Centre issues advisory to States in view of a recent upsurge in COVID-19 cases and detection of first case of JN.1 variant in India

States urged to maintain a state of constant vigil over the COVID situation

New Delhi, Dec. 18 (PIB)

In view of the recent surge in COVID-19 cases in some States/UTs in India and the detection of the first case of the new JN.1 variant of COVID-19 in the country, Shri Sudhanshu Pant, Union Health Secretary sent a letter to States/UTs, highlighting the need for maintaining a state of constant vigil over the COVID situation in the country.

He underlined that "due to consistent and collaborative actions

between Centre and State Governments, we have been able to sustain the trajectory at sustainable low rates". However, as the COVID-19 virus continues to circulate and its epidemiology behaviour gets settled with Indian weather conditions and circulation of other usual pathogens, it is important to keep the momentum going to effectively deal with the challenges in public health.

Union Health Secretary underlined

the critical COVID control and management strategies as below:

Considering the upcoming festive season, States were advised to put in place requisite public health measures and other arrangements to minimize risk of increase in transmission of the disease by adherence to maintenance of respiratory hygiene.

States were urged to ensure effective compliance of the detailed operational

training on nursery techniques of Horticultural Crops (Spices)' of three days each were organized by ICAR-CIARI in collaboration with CSS-MIDH (NHM) Project on Spices and All India Coordinated Research Project on Palms Project from Dec.11 to 16, 2023. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. E.B. Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI, who graced the occasion as the chief guest in the presence of Dr. P.K. Singh, Head, Division of Horticulture and Crop Improvement and Coordinator of the programme.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
