that they are the future generation and they should practice this in their day to day life and contribute in preserving the species which are on the verge of extinction. "We should not destroy nature for greed whether it is through poaching or illegal activity. Our approach should not be shortsighted rather we should share the planet with the notion that wildlife has also got equal rights to survive on this planet," she said adding that we should not disturb the chain. Summing up her address, she said, the message of conservation of wildlife should not be confined to the week alone; it should be done on regular basis.

Speaking on the occasion, the Secretary (Education) highlighted the role of students in disseminating the message of Wildlife Protection to the masses. She expressed hope that the activities to be organized during the week will certainly help in creating greater awareness about wildlife conservation and conveyed the support of Education Department in the initiative.

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (ANI) and PCCF (WL), Dr. R. S. C. Jayaraj, IFS highlighted the importance of Wild Life Week observance and the activities chalked out to create awareness about conservation and protection of wildlife. This year, World Wildlife Day is celebrated with the theme "Recovering key species for ecosystem restoration", to draw attention to conservation of some of the most critically endangered species of wild fauna and flora.

Earlier, Conservator of Forests (HQ), Shri Sanjay Waradkar welcomed the gathering. The Deputy Conservator of Forests (WL), Shri Birendra Choudhary proposed the vote of thanks.

A skit depicting the growing need to conserve and protect wildlife was presented by the trainees of Wimberlygunj Forest Training School on the occasion. According to section 49 of the said Act, motor vehicle owners must notify the registering authority of their new change of residence or place of business, failure to do so, will result in penalties under the MVA Act 2019. Rule 39 of ANIMVR, 2006 states that when any motor vehicle which is not registered in the UT is kept for more than 14 days, the owner must inform the Registration Authority, A & N Islands, providing information such as his name, address, registration number, description of the vehicle, and date of issue of permit (in case of transport vehicle).

It is imperative that all motor vehicle owners who registered their vehicles in other States but brought them to A & N Islands inform this office within 14 days of the change of address in order to avoid legal action. Such owners are also advised to keep documents related to transportation of their vehicles to this UT for verification.

Despite being published in local newspapers on earlier occasions, such vehicles continue to ply on the road in violation of the law. Transport Department has once again advised all owners of vehicles registered in other States to inform the details of their vehicle along with their complete contact information to Transport Department, A&N Islands in compliance to Section 49 of MV Act, 1988 and Rule 39 of ANIMVR. Failure to comply with these legal provision will attract penal action, a press release from Transport Department said.
