The Ministry of Labour & Employment, New Delhi has launched a registration module/portal i.e. e-SHRAM for creation of a comprehensive National Database of Unorganized Workers (NDUW) for all types of Unorganized Workers such as Construction Workers, Migrant Workers, Domestic Workers, Agricultural Labourers, MGNREGA Workers, GIG Workers, Self-Employed Workers, Street Vendors, Shop Keepers, ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, Fishermen, Unorganized Plantation Workers, Milkmen and similar other sub-group of

Unorganized Workers. In A&N Islands, 2346 unorganized sector workers have registered themselves in the portal as on date. The Secretary (Labour & Employment) reviewed the progress of registration of unorganized workers on e-SHRAM Portal and instructed all concerned to speed up

the entire process of registration by motivating all the stakeholders.

Meanwhile, to facilitate the Unorganized Workers to get themselves registered on e-SHRAM Portal, the Labour Department has set up Facilitation Centre in the Office of Labour Commissioner, Supply Line. In this context, it is appealed to all Unorganized Workers (those who aged between 16-59 years, not a member in EPF/ESI and not an Income Tax Payee) to get themselves registered at e-SHRAM Portal. ## No positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight & inter-island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)

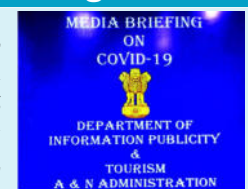
Port Blair, Nov. 9

## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Safe use of fruits and vegetables to avoid chemical residues

With advancement in agricultural technologies, there is an increased use in agrochemicals (pesticides, synthetic fertilizers, herbicides etc.) to improve crop productivity, reduce wastage. Pesticides are group of chemicals applied for protection against pests and diseases however, pesticides can cause problems if they are consumed by humans often they are cause of carcinogenesis, immunotoxicity, neurotoxicity, reproductive dysfunction, endocrine disruption, developmental disabilities, skin conditions, and respiratory diseases. Main route of pesticides entry into the human system is through ingestion of food. So, proper handling of the food items will reduce their inadvertent entry into our human system. For most pesticides, a minimum time between spraying and harvesting of produce will ensure safe food. However, when pesticides are not applied according to Good Agricultural Practices (GAP), may leave harmful residues, which ultimately involve possible health risk. Such residues in food commodities can be decreased or removed by various simple techniques prior to consumption. Washing is the most common method which removes surface residual on the product. Almost 75 to 80 percent of pesticide residues are removed by cold water washing. The fruits like grapes, apples, guava, plums, mangoes, peaches and pears and vegetables like tomatoes, brinjal and okra should be washed thoroughly as they might carry more residue in their crevices. However, certain residues cannot be removed by washing. Washing them with 2% of salt water will remove most of the contact pesticide residues that normally appear on the surface of the vegetables and fruits. Washing with 10% vinegar is also found useful in removing the surface residues. Treating vegetables in warm water for a short while will remove any leftover residue. Peeling or removing the skin of the vegetables or fruits is highly efficient to remove residues. The removal of the excess fat and skin for animal products like chicken or meat could reduce the unwanted pesticide residues absorbed on them. Thermal processing treatments like pasteurization, blanching, boiling, cooking, steaming, canning, scrambling etc. are effective in degradation of various pesticides depending upon the type of pesticide and length of treatment. Other simple tips include changing the vendor regularly will also helpful in reducing the exposure to any harmful residues.

**Benefit:** Farmers and consumers are unknowingly using and consuming pest treated fruits and vegetables imported from the mainland. Simple decontamination techniques will enable the larger public to safely consume fruits and vegetables.

Services trade surplus was \$89 bn in FY 2020-21 and it has been the largest FDI recipient (53% of FDI inflows 2000-2021).

The theme of the Global Services Conclave 2021 was 'India Serves: Exploring Potential Growth Sectors Beyond IT/ITes'. Emphasizing that Service sector is our competitive advantage, powered by Skills, Startups and IT Solutions, the Minister said that today, Indian services have the twin power of universal acceptance & universal attraction.

The Minister listed certain crucial sectors which can catapult India's services sector on a high growth trajectory such as higher Education. He observed that students from US, Canada etc. prefer India for heritage, art and culture studies.

The Minister assured that the Government was actively pursuing market access opportunities (FTAs) and working on a scheme alternative to SEIS. He said that the Government supported service sector through Aatmanirbhar Bharat Package, collateral-free Automatic Loans for Businesses, including MSMEs. Rs. 56,027 Crore was released under various Export Promotion schemes.

Charting the way forward, the Minister said that we must introduce more standards & improve quality. We must move up the value chain in services and pick areas where our strength lies and expand on that, he said. He also said there is a need to expand markets for Legal/Accounting professionals.

Ingredients	Quantity
Cooked horse gram	- 2 cups (60 gm)
Tamarind / lemon juice	- 20 gm/ 1 spoon
Tomatoes	- 1 chopped
Curry leaves	- 5-6 (5 gm)
Garlic paste	- 2 tea spoons
Pepper-cumin seeds paste	- 2 tea spoons
Mustard seeds	- 1 tea spoon
Salt	- to taste ( 1 tea spoon)
Cooking oil	- to season (5 ml)

No. of servings: 2-3 bowls (300-400 ml)

Method of preparation

Clean wash and soak horse gram for 4 hours. Steam, cool and drain the substrate. Heat 1 tea spoon of oil/ghee in a pan, add mustard seeds, curry leaves and red chillies, allow to splutter. Add chopped tomatoes and sauté till they are soft. Add 2 tea spoons of garlic paste and sauté till raw smell goes off, add tamarind and salt and boil. Jaggery, black pepper, cumin seeds, lemon juice, curry leaves are optional. Add horse gram substrate. When the mixture boils and cooks remove from the flame mash well and serve hot.
