Port Blair, Nov. 5

Rural Development is indeed a multifaceted process aimed at improving the quality of life and economic well-being of people residing in rural areas. The Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs, established in 1983, plays a crucial role in supervising, monitoring, and implementing various poverty alleviation programs in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

In Andaman & Nicobar Islands, there are 9 blocks consisting of 70 Gram Panchayats and 7 Tribal Councils. The Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs is implementing various rural developmental projects/schemes of Government of India in these Gram Panchayats and Tribal areas for the welfare of the rural populace. During the preparation of Gram Panchayat Development Plan, various developmental works proposed by the general public and Line Departments are prioritized and approved by the respective Gram Sabhas and kept as shelf of works under respective scheme/project. The Government of India has introduced several schemes to address different aspects of rural development, catering to housing, sanitation, employment, livelihood, governance and infrastructure. The Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj is implementing these schemes of Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Panchayati Raj and Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation with the objective to enhance the quality of life and financial well-being of individuals, specifically living in remote rural areas of the Islands. Various strategies are adopted to obtain an improved and stable socio-economic development of rural areas of the Islands with higher productivity, socio-economic equality and ambition. Some of these key schemes being implemented by the Department of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj are as

Mission (Grameen)' is the segregation and collection of waste. In rural areas, people are segregating the waste at their own at the household level. This was possible due to the continuous efforts made by the PRI Members at grass root level bringing behavioral change in the villagers of their respective Panchayats. Wastes are segregated in two categories i.e. 'dry waste' and 'wet waste'. Dry wastes are collected in 25 Clusters wherein it is further segregated and bailed for transportation to mainland for recycling. Whereas for management of 'wet waste', people are encouraged for it's composting at their backyard. The third component under Swachh Bharat Mission Grameen is 'Grey Water Management' i.e. the water generated from the kitchen and bathing by individuals, which can be reused. The Department has started

follows:

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Grameen (PMAY-G): This scheme focuses on providing affordable housing to rural households, ensuring they have safe and secure living conditions. The scheme is being implemented in A&N Islands since 2016-17 and so far, 1223 houses have been provided to eligible beneficiaries. Additional 2092 houses have been sanctioned during the current FY 2023-24.

Unit assistance of Rs. 1.20 lakh is provided to the beneficiary in 3 installments of Rs.60000/-, Rs.40000/- & Rs.20000/- for construction of house of minimum plinth area of 25 Sq.m. In addition, the beneficiary gets Rs.12,000/- as assistance for construction of toilet under Swachh Bharat Mission. Provision of 90/95 persondays of unskilled labour wage under MGNREGA is also provided for construction of house. Besides that, convergence with other Government schemes for provision of basic amenities viz, drinking water, electricity, clean & efficient cooking fuel, etc is also

provided. The landless beneficiaries are provide 50 Sq.m of land by the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of A&N Islands for construction of PMAY-G house. **Swachh Bharat Mission-Grameen (SBM-G):** A nationwide cleanliness campaign aimed at achieving the vision of a Clean India. It emphasizes on the construction of toilets, proper waste management, and promoting hygiene practices in rural areas.

A&N Islands has become number one in the 'Swachh Bharat Mission' and our Island is declared 'Swachh Sujal State' amongst States and UTs and received an award from the Hon'ble Minister, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat. Apart from this, A&N Islands has also received the award for ODF plus.

Under this Mission, there are three components and the first is 'Access to the Toilet' for every individual. The Rural Development Department constructed individual toilets and community toilets across the Islands & attained ODF status. The second component under 'Swachh Bharat

working on it and creating wide awareness about it. Soak pits are being made for individual Households as well as for community purpose.

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS): A landmark social security scheme that provides guaranteed wage employment to rural households, thereby enhancing their livelihood opportunities. The MGNREG scheme is being implemented in Andaman & Nicobar Islands since 2008 with main objective to provide at least 100 days of guaranteed wage employment in a financial year to every rural household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. Nearly 13000 beneficiaries are actively working for wage employment under the scheme and contribution of women in persondays generation is more than 50%. The workers of South Andaman and N&M Andaman districts get wages of Rs.311/- per day and that of Nicobar get wages of Rs.328/- per day. Payment to beneficiaries is made through Aadhaar

products and delicacies. Visitors also enjoyed the cultural programmes and songs presented by local artistes. The Andaman Nicobar Islands Rural Livelihood Mission (ANIRLM) attached to the Directorate of Rural Development has organized the Mela to

provide a platform to help the SHG members to showcase and sell their hand crafted products and gain good income.

