The Central Government is committed towards the welfare of the people of A&N Islands and focusing more on development and employment opportunities, said the Hon'ble Minister of State for Information & Broadcasting and Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Gol, Dr. L. Murugan while interacting with the media persons at a press conference held at BJP Bhavan here today.

Addressing the scribes, the Minister stated that the Prime Minister's Flagship schemes aims at uplifting the socio-economic status of the last mile beneficiary by bringing them under the fold of such welfare schemes. The Minister mentioned that under Jal Jeevan Mission, the UT of A&N Islands have achieved 100 percent coverage by providing 62,000 tap connections. Under the PM Awas Yojana (Grameen), 1338 houses needs to be constructed and so far, 90 percent work has been completed. For development of Amrit Sarovars, 40 to 45 percent work has been completed which is



being done through MNREGA, the Minister said. He further said, 8596 Kisan Credit Cards (KCC) have been provided to the beneficiaries of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries and they are availing the benefits of KCC. Residents can update their Aadhaars by uploading supportive documents either online through myAadhaar portal or offline by visiting the nearest Aadhaar centre. Aadhaar number has emerged as a universally accepted proof of identity of residents in India. More



than 1100 Government schemes and programmes including 319 run by the Central Government use Aadhaar-based identification for the delivery of services. Ministry of Electronics and IT said that it is in the interest

of the residents to keep their Aadhaars updated with current proof of identity and proof of address. Keeping the documents in Aadhaar updated helps in ease of living, better service delivery, and enables accurate authentication. (Source: india.gov.in)

**Registration, Diagnostics, Treatment fees at National Institutes, Composite Regional Centres to be waived off for Divyangjan from Jan. 1, 2023**

New Delhi, Dec. 25

The Government has said that Registration, Diagnostics and Treatment fees at National Institutes and Composite Regional Centres will be waived off for Divyangjan from Jan. 1, 2023. The fee will be waived for those who have Unique ID for Persons with Disabilities (UDID) cards and

those who have disability certificates and are enrolled on the UDID portal.

In addition, the full course fee will also be waived off in various courses at such institutes and centres. This will be effective for 2022-23 batch students onwards, including those who are doing two years or more duration courses and

are in their 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year. Further, each National Institutes and Composite Regional Centres have been instructed to have a dedicated counter to help Persons with Disabilities in filing UDID applications and to provide treatment facilities to all persons on Saturday and Sunday also. **India recover from the brink to defeat Bangladesh, wins test series 2-0**

Dhaka, Dec. 25

India recovered from the brink to defeat Bangladesh by 3 wickets to win the 2<sup>nd</sup> and final test of the 2-match series at the Shere Bangla National Stadium, Mirpur, Dhaka on Sunday. Chasing the score of 145, India resumed the day from a bleak 45-4 in the second innings on the fourth day of the match requiring 100 runs for the victory. However, the scare set in when India lost three more wickets to reach 74-7

with the pair of Shreyas Iyer and Ravichandran Ashwin on the crease.

The two batsmen saved the Indian side and coasted it to a three wicket win with 71 run partnership for the 8<sup>th</sup> wicket. Shreyas remained unbeaten at 29 off 46 balls, while Ashwin scored 42 off 62 balls helped by a spilled catch by Mominul Haque when he was at 1. In India's first innings score of 314 also, Shreyas Iyer made a powerful 87 off 105 balls.

The victory at Dhaka

gave India a clean sweep of 2-0 against Bangladesh in the two match series after losing the one-day series 2-1 to the host country earlier.

Mehidy Hasan Siraj gave a superb performance with the ball claiming five wickets for 63. R Ashwin garnered 6 wickets in the match and was adjudged player of the match. Cheteshwar Pujara was honoured with the player-of-the-series award for scoring 222, which included a century.

efforts related to Yoga, Ayurveda and traditional treatment methods on social media.

Prime Minister emphasised that India has eradicated diseases like Smallpox, Polio and 'Guinea Worm'. He spoke about Kala Azar, another disease that is about to be eradicated. The parasite of this disease is spread through the sting of the sand fly. 'Kala Azar' can happen to anyone from children to elders. Till recently, the scourge of Kala-azar had spread in more than 50 districts across four States. Prime Minister noted with satisfaction that this disease is confined to only four districts of Bihar and Jharkhand at present. He expressed confidence that the awareness of the people of Bihar and Jharkhand will help the Government's efforts to eliminate 'Kala Azar' from these four districts as well. He said that the treatment of 'Kala Azar' is simple and the medicines for this are also very effective.

Prime Minister also discussed the 'Jalaj Ajeevika Model', which has been prepared to keep Biodiversity in mind. This Tourism-based Boat Safaris has been launched at 26 Locations. Prime Minister said that Namami Gange is showing a new path to everyone in the direction of environmental protection. He gave the example of Sange Sherpa of Thegu village of Sikkim. For the last fourteen years, he is engaged in the work of environmental protection at an altitude of more than 12 thousand feet. Sange has taken up the task of keeping the Tsomgo Lake clean. The lake is of cultural and mythological importance. Now, about five lakh tourists visit the place every year to see this clean lake. Sange Sherpa has also been honored by many organizations for this unique effort to conserve Tsomgo Lake. Shri Modi lauded that due to such efforts, Sikkim is today counted among the cleanest States of India. Touching upon the topic of 'Swachh Bharat Mission', Prime Minister said many unique efforts have been made by the people since its inception in 2014. He highlighted that these efforts are being made not only within the society but also on part of the Government. He pointed out that due to the removal of garbage and unnecessary items, a lot of space opens up in the offices. Prime Minister elaborated that a lot of effort was made in offices of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting in cities including Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Kolkata, and Shillong to clean up the space. He said that this has led to entire floors being available for usage.

Prime Minister said art, literature and culture are the collective capital of the society, and it is the responsibility of the whole society to take them forward. He spoke of one such successful effort being made in Lakshadweep. A club on Kalpeni Island - Kummel Brothers Challengers Club - inspires the youth to preserve the local culture and traditional arts. Here, the youth are trained in the local art of Kolkali, Parichakli, Kilipaath and traditional songs.

Prime Minister greeted the nation on the occasion of Christmas. He said it is a day to remember the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. He also remembered former Prime Minister, Atal Bihari Vajpayee on his birth anniversary. He called the former Prime Minister a great statesman who gave exceptional leadership to the country.

Prime Minister said that "Veer Bal Diwas" will be celebrated tomorrow. He will participate in a programme dedicated to the martyrdom of Sahibzada Zorawar Singh and Sahibzada Fateh Singh in Delhi on this occasion. He said, the country will always remember the sacrifice of Sahibzade and Mata Gujri.

Prime Minister asked people to send their suggestions for the topics to be taken up in the 100<sup>th</sup> episode of Mann Ki Baat. He also wished the listeners a Happy New Year 2023. He cautioned people that COVID-19 is increasing in many countries of the world. He urged everyone to take more precautions like masks and hand washing. People from different parts of Telangana appreciated today's Mann Ki Baat. Harikrishna from Jaishakar Bhupalaply inspired by Prime Minister, Shri Modi said, Yoga is helping breast cancer patients to reduce their problems. Harikrishna said, everybody should help in eradicating Kala Azar from the country. (Source: india.gov.in)
