With a view to keep strict check on encroachments on Govt. land, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain has directed the Deputy Commissioners of all the three Districts of A&N Islands, to create database of all encroachments on Government land in their jurisdiction, especially by the rich, powerful, outsiders and greedy people with the help of public within one week.

In this regard, the Deputy Commissioners have also been asked to create database of encroached land surrendered as a precondition for registration of sale deed and accordingly, the Administration shall take action for allotment of such land, as per land allotment policy under

various schemes viz. PMAY etc.

Further, the Deputy Commissioners

have also been asked to share the database/list of encroached Government land with the Housing & Estate Department and action shall be initiated by the concerned agency to evict the encroached Govt. land as per law in a time bound manner. The database of encroached land surrendered while execution of sale deed along with request for allotment of land pending consideration may be shared with the Revenue Department for taking further necessary action.

Draft rules for safety provisions for a child carried on a motor cycle

New Delhi, Oct. 26 (PIB)

Section 129 of the Motor Vehicles Act stands amended by the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act 2019, dated 09.08.2019. The second proviso in the section is - "Provided Further that the Central Government may by rules provide for the measures for the safety of children below four years of age riding or being carried on a motor cycle".

The Ministry has made draft rules vide GSR 758(E) dated Oct. 21, 2021, recommending - For children below four

years, safety harness shall be used for attaching the child to the driver of the motorcycle.

The driver shall ensure that the child pillion passenger aged between 9 months and 4 years must wear his/her own crash helmet which fits his/her head or wear bicycle helmet complying with [ASTM 1447/ [European (CEN) BS EN 1080/BS EN 1078] till such time that the specifications are prescribed by the Bureau of Indian Standards under the Bureau of Indian Standards (Contd. on last page)

Review of revamping GIA scheme in process

Port Blair, Oct. 26

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration with a vision to support imparting of quality education to the minority sections of the society has been extending Grant-in-Aid to the tune of 95% of the total pay and allowances of the teaching and non-teaching staff to the Muslim Education Society Senior Secondary School, Stewartgunj.

Till date, Grant-In-Aid to the tune of Rs. 43.39 Crores has been released to this school since the year 1987 onwards. Although the endeavor has been to continuously extend the support, however during recent inspections conducted by the Department and also in the

Local Fund Audit conducted by the Chief Pay & Accounts Office, it has been noticed that in spite of the continuous support extended to this school, the school management has failed on its part to maintain the required infrastructure and fulfill its obligations as part of the Grand in Aid Rules 2018. It was also noticed that the MES School has engaged teachers over and above the prescribed norms of teacher engagement as per the Right to Education Act, 2009. There is also shortage of classrooms viz-a-viz the total number of classes they were running. There was improper maintenance of bill register, pay bill register, stock register, GPF ledger as well as

Utilization Certificate Register. The management has completely failed to adhere to the prescribed guidelines for proper accounting of the GIA released by the Administration. The requirement of filing of audited statement of account every year to the Administration was also not followed. Management has even failed to execute the duties bestowed on him under statutory provisions of Income Tax Act. It was noticed that Income Tax at source was not deducted in proportionate monthly installments in every quarter.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 4,84,500 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

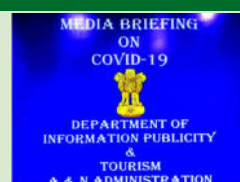


Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Heliconiawagneriana commonly known as Easter Heliconia

Heliconiawagneriana is commonly known as Easter Heliconia. This is an evergreen, perennial, rhizomatous, erect, herbaceous species growing to a height of 1.5 - 3.0 m. The leaves are alternate, oblong with pointed apex, green in colour and the sheathing tubular foliar bases forming a 1-1.5 m long flattened pseudostem. The inflorescence is sessile, 45 cm long, erect spike, waxy, overlapped at the base and wholly wrapping the rachis. Bracts are of Pinkish red colour with pale yellow edge and green margins. The bracts secrete a liquid that gathers in the cavity besides rainwater. This species is highly adapted to grow in humid tropical and subtropical climate and preferably in shaded condition. This species is a short-day plant and can be a suitable intercrop in plantation based cropping system with peak flowering during summer season. The shelf life of the spike is 10-15 days. The popular varieties in the species are H.Wagneriana Cv. Rainbow, H. wagneriana Cv. Turbo and H. wagneriana Cv. Big Red

Benefit: Heliconiawagneriana has huge ornamental potential as cut flower and in landscape horticulture with prolonged flowering habit. It can also be grown in spacious pots for decoration of patios and balconies.

AUDITORS' REPORT

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

Report on financial statements: We have audited the financial statements of 'Andaman & Nicobar State Cooperative Bank Limited' Port Blair, Andaman which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31st 2021, the Receipts and Payments Account and Income & Expenditure Account for the Year then ended.

Key Audit Matters

Impact of COVID-19 on Audit – Due to outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19 and consequent country wide Lockdown enforced by the Government of India and A&N Administration due to which we could not carry out the normal audit procedure by visiting any of the bank's branches except the banks Port Blair Branch and the Bank's Head Office, the audit was carried out in a limited manner using 'Work from head office' approach and on a test check basis of the documents and the details available at the bank's Head Office. This is considered as key audit matter, since alternative audit procedures were performed for carrying out the audit.

How to audit addressed the key audit matter

- Due to "Work from Head Office" approach adopted, we performed following alternative audit procedure:-
- Remote access to the Bank's financial accounting Software in Presence of the Bank's Head Office Officials.
 - Various data, Documents and confirmations were received electronically through e-mail.
 - For various audit procedures, reliance was check basis of the documents, details and information available on the extent possible under the pandemic conditions.
 - Interview / discussion with the client via call conferencing and other verbal communications.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statement: Management is responsible for preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and Cash flows of the institution in accordance with the accounting standards generally accepted in India. This responsibility includes the design, Implementation and maintenance of Internal Control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the Financial Statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility: Our responsibility to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with standards on Auditing issued by the institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Financial Statements are free from material mis-statement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the Auditors' Judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material Mis-statement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Opinion: In our opinion, and to the best of our information and according to the explanation given to us, the financial statements gives the information required by the act in the manner so required as give a true & fair view in conformity with the accounting Principles generally accepted in India.
