

PM attends 28th National Human Rights Commission Foundation Day programme

India's freedom movement and its history has been a great source of inspiration for human rights: PM

The whole world sees our Bapu as a symbol of human rights and human values

New Delhi, Oct. 12 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi attended 28th National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) Foundation Day programme today through video conference. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister remarked that India's freedom movement and its history have been a great source of inspiration for human rights and the values of human rights for India. "As a nation, as a society we resisted injustice-atrocities, we fought for our rights for centuries. At a time when the whole



world was engulfed in the violence of World War I, India suggested the path of 'rights and non-violence' to the whole world. Not only India but the whole world sees our Bapu as a symbol of human rights and human values", said the Prime Minister remembering Mahatma Gandhi. Even when, on many occasions, the world was disillusioned and confused, India remained steadfast and sensitive towards human rights, he added.

The Prime Minister said that the concept of human rights is closely



related to the dignity of the poor. He said when the poorest of the poor does not get an equal share of the Government schemes then the question of rights arises. The Prime Minister enumerated the Government's efforts to ensure the dignity of the poor. He said when a poor person gets toilets ensuring freedom from open defecation, he gets dignity, similarly, a poor man who was hesitant to enter a bank, gets a Jan Dhan account, which ensures dignity, he said. Similarly, measures like Rupay Card, Ujjwala gas connections, and

pucca houses for women are major steps in that direction.

Continuing with the listing of measures, in the past few years, the Prime Minister said that the country has also tried to remove the injustice happening at different levels in different sections. "For decades Muslim women had been demanding a law against triple talaq. We have given new rights to Muslim women by enacting a law against triple talaq" the Prime Minister said. Many sectors have been opened for women and

Vaccination- shield against the virus

4, 59,796 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

Port Blair, Oct.12

As per the data available, the percentage of cumulative population vaccinated so far in Isles stands at 72.90%. With 1831 eligible beneficiaries vaccinated today, the number of doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

has gone up to 4, 59,796 in A&N Islands. The cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose so far is 2,91,600 (101.96%) while beneficiaries vaccinated with second dose till date is 1,68,196 (57.68%).

Meanwhile, 707 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 89 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 902 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which,

Passion Fruit: nutritious easy fruit crop for Island cropping systems

Passion fruit is a tropical vine, native to South America and being cultivated commercially in most part of tropical and subtropical areas for its sweet-sour, aromatic fruit pulp for fresh consumption as well as juice making. Wide variability has been observed for sweetness of pulp. The fascinating passionflower types exhibit most beautiful flower parts comprising ornamental types too, attracts pollinating insects to the growing garden thereby aiding all other component crops in a cropping system. Passion fruits are round or oval, attractive yellow/red/purple/green coloured, shiny peel. The fruits are soft to firm, interior filled with juicy pulp embedded with numerous seeds. The fruit pulp is consumed either fresh or used for juice making. The juice is added to other fruit juices to enhance aroma and taste. The characteristic aroma of the pulp makes the consumer to feel consuming many other fruits. The ripe pulp provides good number of calories and contains dietary fibre, vitamins, and minerals. The climate of Andaman and Nicobar Islands is suitable for commercial cultivation of passion fruit as component crop in plantation based cropping systems or in home gardens or in community gardens on fences, terraces etc. Passion fruits require very less care and could be easily grown in the islands with minimum requirement of inputs. In pandals and trellis system, the fruit yield is observed to be higher. Year-round fruiting will give the additional income for the island farmers. Observations revealed that the passion fruit types (purple and light-yellow peel) conserved at ICAR-CIARI commence first flowering in about 9 to 12 months and recorded almost year-round production of fruits on pandals and on fences. The yield ranges from 50 to 150 fruits per vine in the first year and subsequently higher depending on the growing status. Systematic cultivation of passion fruit in our islands could improve the production and marketing of fruits for consumption and value addition. The availability of passion fruit products would enhance nutritional security among the island communities. ICAR-CIARI has conserved passion fruit plants and regularly multiply and sell the planting material to the needy farmers.

Benefit: The climate and soil in the whole of Andaman and Nicobar Islands is highly suitable for passion fruit production. Diversification of island agriculture through crops such as passion fruit would improve the profitability from unit area and ensure nutritional security in remote places.

it has been ensured that they can work with security round the clock. He said India has ensured 26 weeks of paid maternity leave for career women, a feat that even many developed nations could not achieve. Similarly, the Prime Minister listed the measures by the Government for trans-genders, children and nomadic and semi-nomadic communities.

Recalling the inspired performance of the para-athletes in the recent Paralympics, the Prime Minister said that in recent years laws have been enacted for the Divyang Jan. They have been connected to new facilities. Buildings are being made, divyang friendly and language for divyang is being standardized.

Shri Modi said that during the pandemic, poor, helpless and senior citizens were given direct financial support in their account. Migrant labourers were spared much hassle due to the implementation of the One Nation-One Ration Card.

The Prime Minister cautioned against the selective interpretation of human rights and using human rights to diminish the image of the country. He said of late, some people have started interpreting human rights from their own angle as per their selfish interests. Tendency to see infringement in one situation and not in a similar situation has damaged human rights a great deal, he said. He also said that the biggest infringement of human rights takes place when they are seen from the prism of politics and political profit and loss. "This selective behaviour is equally damaging for democracy too", cautioned the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister said that it is important to understand that human rights is not associated with rights only but is a subject of our duties too. Saying "rights and duties are two tracks on which the journey of human development and human dignity takes place, he stressed that duties are equally important as rights and they should not be discussed separately as they complement each other.

The Prime Minister concluded by mentioning the human rights of future generations. He emphasized that with measures like International Solar Alliance, renewable energy goals and Hydrogen Mission, India is rapidly moving in the direction of sustainable life and eco-friendly growth.
