The long felt need for establishment of an Old Age Home for women in A&N Islands has been fulfilled with the coming up of one such facility at Attam Pahad. Established by the Directorate of Social Welfare,



A&N Administration and aptly titled as 'Ullas' - an Old Age for Women was inaugurated befitting the occasion marking International Day of Older Persons today by the Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Social Welfare, Ms Nandini Paliwal, IAS as chief guest. The function was attended by elderly womenfolk, Zilla Parishad, Adhyaksha, South Andaman, Smti. Pramila Kumari, Secretary (GA), Shri Binay Bhushan, IAS, Secretary-cum-Director (Social Welfare), Ms. Ranjana Deswal, field functionaries of Social Welfare Department - Anganwadi Workers

and Officers / Staff of the Department.

Soon after unveiling the plaque to mark the inauguration, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary inspected the facilities provided in this Old Age Home which includes spacious bedroom, toilets, recreation hall etc and has a capacity to house 15 beneficiaries. COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Oct. 1

Four COVID positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, of which, 3 were from incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 15 flights with 2593 passengers arrived, out of which, 2269 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 294 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 57 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 31 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 27 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

India defeated Sri Lanka by 41 runs in their opening match of Women's T20 Asia Cup at Sylhet in Bangladesh. Chasing a target of 151 runs, Sri Lanka were bundled out for 109 runs in 18.2 overs. Earlier, put into bat, India posted 150 runs in the stipulated 20 overs. Jemimah Rodrigues was the top scorer with 76 runs and Harmanpreet Kaur contributed 33 runs. In the opening game of the tournament, earlier in the day, defending Champions Bangladesh beat Thailand by nine wickets.

Bangladesh is hosting women's international match after four years. A total of seven teams -India,

Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Malaysia and the United Arab Emirates - are competing for the title. The teams will play each other in a round-robin format, where each will play six games. The top four teams will reach the semifinals.

After being held as a 50-over tournament between 2004 and 2008, the Asia Cup moved to the T20 format in 2012. The tournament was last held in Kuala Lumpur in 2018, where Bangladesh defeated India in a tight final to clinch the title in 2018. India has won two out of three T20 editions. Interestingly, when it was played in a 50-over format, India won all four titles.

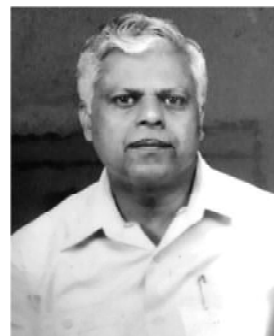
