PM's 'Mann Ki Baat' prog. over AIR

India has become one of the biggest solar power generating nation: PM

Invites Start-ups and Innovators to take advantage of huge opportunities in space sector

New Delhi, Oct. 30

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today asserted that India has become one of the biggest countries to generate electricity from solar energy. Addressing the nation in his 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio this morning, the Prime Minister said the whole world is looking at solar energy as the future. He stressed that India is combining her traditional experiences with modern science in this field. He further stated that solar energy is changing the lives of the poor and middle class of the country. Shri Modi also mentioned that several IITs are working together on a multilingual project that makes learning local languages easier. This project will help the new National Education Policy in achieving those goals as well.



The Prime Minister said that National Unity Day will be observed tomorrow, on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. On this day, Run for Unity is organized in every corner of the country. He said, this race strengthens the thread of unity in the country and inspires the youth.

Prime Minister said that the space sector was earlier confined within the purview of Government systems. But revolutionary changes started coming in since the space sector was opened for India's youth. Indian industries and start-ups

are engaged in bringing new innovations and new technologies in this field. The Prime Minister said that the collaboration of IN-SPACE is going to make a big difference in this area. The Prime Minister also spoke about the scope of student power, saying it is the basis of making India powerful. He expressed confidence that when India celebrates her centenary, this power of youth will take India to the heights that the country is working on today. Providing social and financial security to girl child under 'Dulari Scheme' in Isles

Girl child born on or after 26.01.2013 eligible to get benefit under the Scheme

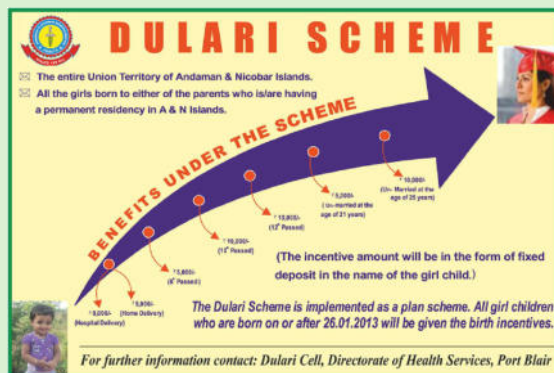

Port Blair, Oct.30

Dulari Scheme, a Govt. of India scheme, envision encouraging birth of girl child, is being implemented as a plan scheme effectively in A&N Islands'. Launched on Jan. 26, 2013 in A&N Islands, the scheme is aimed to reduce the gap in sex ratio to the replacement level of Net Reproduction Rate (NRR) i.e. 1 by ten years after implementation of the scheme whichever is earlier.

The objective of the scheme is to reduce the gap in sex ratio to a replacement level of NRR, to encourage birth of girl child in A & N Islands, to provide social security to the newly born girl child, for her education and marriage, to adopt delayed marriage practices in respect of girl child and to encourage adoption of hospital delivery practices.

As per the present scheme, the girl child born on or after 26.01.2013 can avail their



benefit under the scheme and the girl child who have passed 8th Standard for the academic session of 2012-2013 onwards will also be eligible from the category of education incentives of this scheme.

All the girl born to either of the parents who is/are a permanent resident of A & N Islands are eligible for availing benefit provided under Dulari scheme viz. Benefits at Birth (Hospital Delivery or Home Delivery) Rs.8,000/- & Rs.5,000/- respectively. Rs.5, 000/- will be provided to the girl child on passing VIII standard, Rs.10, 000/- on passing X standard & Rs.10, 000/- on passing XII standard, Rs.5, 000/- unmarried at the age of 21 years and Rs.10, 000/- unmarried at the age of 25 years.

Declaration was adopted in the special meeting of the Committee held in New Delhi on Saturday. In the Delhi Declaration, the Committee has urged all Member States to ensure zero tolerance towards terrorism, consistent with their obligations under international laws, including human rights law,



international humanitarian law and international refugees law. It has called for taking urgent action to prevent and counter terrorism in all its forms and manifestations through the full and effective implementation of Security Council resolutions and other relevant international instruments relating to terrorism. The Declaration reaffirms that terrorism should not be associated with any religion, nationality, civilization or ethnic group. It has also called upon Member States to fulfill their obligations enshrined in relevant international counter-terrorism conventions and protocols to which

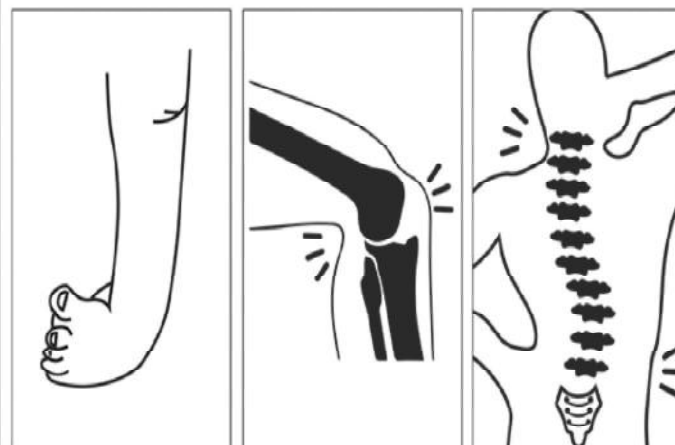
