Vice President addresses 85th Anniversary of Brahma Kumaris Vice President calls for developing spiritual mindset in the society; says 'life is incomplete without spirituality'

New Delhi, Oct. 25 (PIB) The Vice President, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today emphasised the need for developing spiritual mindset among individuals, families and society as a whole to root out impropriety, immoral conduct and negativity from the nation. Opining that "life is incomplete without spirituality," Shri Dhankhar said that the technological transformation currently underway across the world will have a better impact on people's lives if it is infused with spirituality.

The Vice President made these remarks while addressing the 85th Anniversary of Brahma Kumaris and Deepawali



Celebrations on the theme 'सशक्त, समृद्ध और स्वर्णिम भारत की ओर' (Towards a Strong, Prosperous and Golden India) at Brahma Kumaris World Headquarters, Mount Abu in Rajasthan today. On this occasion, Shri Dhankhar termed spirituality as an essential part of our

education that "makes a person a complete person," and lauded Brahma Kumaris for promoting spirituality and Dharma (righteousness) across the world. Praising the New Education Policy-2020 for laying emphasis on Indian civilizational values, he observed that "the right education, right thinking and the right knowledge can only make us powerful as a nation."

Describing Brahma Kumaris as an epicentre of Indian cultural values, Shri Dhankhar said that "the noble thoughts of world welfare & world happiness emanate from here." He also praised Brahma

Kumaris for planting over two million saplings to combat climate change and called it 'an organisation of unparalleled dimensions that exemplifies the virtues of not only humanity but entire living beings on the planet.'

Mentioning a series of affirmative steps and farsighted initiatives in recent years, the Vice President said that India is on the move like never before and urged the media to highlight and "celebrate the rise of India".

Economic stability to be at the heart of new agenda: UK's new PM Rishi Sunak

New Delhi, Oct. 25 Former Finance Minister, Mr Rishi Sunak has become Prime Minister of the United Kingdom this evening. He met King Charles III at Buckingham Palace, who accepted the resignation of Liz Truss. In a constitutional monarchy, the monarch plays a ceremonial role in appointing Government leaders.

In his first speech, Sunak said that the UK is facing a profound economic crisis and that he has been chosen to take office to fix some of Liz Truss's mistakes. Speaking to the public from outside No 10



Downing Street, he said trust is earned, and he will earn yours. He said, together we can achieve incredible things.

Sunak at the age of 42 is the youngest British leader in more than 200 years. He is expected to immediately begin appointing a Cabinet and getting to grips with an economy sliding toward recession. The third Conservative Prime Minister this year, he will also try to unite a governing party that is riven with divisions.

Sunak was selected as leader of the Governing Conservative Party yesterday as it tries to stabilize the economy, and its own plunging popularity, after the brief, disastrous term of Liz Truss. (Source: india.gov.in)

Port Blair, Oct. 25 The Department of Industries is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Prime Minister's Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprise (PM FME)' launched by Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan with the objective to strengthen backward/ forward linkages, common infrastructure, packaging, branding & marketing of products pertaining to micro food processing enterprises. Under this scheme, financial assistance in the form of credit-linked subsidy @ 35% of the eligible project cost

with a maximum ceiling of Rs. 10.00 lakh per unit would be provided to Individual Entrepreneurs/ Proprietorship Firms/ Partnership Firms/ Farmer Producers Organization (FPOs)/ NGOs/ SHGs/ Co-operatives/ Pvt. Ltd. Companies who have established or propose to establish micro food processing unit.

The scheme is implemented through the District Resource Persons engaged for each district to provide handholding support to

micro-food processing enterprises including assistance in preparation of Detailed Project Report, documentation and getting bank loan.

The modified eligibility criteria to avail the benefits are as under:

- > Existing or new micro food processing enterprises for expansion/upgradation of existing micro food processing enterprises or setting up of new micro food processing enterprises.
- > Beneficiary

contribution should be minimum 10% of the project cost.

- > Applicant should be above 18 years of age.
- > Applicant/enterprise those who have availed bank loan under other Subsidy Linked Scheme of Govt. are also eligible for bank loan under this scheme. Applicants are also eligible for interest subvention and top-up convergence with other relevant Government Sponsored Scheme.

'National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme' for academic session 2022-2023 State Institute of Education to conduct NMMSS exam in A&N Islands on Dec.17

Port Blair, Oct. 25 The State Institute of Education, Port Blair will be conducting the NMMSS Examination in A&N Islands on 17th December, 2022 under the guidance of Ministry of Education (MoE). The selection test/examination will be conducted to select students presently studying in Class VIII for award of Scholarship under the centrally sponsored scheme 'National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme' (NMMSS) for the academic session 2022-2023.

Students who have secured minimum 55% marks or equivalent Grade in class VII examinations (relaxable by 5% for SC/ST candidates), presently studying in Class VIII in

Government, Govt.-Aided and Local Body Schools of State/UT and whose parental income does not exceed Rs.3.5 Lakh per annum from all sources are eligible to appear in NMMSS Examination.

The students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and Residential Schools run by State Government

and Private unaided Schools are not eligible for scholarship under the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS).

For NMMSS examinations, students have to produce mark statements of the qualifying examinations (i.e. Mark statement of class-VII for NMMSS examination). To

appear in the NMMSS Examination students should produce parental income certificates issued from Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar concerned with their application forms. Category certificate are also to be produced by the candidates who come under reserved categories.




