHO has declared and

characterized COVID-19 as pandemic till 28.02.2022. To be entitled to benefits under this scheme Child should not have completed 18 years of age on the date of death of parents.

Prime Minister,

Shri Narendra Modi, on 29th May, 2021, had announced comprehensive support for children who have lost both their parents due to COVID-19 pandemic. The objective of the scheme is to ensure comprehensive care and protection of children who have lost their parent(s) to COVID pandemic, in a sustained manner, enable their wellbeing through health insurance, empower them through education and equip them for self-

Govt. approves continuation of National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMSS) for a period of five years

New Delhi, Feb. 22 (PIB)

Government has approved the continuation of Central Sector National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMSS) over the 15th Finance Commission cycle for a period of five years i.e. from 2021-22 to 2025-26 with financial outlay of Rs. 1827.00 crore with minor modifications in eligibility criteria such as increasing income ceiling from Rs.1.5 lakh per annum to Rs.3.5 lakh per annum and revising the renewal criteria under the scheme.

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students of

economically weaker sections to arrest their drop-out at class VIII and encourage them to continue their education at secondary stage.

One lakh fresh scholarships of Rs.12,000/- per annum (Rs.1000/- per month) per student are awarded to selected students of class IX every year and their continuation/renewal in classes X to XII for study in State Government, Government-aided and

The Director, Panchayat and Municipal Elections, A&N Islands, Shri Suneel Anchipaka accompanied by the Officer In-Charge (Elections) visited Diglipur Tehsil to assess the ongoing preparatory arrangements for the ensuing Panchayat Elections. During the visit, he held meetings with the local representatives of the political parties, officials of line Departments, Police and sought their cooperation in conducting the elections in a free and fair manner.



The DPME also held meetings with the Returning Officers and further reviewed the Model Mode of Conduct (MCC) with the Police and Sector Officers. He requested all concerned to ensure COVID protocols as per the

Chess: Indian GM R Praggnanandhaa defeats world champion Magnus Carlsen at Airthings Masters

New Delhi, Feb. 22

In Chess, Indian Grandmaster R Praggnanandhaa defeated world champion, Magnus Carlsen in the eighth round of the Airthings Masters competition. Praggnanandhaa won with black pieces in 39 moves yesterday to halt Carlsen's run of three straight wins. Earlier, the Indian registered a solitary win versus Levon Aronian along with recording two draws and four defeats. Airthings Masters, is a 16-player online rapid chess tournament.



Praggnanandhaa has become only the third Indian after Viswanathan Anand and P Harikrishna to beat Carlsen. Praggnanandhaa shot to fame in 2018 when he became India's youngest and world's second youngest Grandmaster after entering the final round at the Gredine Open in Italy. He achieved the landmark at just 12 years, 10 months and 13 days, which was just three months short of Sergey Karjakin's record of the youngest Grandmaster in the world at 12 years, 7 months.

address outlined the functions and responsibilities of Biodiversity Council, National Biodiversity Authority, importance of strengthening and operationalisation of the Biodiversity Management Committee, and the need for developing a mechanism for making best use of stakeholders as a means of conserving the unique biodiversity in these Islands. He also underlined the importance of Citizen Science to improve the knowledge base.

Orientation was provided on the Access and Benefit Sharing issues in biodiversity conservation and its implications in conservation of resources, the need for capturing the traditional knowledge base in the Islands and the laws governing biodiversity conservation. He further touched upon how generation of information and robust data in the form of People's Biodiversity Register and its digitization can lead to greater conservation of flora and fauna and accruing benefits to the people, who have traditionally held the knowledge of conservation of the bio-resource. The Chairperson, NBA has agreed to provide the needed support in form of resources and technology and the handholding and guidance in this front.

Earlier, the session was inaugurated by PCCF (HoFF), Shri Tarun Coomar, and attended by all officers, including Divisional charges of inter-islands. He explained the need to know and document the traditional knowledge base of the settlers and others which are unique to the Island setting.

Shri P. Subramanyam, PCCF underlined the significance of resource description and one should be aware of the areas where the resources are existing. The value of documenting the floral, faunal wealth of the Islands and the knowledge base for effective conservation and utilization of resources were highlighted.

Dr. K. Ravichandran, APCCF outlined the steps taken by the A&N Administration in biodiversity conservation, creation of People's Biodiversity Registers, its updation and the need for capacity building and awareness programmes among various stakeholders at village level, a press release from Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) said.

Local body schools under the scheme. Students are selected for award of scholarships through an examination conducted by the State/UT Governments. The scheme is boarded on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). Scholarships are disbursed directly into the bank accounts of students by electronic transfer through Public Financial Management System (PFMS) following DBT mode. 100% funds under the scheme are provided by Central Government.

This is a continuing scheme and since launch of the scheme in 2008-09, 22.06 lakh scholarships have been sanctioned till 2020-21 involving an expenditure of Rs. 1783.03 crore.

It is proposed to disburse scholarships to 14.76 lakh students with the financial outlay of Rs.1827.00 crores approved for the scheme.
