Delay in supply of LPG refills trouble households in Brookshabad, Brichgunj & Dollygunj

Port Blair, Nov 22: Delay in supply of cooking gas cylinders since Sept 26 is taking a toll on consumers at Brookshabad, Brichgunj and Dollygunj in South Andaman. Any disruption in the supply of LPG refills means a harrowing time for a household and the reasons cited by distribution agencies supplying the essential

commodity offer them no comfort. Consumers in the areas are fuming over the delay in supply of the cooking gas forcing them to face

hardships.
As per reports, cooking gas
was distributed in the areas last on
Sept 26. Reason cited for the delay
in supply of LPG refills was lack of
cylinders with the distributors.

However, the stock of LPG cylinders was reportedly replenished in the last week of October. But the distribution agencies have till date failed to supply cooking gas refills in the areas.

The Maharashtra government gave the 9,000 subordinate striking engineers of the State Electricity Board an ultimatum to resume duty within 24 hours or "face the consequences". Shooting down of upgraded F-16 by a MiG-21 was a rarest of the rare incident in the military's aviation

8,000 feet, approaching Indian airspace. Wing Commander Varthaman locked on the target at a

The upgraded MiG-21 Bison was on combatair patrol at 15,000 feetwhen itspotted an F-16 Falcon at

60-degree angle and launched the R-73 air-to-air missile, which hit the aircraft.

According to military observers, in the 51 years of the MiG's existence, this is the first time it had shot down an F-16. Missile misfiring from F-16 is also said to be rare.

Varthaman was captured by Pakistani forces after his parachule was landed in their territory. But he was returned after 60 hours in captivity.

"Despite being captured by the enemy, he continued to display ex ceptional resolve in dealing with the adversary in a stoic, brave and

adversary in a stoic, brave and dignified manner till he was repatriated on March 1, 2019," the citation said.

Varthaman was posted at Srinagar Air Force station, but his MiG-21 Bison squadron received a message that a large Pakistani air force fighte jets package was detected towards Line of Control. Despite knowing that Pakistan air force jets of F-16 were armed with advanced Bey ond Visual Range (BVR) air-to-air missiles and modern air-to-ground stand-off weapons, he hopped on to his jet to

Should govt apps use facial recognition tech? Experts weigh in

When the Meghalaya government launched a mobile app in July to verify persioners' identible using facial recognition technology, it led to criticism over privacy concerns. In response to a legal notice from Jodhpur-based law student Jade-Jermiah Lyngdohflagging privacy concerns with the Presponers Life Certifican() verification are "Pensioner's Life Certification Verification" app, the state gov ernment said the use of FRT was notmandatory. Those had concerns could opt out they said.

The InlemetFreedom Foundation (IFF),
a digital liberties organisation, was among
those that have aised concerns that invasive
technologis like FRT could be misused. They have called for a law to stop the government from using personal data.

Other experts feel file technology has huge potential if deployed correctly, as contactless technology has become indispensable in the post-pandemic world,
Research has shown that facial recognition technology has limitations. Therisk elements of facial recognition include the

elements of facial recognition include the possibility of racial discrimination, the risk of identity fraud the risk of hias and the risk of

identity traud, the risk ofbias, and the risk of errors in bechnology, "says Aarthy Venkat, Senior Legal Advisor of SignDesk.
"In India and around the world, FRT adoption as part of efforts to boost digital transformation has been extensive. How ever, and bechnolous that can be invested around. any technology that can be invasive requires regulations ensuring risk mitgation," Venkat says, adding that there needs to be a procedure for rolling out FRT projects with safeguards against misuse of the technology and steps to ensure the rights of the data subjects are

protected.

"Even the proposed data protection bill, in its current form, is not sufficient to protect the rights of individuals in case of misuse of FRT or to address the grievances of data subjects. A decide de quelon governing he use of FRT for usecases in he government sector is he need of the hour. There needs to be a Data Protection Impact Assessment (DPA) to be conducted by regulators before adopting FRT and the publishing of DPIA reports in the public domain. There is also a requirement to effectively spell out Data Subject Rights and Grievance procedures and create provisions for close-quarter monitoring of deploy ed projects. Due to the massive potential benefits of FRT, a complete ban on its usage would be counterproductive, however, adequate steps for safeguarding cifizens' rights should be taken by publishing

cizers inglis slouble that by guisting guidelines, rules and regulations for the use of this technology," says Venkat.

Businesses and gov errments may also see FRT as a way of lowering security expenses or improving services by providing a reliable identification and authentication. reliable identification and authentication ethod, online and offine. But, there is still a lot that needs to be worked upon in the field of FRT. "While FRT has the potential to promote

innovation in many different sectors, it is important to underline that facial recognition important to underline that facial recognition algorithms are a work in progress and they remain far from perfect. The accuracy of systems depends on factors like the environment, ageing for the subject, their emotions, dissimilarities between the compared images in terms of lighting conditions, camera distance, background head orientation and size of the face in the image," ex plains Jayanth Tadinada, an Al expert and Chief Technology Officer at Mobius.

The real worry is a situation like that in China, where FRT has become all-pervasive. "Unlike other forms of biometric authentication, consent is very hazy. We do not know where the cameras are and whether we are being tracked by the governmentor private entities.

Moreover, we donotknow, and might never Moreov er, we do notknow, and mightnever know how that data is processed, correlated and used to discern new and potentially damaging information about us.

Experts point out that the use of FRT goes against the General Data Protection

Regulation (GDPR) guidelines being adopted by developed countries. "The government needs to assure us abouthow it aims to store and use such critical data, do we have the infrastructure to protect the priv acy and data of millions of users, " says Tushar Chhabra. CEO and Co-founder, CRON AI.