The participant SHGs were brimming with joy as they set up their stalls for selling wares of different kinds. More than 60 Self Help

Groups from Port Blair, Prothrapur, Ferrargunj, Rangat and Nancowry participated in the mela. The products which were prepared by SHGs and put up for sale included handicrafts made of coconut shell, bamboo & cane, ladies hand bags made of

Based Payment System on eFMS Module linked with PFMS Module.

Diverse categories of works are being taken up to enhance scope of MGNREGA works in order to provide employment to MGNREGA workers. Actions are being taken up for Horticulture, Moringa Plantation, raising nurseries through Cluster Level Federations and MGNREGA convergence for livelihood and wage employment of MGNREGA workers. Monitoring of MGNREGA works through Area Officer App is done to ensure proper implementation of scheme. GIS based planning is also being adopted for effective plans to execute MGNREGA works leading to timely achievement of targets.

**MGNREGA work**

Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM)/Aajeevika: This program focuses on promoting self-employment and entrepreneurship among rural women enabling them to generate sustainable livelihoods. The scheme is being implemented since 2015-16 in A&N Islands. Its objective is to ensure livelihood to women in rural areas through Self-Help Groups. Formation of mixed groups of men and women is not allowed. So far, 1250 SHGs consisting of 12557 members, 90 village organizations and 5 Model Cluster/Block Level Federations have been formed.

After the formation of Self-Help Groups, Primary Level Federations called as Village Organization and Block/Cluster Level federations are formed. Various community funds and loans like Revolving Fund (RF) of Rs.15000/- (One time Grant) and Community Investment Fund (CIF) upto Rs.1.50 lakh (on loan basis) are made available to the SHGs through Village Organizations. SHG members are being covered under Government insurance schemes. 1108 SHGs received RF and 946 SHGs received CIF. Rs 9.64 Crore capitalization support already given and bank linkage of Rs. 2.22 Crore is also availed by many SHG members.

The SHG members are supported and encouraged to take up diverse livelihood interventions in agricultural and non-agricultural sector for their livelihood promotion. The focus is on each household having multiple livelihoods to ensure year-round income flow and risk mitigation. Most of the SHG women are engaged in poultry, mid day meals, handicraft items, tailoring, small shops, catering services, beauticians etc. Fairs/Melas are organized at regular intervals for the sale of handmade products made by SHG members. This provides livelihood opportunities to the members. Thus, DAY-NRLM program generates various livelihood opportunities for the people in rural areas.

Social Mobilization camps are being organized in all Gram Panchayats since March, 2023 to mobilize the members of existing SHGs formed by various NGOs and A&N State Cooperative Bank to come under the fold of NRLM and avail the benefits of the scheme.

Deen Dayal Upadhaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY): Focused on skill development and wage employment for rural youth, enabling them to secure better job opportunities. In A&N Islands, this scheme is of immense importance, as it help in skilling the rural youth in sectors like Hospitality, Hospital Management, Tourism, Mason training for which Rural Development Department arranges training. Under the scheme, the rural youth within the age group of 18-35 male & 18-40 female are provided free residential skill development training with assured placement. The trainees who are selected get to earn their livelihood with an initial earning of Rs.15000/-. If the company is satisfied with the work after providing training, they then retain the trainees as employees.

The target beneficiaries for the training are 1500 and the scheme is implemented in PPP mode. The Department has selected five Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) for the conduct of the training and the onus of placement also lies with the Agency. Under this, 423 members have been trained, 151 are under-going training, 253 are appointed in companies in mainland. The trainings under DDU-GKY Sagarmala Convergence Project have also started from October, 2023 and under this convergence, additional 1500 candidates will be provided skill development trainings.

The Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs is time to time organizing Mobilization Drive-cum-Awareness programme under DDU-GKY in all Gram Panchayats and Tribal Areas. Recently, Mobilization camps are ongoing in 19 Gram Panchayats under Ferrargunj Block & in November, 2023 mobilization will start in Car Nicobar & Nancowrie. The rural youth of the Islands have been urged to avail the benefit under the scheme.

Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA): A scheme that aims to strengthen the Panchayati Raj Institutions, empowering local governance and ensuring participatory development in rural areas. The main objectives of the scheme are to strengthen Gram Sabhas with social inclusion of all citizens; promotion of e-governance; geospatial technology and other technology driven solutions at the Panchayat level; and efficient convergence of institutions, resources and services at the Panchayat level. The achievements under the scheme are

- Induction training conducted at DBRAIT Auditorium from December 01 to 03, 2022 for elected representatives from Diglipur to Campbell Bay.
- In the year 2022, Gram Panchayats have taken sankalp on 03 themes among 09 Localization of Sustainable Development Goals (LSDGs).
- Training has been given at State, District, Block & Gram Panchayat level on 09 themes of localization of Sustainable Development Goals.
- Panchayat Learning Centers have also been established (Mithakhari, Subashgram, Neil Kendra) (2023-24- 02 PLC have been approved).
- In the National Panchayat Award 2023, Gram Panchayat Lakshminagar (C/Bay) has been awarded for self-reliant infrastructure in the Panchayat (Theme-6).

Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM): This initiative aims to bridge the rural-urban divide by developing rural areas with urban facilities and amenities, thereby improving the overall quality of life for rural inhabitants. Under the scheme, Ferrargunj Community Development Block is selected as Rurban Cluster in Andaman and Nicobar Islands consisting of 19 Gram Panchayats for execution of necessary developmental works. So far, out of total, 74 feasible works, 64 are completed and 10 are ongoing which shall be completed by December, 2023. Some of the major achievements under the Mission are as follows:

- Construction of Veterinary Sub-Dispensary Centre at Wandoor for benefit of local populace.
- Double Storied Market Complex at Wimberlygunj
- Construction of Zonal Library at Chouldari
- Vegetable Market at Chouldari Junction.
- Construction of 8 Classrooms for VKV Zilla Parishad Vidyalaya at Ferrargunj
- Fish Market with storage facility at Wimberlygunj & Wandoor
- Additional work of Fish Landing Centre at Wandoor to facilitate fisherman community.
- Construction and up-gradation of 25 Anganwadi Centers at various location under Ferrargunj Block

Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY): The Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) is a village development project launched by Government of India under which Members of Parliament are encouraged to adopt villages and develop them as model villages, focusing on holistic development and inclusive growth. The Member of Parliament takes the responsibility of developing physical and institutional infrastructure in the selected village/Gram Panchayat. Various projects are undertaken under this scheme by preparing Village Development Plan with the consent of the Member of Parliament which is beneficial to the rural populace.

Since inception of the scheme, the Gram Panchayats like Ferrargunj, Shivapuram, Wandoor, Mithakhari have been taken up for development under Phase I to IV. Now under Phase V, four Gram Panchayats, namely Ramakrishnapur under South Andaman, Bakultala, Harinagar & Radhanagar under N&M Andaman, have been nominated by the Hon'ble MP and developmental works are being taken up in the said Panchayats through Rural Development Department and other Line Departments.

Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM): A mission aiming to provide safe and adequate drinking water to all rural households, ensuring water security and improving overall health and well-being. The programme also implements sustainability measures as mandatory elements, such as recharge and reuse through grey water management, water conservation, rainwater harvesting. Under the scheme, 62037 households (100%) have been provided with tap water connection.

The Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs is dedicated towards rural development emphasizing on poverty alleviation, creating better livelihood opportunities, ensuring clean and safe surroundings, and providing essential amenities and infrastructure. Through these innovative programs, the Department aims to uplift rural communities, enhance their standard of living and promote sustainable development in rural areas.

A&N Police cautions public against fraudsters using pictures of Senior officials as profile Display Picture to perpetrate financial cyber fraud



A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where WhatsApp messages are being sent from random WhatsApp accounts using images of senior Government officials as profile Display Picture to create gift cards on Amazon, Flipkart, or other E-commerce platforms. Gift cards or gift vouchers are prepaid stored-value money cards, usually issued by a retailer, to be used as an alternative to cash for purchases within a particular store or related businesses.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar


Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

- If a WhatsApp message from an unknown mobile number is received, check with the previously known number (or with common acquaintances) if the new mobile number is authentic.
- Call & confirm with the concerned senior official, if any such money related request is made.
- Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize, if a request seems too urgent.
- Avoid replying to unknown messages on messaging apps such as WhatsApp, Telegram, Signal, etc.



➤ Avoid sharing photos or videos online (privacy filters may be used if shared), as these may be used for creating fake accounts on WhatsApp, Telegram, or other messaging platforms.

**Swaraj Dweep Police seizes 565 grams of ganja; one arrested**

In a significant crackdown on illegal narcotics, the Swaraj Dweep Police have apprehended an individual and seized 565 grams of Ganja. The arrest and seizure followed credible information and a well-executed operation led by Inspector N. Zainuddin of the Swaraj Dweep Police Station. On November 4, 2023, the Swaraj Dweep Police received reliable information that an individual was

in possession of illicit ganja and was actively seeking customers to distribute the contraband from his shop located at Govind Nagar No.03.

The well-coordinated raid was conducted at the suspect's pan shop at Govind Nagar No.03, which culminated in the arrest of Balram Paramanik, aged 36 and a resident of Govind Nagar No.03, Swaraj Dweep. During the operation, 565 grams of Ganja were

seized from Paramanik's possession. A case has been registered against the arrested individual under the stringent Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act at the Swaraj Dweep Police Station. 
