

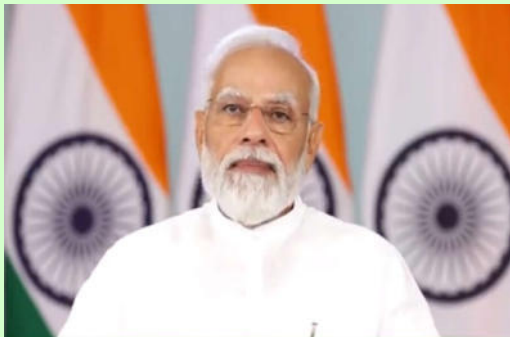
## PM addresses inaugural session of International Conference on Disaster Resilient Infrastructure

**We remain committed to meeting the needs of the poorest and the most vulnerable by building next generation infrastructure to realize their aspirations: PM**

New Delhi, May 4 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the inaugural session of the fourth edition of the International Conference on Disaster Resilient Infrastructure via video message today. The session was also addressed by Hon. Scott Morrison MP, Prime Minister of Australia, H.E. Nana Addo Dankwa Akufo-Addo, President of Ghana, Hon. Fumio Kishida, Prime Minister of Japan and H.E. Andry Nirina Rajoelina, President of Madagascar.

At the outset, Prime Minister, Shri Modi reminded the gathering that the solemn promise of the Sustainable Development Goals is to leave no one behind. "That is why, we remain committed to meeting the needs of the poorest and the most vulnerable by building the next generation infrastructure to realize their aspirations", he said. The Prime



Minister said that infrastructure is about people and providing them high quality, dependable, and sustainable services in an equitable manner. "People must be at the heart of any infrastructure growth story. And, that is exactly what we in India are doing", he said.

As India is scaling-up the provision of fundamental services in India in the areas of education, health, drinking water, sanitation, electricity, transport and much more, said the Prime Minister, "We are also tackling climate change in a very direct way. That is why, at COP-26 we

have committed to attain 'Net Zero' by 2070, in parallel with our developmental efforts."

The Prime Minister talked about the importance of infrastructure in unleashing the human potential and said that damage to infrastructure leads to lasting damage for generations. In the context, the Prime Minister asked "with modern technology and knowledge at our disposal, can we create resilient infrastructure that is built to last?" Recognition of this challenge underpins the creation of the CDRI, he said. He also noted that the coalition has expanded and made valuable contributions. He mentioned the initiative on 'Infrastructure for Resilient Island States' that was launched at COP-26 and CDRI's work on Resilient Airports studying 150 airports around the world. The

## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 11,857 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, May 4

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,76,702 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,438 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs and 11,857 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group

of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 20423.

A total of 561 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 293 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 8 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 (Contd. on last page)

## Electricity Deptt. appeals general public, commercial & Govt. establishments, hoteliers to judiciously use power

Port Blair, May 4

The sudden rise of 5-6 MW power demand in Port Blair and South Andaman is experienced due to hot and humid weather condition and thereby injudicious use of power. In view of this, the Electricity Department is forced to exercise load shedding of 45 minutes to 1 hour on rotational basis. To bail out from the present situation, the Electricity Department in a press release has

appealed to all general public, commercial establishments, Govt. establishments and hoteliers to judiciously use the power. In addition, all commercial establishments shall switch off their ACs, Hoteliers shall operate on their DG sets and Industrial units shall close their operation from 1700 hrs to 2300 hrs during peak hours and extend their cooperation to the Department, the release added.

## Cable TV operators warned against illegal use of electric poles

Legal action would be initiated against violators

Port Blair, May 4

It is noticed that several cable TV operators are using the electric poles for stringing and tying their cable TV wires sometimes bunch of cables with big loops and fixing some boxes on it unauthorizedly and sometimes use power supply from illegal sources for boosting signals, knotting the cables to electricity poles

unauthorizedly not only violating Indian Electricity Rules and Electricity Act 2003, but also compromising on safety aspect and danger to life on account of haphazardly pulling of cable TV wires over electric poles,

Further, cable TV wires/ cables tied on electricity poles are causing hindrance and difficulties in various

terms to the electricity staff in carrying out electric maintenance works on respective electric poles. Moreover, any accident can occur to the cable TV operators who are not at all authorized to climb on the electric poles.

