SAFETY TIPS ON CYCLONE PREPAREDNESS

(For Cyclone, Heavy Rain, Water Logging, Flash Flood etc.)

- 1. Listen to radio or TV weather reports for warning & advice and be alert.
- 2. Identify safe shelters in your area. These should be cyclone resistant and also find the closest and safe route to reach them.
- 3. All your family members should know the safe routes to nearest shelter/raised pucca buildings.
- 4. Keep your emergency kit and basic food supply, medicines, torch and batteries etc. ready in waterproof bags. Drink preferably boiled
- water. Keep your food items covered.
- Doors, windows, roof and walls should be strengthened/checked before the cyclone season through retrofitting and repairing. Store adequate foodgrains and water in safe places. 6. If your area is flood-prone, consider suitable flood resistant building materials.
- Do not let children and pregnant woman remain empty stomach
- Put furniture, clothing and valuable items etc. on a higher platform so that they can be shifted
- Do not use electrical appliances, which are in flood water. 10. Do not go into water of unknown depth and current.
- Do not allow children to play in, or near flood water.
- 12. Do not venture into the sea if so advised. Stay Indoors under the strongest part of the house/
- if not moved to the cyclone shelter. 13. Remain indoors until informed that weather has improved.
- 14. In case of cyclone alert, do not go out, till officially advised that it is safe. If evacuated, wait till advised to go back. Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush/panic. 15. Be careful of broken/uncovered power lines, damaged roads and houses, fallen trees etc.
- 16. Be careful of snakes, as snake bites are common during floods.

- Listen to radio or TV weather reports and be alert.
- Identify safe shelter in your area. These should be cyclone resistant and also find the closest route reach them
- Keep your emergency kit and basic food supply, medicines, torch and batteries etc. ready. Doors, windows, roof and walls should be strengthened before the cyclone season through
- retrofitting and repairing. Store adequate food grains and water in safe places.
- Conduct Mock Drills for your family and the community.
- Do not venture into the sea Stay Indoors under the strongest part of the house if not moved to the cyclone shelter.
- Remain indoors until advised that the cyclone has passed away.

DoT launches DCIS Scheme for providing ...

Companies Act 1956/2013, primarily a Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as defined in the MSME Act, 2006 having over 51% stakes by the Indian Citizen/NRI/OCI and Head Quarter in India.

Individual Innovators will also be encouraged to apply (research & academic institutions can use this category to apply). However, release of funds shall be subjected to compliance of eligibility conditions for either Startup or MSME before agreement signing. More than one organization can jointly submit the application in partnership with consortium, registered societies & Academia. Collaboration with Academia / R&D Organization is highly encouraged.

Under the scheme, financial support will be provided to those projects/ideas who have reached at least 'Proof of Concept (PoC)' level. Financial support will be provided to the beneficiary in the form of grants. Extent of Milestone based Grant in aid from Proof-of-concept stage for Startup: upto Rs. 50 Lakhs, MSMEs: upto Rs. 2 Crore, Consortium: unto Rs. 10 Crore.

The last date for applying under the Scheme is May 18, 2022 and direct link for application form is dcis.dot.gov.in/registration.aspx and the website is dcis.dot.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Industries said.




