

Forest offences detected; Padauk timber seized by Forest team

Port Blair, Feb. 4

On credible information received at Range Office, Mobile Squad on 03.02.2024 regarding occurrence of a forest offence inside the Jirkatang RF area, a team of Mobile Squad was constituted and pressed into search operation for detection of the Forest Offence. The team carried out intensive search in the suspected area and found a fresh Machan and seized 17 pieces (0.4815 cbm) of hand sawn Padauk timber and a 6" pit saw from the spot. Though the offenders could not be apprehended, a case has been registered under relevant sections

of IFA, 1927 and investigation is on to nab the offenders.

In another instance, the Forest officials of Mobile Squad, Wimberlygunj, acting on a tip off, seized a fresh dug out portion of timber with the frame work of a dinghy concealed near the bank of Malapuram Nallah, Mannarghat on 01.02.2024. However, no offenders were found on the spot. A case has been registered under relevant sections of Indian Forest Act, 1927 and is under investigation.

The detection of these forest offences and seizure of forest products was possible due to the hard work

and concerted efforts of the Forest officials namely Shri John William, Range Officer, Shri Uttam Kumar Mistry, Forest Guard, Shri Keshabananda Ganguly, Forest Guard, Shri Paul Mark, Mazdoor, Shri Ganesh Sahoo, Mazdoor and two DRMs.

A&N Police issues public advisory on fraudsters using Armed Forces personnel details to perpetrate financial cyber frauds

A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters impersonate Indian army personnel to exploit the goodwill associated with the Armed Forces to siphon off money from innocent victims who have advertised to put their property (House, Flat, Rooms, etc. on rent) on the popular house renting websites/apps, real estate database website or social media websites, etc.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard oneself:

➤ Always remember that entering OTP is a requirement for sending money, not for receiving



it.

➤ If an unknown person makes contact for renting your house, flat, or rooms, etc., try to confirm his/her identity from other available methods/sources.

➤ Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize, if a request seems too urgent.

➤ Avoid relying on conversations and identity details provided by unknown people on messaging apps, house renting platforms, etc.

➤ Scrutinize every transaction request made

to you from people unknown to you.

➤ Cautiously perform transactions on various online transaction platforms, aware yourself with all the features of payment gateway.
