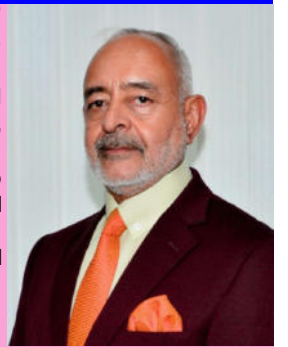

will be addressed in a speedy manner.
