PortBlair, Oct21: After a report published in this daily about violation of the provisions of the Municipal Building By e-laws 1999 by almost every division of the Andaman and Nicobar Command andamaration knoode Commandian in the city, the Municipal Council last month held a meeting with representable se ofthe Andaman and Nicobar Command, Andaman Public Works Department and civic officials. But, the Andaman and Nicobar Commandhad during the meeting agreed to cooperative with the civic body and comply with the provisions of the Online Building Plan Approval System (OBPAS) mandatory forall the cases coming under the vicinity of Port Blair Airfield area. But to the dismay of the civic agency, not a single proposal has been placed by the defence forces seeking approval of the civic agency since the crucial

meeting.
"There are several defence projects that are coming up indifferent parts of the city while many others." are under the execution stages. In all the construction projects, the otherwise 'disciplined' defence agencies have completely ignored the provisions of the Municipal Building regulations. While it is imperative for all government agencies to abide by the provisions of the Building By e-laws, which has certain riders for defence agencies, the Andaman and Nicobai Command has all these years chosen to blatantly ignore the rules. chosen b biatanty ignore the rules.

India's business world

First they came for a Tanishq ad - and the mighty Tata empire did not stand up to a communal campaign against an image of an inter-faith home. A year later, the mob has trained its outrage on Fabindia, for advertising a festive collection ins ountage on Faulus, in autoreting a resurve contention that it called Jashn-e-Riwaz. The public display of bigotry was endorsed by BJP MP from Bengaluru, Tejasvi Surya, who accused the clothing brand of "Abrahamising" the Hindu festival of Diwali, and warmed it of "economic costs". Other self-styled defenders of Hinduism plunged into this riticulous buttle be defenders of Hinduism plunged into this riticulous. battle by doing a close reading of the foreheads of the models in the ad— and rejecting them because they did not wear binds. Instead of shrugging off this absurd campaign, Fabindia has withdrawn the ad.

That Hinduism and Hindus need to be defended against a phrase in Urdu — a language born in the north Indian heartland, one of 22 scheduled languages listed in the Constitution, spoken and written by freedom fighters and poets, lovers and lyridsts, a strand entwined in the DNA of poets, overs and yndrists, a strain entwined in the DIVA or this diverse country— is a lauphable proposition. But gathers menace in the hands of an indignant mob that tweets first, thinks later. It becomes dangerous when hate and bigotry are so easily amplified by social meda— and when the right to take offence is licensed by politicians who, it appears, wish only to speak the language of polarisation and divisiveness.

And so, a mob of trolls, intent on toching the shared ritual

and common ground of diversity, grows into a vigilante for

True, such intolerance feeds on the complicity of

politicians such as Surya and the dispiriting lack of trust in the state to defend the citizen or the businessman. But it is also emboldered by the silence of the biggest names of India Inc. who have enormous resources to defend themselves. Their reticence will not buy them a reprieve — it will not protect the retucence will not only item a septement—it will not procest the bottom line nor prevent a campaign of calumny, as the recent tarring of Infosys as "arti-national" or the labelling of Fabindia, as stolid an example of indigenous "Make in India" enterprise as any, as "anti-Hindu" reveal. It is time for corporate India as a whole, and not just individual businesses, to look hard at the balance sheet of such capitulation, to realise that the mob will not stop at one ad. By deleting "Jashne-Riwaaz"— Urdu for a "festival of tradition"— or scrapping an ad campaign in the hope of muting the mob, it shrinks the space for both freedom and enterprise. And paves the way for another salvo from the bullies of new India.

MUSLIM MARRIAGE IS A CONTRACT AND NOT SACRAMENT UNLIKE A HINDU MARRIAGE, SAYS KARNATAKA HIGH COURT

Bengaluru, 1st Oct, 2021: The Karnataka High Court has held that the Muslim marriage is a contract with many shades of meaning, not a sacramentunikea Hndumarriage and does not repel certain rights and obligations arising from its dissolution.

The case pertains to a petition filed by Ezazur Rehman (52) in

Family Court in Bengaluru on August 12, 2011. 12, 2011.

Rehman had divorced his wife
Saira Banu by uttering Talaq on
November 25, 1991, months after the
marriage with a Mehr' of Rs 5,000
After the divorce, Rehman then



became the father of a child. Banu then praying to quash an order passed by the First Additional Principal Judge of filed a civil suit for maintenance on August 24, 2002

August 24, 2002.

