

Chief Secretary orders to conduct surprise inspection at all commercial establishments & hotels to ascertain technical parameters, power demand & consumption

Team of Officers raided Hotels, Saw Mills, Commercial Establishments and IMFC Residential Societies

99 residential flats found tapping electricity through illegal means

Port Blair, May 24

Keeping in view the frequent power disruptions and its rising demand in the city, Shri Jitendra Narain, Chief Secretary, A & N Administration directed that several teams consisting of Senior Officers of Administration, Revenue, Police and Power Department be constituted who have been ordered to conduct surprise inspection at all commercial establishments and hotels to ascertain their technical parameters, power demand and consumption.

In pursuance to these directions, the Senior Officers from A & N Administration, District



Administration, Police and Electricity Department has conducted inspections and raids at Hotels, Saw Mills and Commercial establishments along with Residential Societies to check the connected load, peak demand and consumption to address the problem of load shedding and frequent power disruption.

The Residential Society constructed by IMFC was



(Rural Development) and Shri Singh Piyush Vijaykaran, Joint Secretary (Vigilance) and it has been found that the flats situated at Teylarabad (Block-I & Block-II) has a total number of 120 flats, out of which, 34 were metered and 58 flats are tapping electricity through illegal means and 28 are under construction.

During inspection of IMFC Housing Society at Garacharma, it has been found that out

of 75 flats, 34 flats are having metered connection whereas 41 flats are tapping electricity through illegal means. The theft of electricity shall be booked under clause 135 of Electricity Act, 2003.

The private saw mills situated at Bathubasti, Garacharma and Dhanikhari were also raided by the team and it was found that some saw mills have installed under rated Current Transformers (CT)

thereby manipulating the meter readings. The theft of electricity have been noted which shall be booked under clause 135 of Electricity Act, 2003.

The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration has issued warning and advisory to all the hoteliers and owners of commercial establishments to judiciously use the power during peak hours and meet their power requirement by using DG Sets to mitigate the power crisis being experienced in Port Blair and adjoining areas.

Acting earnestly to resolve the power crisis, the Chief Secretary also

In pursuance of the instructions of Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain to conserve rainwater, Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) has launched the 'Blue Pipe Project' for urban rainwater harvesting. It is a novel community based Rainwater Harvesting initiative which utilizes existing building roofs and existing wells to recharge ground water.



Under this project, the neighborhood rooftops are connected to the nearby community wells in the area so that rainwater flows directly into the well

instead of the drain. This water recharges the ground water table by slowly seeping into the ground from well. This also allows the citizens with older

buildings to participate in rainwater harvesting and conserve rain water. PBMC's artists have also painted the well and its

surroundings with slogans under 'Blue Pipe Project', to spread awareness on rain water harvesting. Currently, 14 community wells in well and its

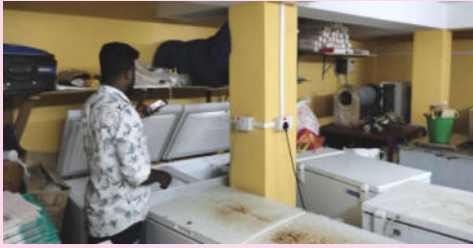
Food Safety Deptt. carries out surprise inspections of Ice Cream manufacturing units at Port Blair

Six major ice cream manufacturing units inspected; improvement notices issued to all units for proper rectification of violations observed

Port Blair, May 24

The Food Safety Department, A & N Administration carried out surprise inspections of Ice Cream manufacturing units at Port Blair today, during which, major ice cream manufacturing units of the city were inspected. The Food Safety Regulators checked the sanitary and hygienic conditions, good manufacturing and hygienic practices followed at the premises. They also inspected the labeling conditions and other relevant provisions of Food Safety and Standards Act, Rules and Regulations made there under.

Altogether six major ice cream manufacturing units were



inspected. Several deviations from the Food Safety Standards Act, Rules and Regulations were noticed. Improvement notices are being issued to all the units for proper rectification of the violations observed within a

time period of 14 days and to submit compliance report, failing which, punitive actions against the violators will be initiated as deemed fit under the provisions of Food Safety and Standards Act, Rules and

Regulations.

The Commissioner of Food Safety/ Deputy Commissioner has warned all stakeholders to abide by the Food Safety Act, Rules and Regulations and adhere to Good Manufacturing and Hygiene Practices as per the Food Safety Licensing & Registration of Food Business Regulations, 2011, failing which, stringent actions will be initiated against the violators. The Food Safety Department is committed to ensure the availability of safe and hygienic food to the Islanders. in 29 fixed COVID Vaccination Centres (CVCs) across these Islands which administers Covishield to all Health Care Workers, Frontline Workers and 60+ population with Precautionary Dose, Covaxin to children of 15 to 18 years of age and Corbevax to 12 to 14 years as is being done across the country.

It is mentioned that A&N Islands has already achieved 100% target coverage for Covishield for its 18+ population long back and stood second in the country to achieve the target second to Lakshadweep Islands.

With regards to Covaxin, the Islands has already achieved the feat in achieving the target for first dose and it's time to cover the left out children of 12 to 14 years of age with corbevax.

Those in the age group between 18 to 59 years and intending to get the Precautionary Dose may visit the Pvt. CVC at Port Blair and get themselves vaccinated after paying requisite fees as prescribed by the Govt.

During the week long campaign of 'Har Ghar Dastak 2.0' which will continue till May 31, 2022, the Health Care Workers will visit house to house along with ASHA and Anganwadi workers to find out and vaccinate the missed out beneficiaries. The entire process is being supported by the functionaries of the District Administration and the local bodies.

People have been appealed to cooperate and voluntarily come forward to take their doses as per their eligibility so that the Islands can be made COVID free and also to safeguard any future outbreaks. This will also ensure free movement of people in the territory of the Islands, a press release from DHS said.

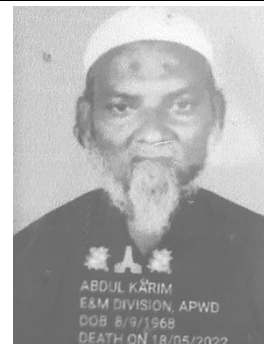
