New Delhi, Sept. 27

Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh has called upon the Indian defence industry to identify and manufacture state-of-the-art cost-effective products and technologies to realise the vision of a New India. He said, this will not only cater to the needs of the country, but also fulfills international requirements. Shri Singh was addressing the 5th Annual Session of Society of Indian Defence Manufacturers in New Delhi today.

He said, the Government is constantly working towards bolstering all dimensions of national security to take the country to greater heights. Shri Singh said, seven to eight



years ago, the country's defence exports were not even one thousand crore rupees, which has now crossed to 13 thousand crore.

children reported breathing difficulties, anxiety, panic attack, nausea and giddiness. The students were treated effectively and stabilized within 30 minutes by the Paediatricians, Physicians, Psychiatrists and other health staff and all were kept in observation throughout the night. As they recovered and no unwanted incident happened in the night, all were discharged the next morning.

Blood investigation of all the children were normal. An onsite epidemiological survey of Govt. Model Sr. Sec. School, Port Blair was conducted by Preventive and Social Medicine Department (PSM), ANIMS and the issues related to food supply were checked, mebendazole tablets and bad odour in the school were ruled out.

Considering the sequence of events which occurred on the unfortunate day, the possibility of panic attack leading to mass hysteria could be considered, a press release from MS, GB Pant Hospital said.

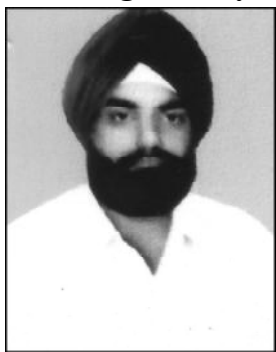

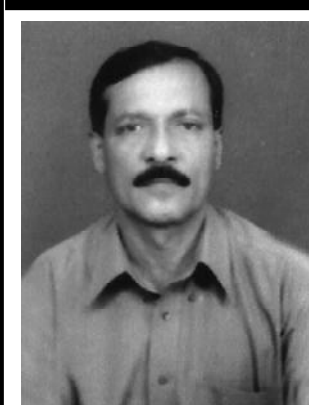