The family court ordered that the plaintiff is entitled to monthly maintenance at the rate of Rs 3,000 from he date of the suit till the death of the plaintiff or till she gets remarried or edeath of the de

Dismissing the petition with a cost of Rs 25,000, Justice Krishna S Dix it in his order dated October 7 said "'marriage is a contract has many shades of meaning; It is not a sacrament unlike a Hindumarriage, is

Elaborating further, Justice Dix it said a Muslim marriage is not a sacrament, does not repel certain rights and obligations arising from it

"Such a marriage dissolved by

div orce, per se does not annihilate all the duties and obligations of parties by

theouses and obigations or parties by lock, stock and barel," the berch noted. The Judge said the marriage amongst Muslims begins with the contractand graduates bothe status as it ordinarily does in any other community. This very status gives rise to certain justiciable obligations. They are ex contractual," the court said.

In law , new obligations too may nisw, new obligations too may arise, of them being the circumstantial duty of a person to provide sustenance to his ex-wife who is destitute by divorce. Quoting verses from Surah Al Bakra in Qur'an, Justice Dixit said a pious Muslim owes a moral and religious duty to provide subsistence by selections.

to his destitute ex-wife. The court said a Muslim ex-wife has a right to main tenance subject to satisfying certain conditions, is

indisputable.

In Islamic jurisprudence, as a general norm, Mehr, that is dower, is treated as consideration for marriage, the court said adding that it may be a prompt dower' pay able before the wife is called upon to enter the conjugal domicile or it may be a 'deferred dower' pay able on the dissolution of marriage.

"Ordinarily, the right of an ex-wife

"Ordinarily, the right of an ex-w ife to maintenance does not ex tend bey ond 'ibdat'. I should hasten to add that Islamic jurisprudence has not treated this as thumb rule ever, although there is some juristic opinion in variance," Justice Dixit

"This norm has to be subject to the "I his norm has to be subject to the rider that the amount paid to the ex-wife, be it in the form of "Mehr" or be it a sum qualified on the basis of 'mehr', or otherwise, is not an inadequate or illusory sum," the judge noted.

air quality.
In Delhi, levels of particulate matter measuring 2.5 microns or less in size (PM2.5), which pose a serious health risk, often reach lev els that are 17 times higher than the World Health Organisation's designated safe limit. The city, meanwhile, has put several measures in place to tackle

the problem.

instrumental in the battle to curre emissions and keep climate change under control.

Calculating CO2 and other GHG emissions is usually achieved by looking at consumption data – how much fuel factories, households and traffic have consumed in any given period - and then ex trapolating from there. Often this information only becomes available after a

A better idea would be to directly measure levels of GHGs in the atmosphere in real time. Not only would this provide an up-to-date picture of air quality at any given time, but by placing a great many

network, the source of the GHGs could be determined.

determined.
Such a dense sensor network is being established in Glasgow, host city to the COP26 summit in November, as part of a pilot project between the University of Strathc ly de and Glasgow City Council, within the framework of the Global Environmental Measurement and Environmental measurement and Monitoring Initiative (GEMM), an international project of Optica (formerly OSA) and American Geophysical Union (AGU). Other partners include Stanford University, the University of California, Berkeley (UC Berkeley), the Met Office and the National Physical Laboratory.

A similar initative will get underway A similar initiative will get underway in Delhi following an agreement between the Dehi Pollution Control Committee and IT Kanpur for a "real-time air pollution source apportionmentand forecasting for advance air pollution management" project.

Collecting air samples is only one part of the picture, how ever. These then need to be combined with atmospheric need to be combined with atmospheric transport models to help understand where air is coming from and to separate natural sources of GHGs from man-made ones. The data generated by the sensors need to be interpreted and inverse modeling

techniques used to identify the sources of CO2 samples that have been observed.

This information would offer city leaders and policy makers a much more detailed picture on the sources of GHGs and provide near-instantaneous insight into the effects of any decisions they take to tackle emissions and pollution.

During COVID-19 lockdown in California, the BEACO2N network recorded a 25 per centreduction in CO2 emissions in the San Francisco Bay Area due to a 50 per cent drop in road traffic. It was a demonstration of the utility of such