Though a few experts have praised the step by the Government of Meghalay a to lev erage technology to provide convenience to the end-users at allower cost, they also

to the end-users at allower cost, they also agree with the IFF's observations.
"IFF has raised some valid points here. Data security and error rates in FRT seem to be a major concern of the government. On this, I can only thirk of a quote by Steve Jobs: 'Sometimes when you innovate, you make mistakes.' It is best to admit them quickly, and geton with improving your other innovations," remarked Vikas Singhania, CEO at TradeSmart.



MOON'S TOP LAYER ALONE HAS ENOUGH OXY TO SUSTAIN 8 BILLION PEOPLE FOR 1.00.000 YEARS

In October, the Australian Space Agency and NASA signed a deal to send an Australanmade rower to the moon under the Artemis program, with a goal to colect unar rocks that could ultimately provide breathable oxygen on the moon.

Although the moon does have an Attrough the moon obes have an atmosphere, it's very thin and composed mostly of hydrogen, neon and argon. It's not the sort of gaseous mixture that could sustain oxygen-dependent mammals such as humans.

That said, there is actually plenty of oxygen on the moon. It just isn't in a gaseous form. Instead it's trapped inside regolith—the layer of rock and fine dust that covers the moon's surface. If we could extract

the moon's surface. If we could extract oxygen from regolith, would the enough to support human life on the moon?

Oxygen can be found in many of the minerals in the ground around us. And the moon is mostly made of the same rocks you'll find on Earth (although with a slightly conference of the same forks to the same forks the same forks the same forks.) greater amount of material that came from

Minerals such as silica, aluminium, and iron and magnesium oxides dominate the moon's landscape. All of these minerals contain oxygen, but not in a form our lungs

On the moon these minerals exist in a few different forms including hard rock, dust, gravel and stones covering the surface. This material has resulted from the impacts of

material has resulted from the impacts of meteorites crashing into the lunar surface over countless milennia. Some people call the moon's surface layer lunar "soil", but as a soil scientist I'm hesitant to use this term. Soilas we know it is pretty magical stuff that only occurs on Earth. It has been created by a vast array of

organisms working on the soil's parent material—regolith, derived from hard rock— overmillions of years. The result is a matrix of minerals which

re not present in the original rocks. Earth's soil is imbued with remarkable physical, chemical and biological characteristics



surface is basically regolith in its original, untouched form

You might be familiar with this if you know about electrolysis. On Earth this process is commonly used in manufacturing, such as to produce aluminium. An electrical current is passed through a liquid form of aluminium is passed through a liquid borm of aluminium oxide (commonly called alumina) via electrodes, to separate the aluminium from the oxygen. In this case, the oxygen is produced as a byproduct. On the moon, the oxygen would be the main product and the aluminium for other metal) extracted would be contacted would. be a potentially useful byproduct. It's a pretty straightforward process,

but there is a catch: it's very energy hungry. To be sustainable, it would need to be supported by solar energy or other energy sources available on the moon.

Extracting oxygen from regolith would also require substantial industrial equipment. We'd need to first convert solid metal oxide into liquid form, either by applying heat, or heat combined with solvents or electrolytes.

heat cambined with solvents or electrolytes.
We have the technology to do this on Earth, but moving this apparatus to the moon—and generating enough energy to run it—will be a mighty challenge.
Earlier this year, Belgium-based

startup Space Applications Services announced it was building three experimental reactors to improve the experimental reactors to improve the process of making oxygen viaelectrylss. They expect to send the technology to the moon by 2025 as part of the European Space Agency's in-situ resource utilisation (ISRU) mission. That said, when we do manage to pullit off, how much oxygen might the moon actually deliver? Well, quite a lot as it turns out. Now let's assume the

average depth of regolith on the moon is about ten metres, and that we can extract all about territeires, and that we can extract an of the oxygen from this. That means the top ten met res of the moon's surface would provide enough oxygen to support all eight billion people on Earth for somewhere around 100,000 years.

This would also depend on how Ihis would also depend on how effectively we managed to extract and use theoxygen. Regardless, this figure is pretty amazing! Having said that, we do have it pretty good here on Earth. And we should do everything we can to protect the blue planet—and its soil in particular—which continues to support all terrestrial life without us even trying. The Conversation

May abunder. Nov 22: Unwarranted delay in disbursement of EPF pension is taking a toll on subscribers in Mayabunder, Some pensioners used to gettheir pension from EPF office. But the benefithas notbeen paid to them since the last nine months as the financial assistance has not been credited in

theirBank account, as per reports.
As per reports, the EPF pensioners hav etheir accountin the Cooperative Bank branch at May abunder. Around 20 to 25 persons who have been given pensioner from Mayabunder, has not received their pensions. They have received their last EPF pension in the month of February, 2021. Since then, the pensionary benefithas not been credited in their bank accounts. Many of them suffering from various critical diseases and many belong to poor sections settled in remote

areas about 30 km aw ay from Mayabunder like Ghanadabla. May abunder like Ghanadabla, Kalapahad, Rehill and other remote areas. All the pensioners depend on the meager amount of EPF pension for their living and for medical teatment. Once in a three or four morths, they visit the nearest Cooperative Bank hoping to obtain the financial benefit, but are forced to return disappointed.
When contacted, the EPF

office at Port Blair stated that there are some errors in the date of birth in Adhaar Card and PAN Card or other any documents etc due to other any documents etc due to which the EPF pension could not be credited in the bank account. Before February 2021, the pensioners obtained their pension every month but now there pension has been stopped since February 2021. Pensioners have urged the authorities in the administration to address the grievances