All the firms/persons indulging in such types of illegal use of electric poles have been strictly advised (Contd. on last page)

## SAFETY TIPS ON CYCLONE PREPAREDNESS

(For Cyclone, Heavy Rain, Water Logging, Flash Flood etc.)

1. Listen to radio or TV weather reports for warning & advice and be alert.
2. Identify safe shelters in your area. These should be cyclone resistant and also find the closest and safe route to reach them.
3. All your family members should know the safe routes to nearest shelter/raised pucca buildings.
4. Keep your emergency kit and basic food supply, medicines, torch and batteries etc. ready in waterproof bags. Drink preferably boiled water. Keep your food items covered.
5. Doors, windows, roof and walls should be strengthened/checked before the cyclone season through retrofitting and repairing. Store adequate foodgrains and water in safe places.
6. If your area is flood-prone, consider suitable flood resistant building materials.
7. Do not let children and pregnant woman remain empty stomach.
8. Put furniture, clothing and valuable items etc. on a higher platform so that they can be shifted safely/easily.
9. Do not use electrical appliances, which are in flood water.
10. Do not go into water of unknown depth and current.
11. Do not allow children to play in, or near flood water.
12. Do not venture into the sea if so advised. Stay indoors under the strongest part of the house if not moved to the cyclone shelter.
13. Remain indoors until informed that weather has improved.
14. In case of cyclone alert, do not go out, till officially advised that it is safe. If evacuated, wait till advised to go back. Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush/panic.
15. Be careful of broken/uncovered power lines, damaged roads and houses, fallen trees etc.
16. Be careful of snakes, as snake bites are common during floods.

- > Keep your emergency kit and basic food supply, medicines, torch and batteries etc. ready.
- > Doors, windows, roof and walls should be strengthened before the cyclone season through retrofitting and repairing. Store adequate food grains and water in safe places.
- > Conduct Mock Drills for your family and the community.
- > Do not venture into the sea Stay indoors under the strongest part of the house if not moved to the cyclone shelter.
- > Remain indoors until advised that the cyclone has passed away.
- > Do not go out till officially advised that the safe. If evacuated, wait till advised to go back.
- > Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush.
- > Be careful of broken powers lines, damaged roads and house, fallen trees etc.

Companies Act 1956/2013, primarily a Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as defined in the MSME Act, 2006 having over 51% stakes by the Indian Citizen / NRI / OCI and Head Quarter in India.

Individual Innovators will also be encouraged to apply (research & academic institutions can use this category to apply). However, release of funds shall be subjected to compliance of eligibility conditions for either Startup or MSME before agreement signing. More than one organization can jointly submit the application in partnership with consortium, registered societies & Academia. Collaboration with Academia / R&D Organization is highly encouraged.

Under the scheme, financial support will be provided to those projects/ideas who have reached at least 'Proof of Concept (PoC)' level. Financial support will be provided to the beneficiary in the form of grants. Extent of Milestone based Grant in aid from Proof-of-concept stage for Startup: upto Rs. 50 Lakhs, MSMEs: upto Rs. 2 Crore, Consortium: upto Rs. 10 Crore.

The last date for applying under the Scheme is May 18, 2022 and direct link for application form is dcis.dot.gov.in/registration.aspx and the website is dcis.dot.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Industries said.

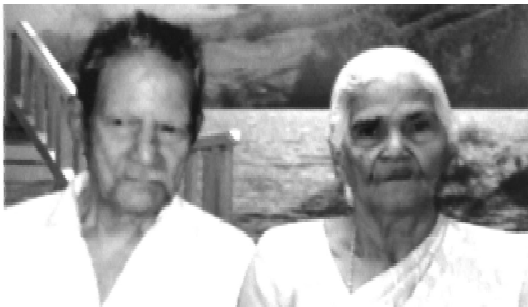
