These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration Group-'C' (Non-Gazetted/Non Ministerial) Posts of Insect Collectorin the Directorate of Health Services Recruitment Rules, 2023.

(ii) These shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay:-

The number of Posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in Para 2 to 4 of the Schedules annexed thereto.

Method of Recruitment, Age Limit and Other Qualification:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Para 5 to 13 of the attached schedule.

4. Initial Constitution of the service:-

The Insect Collector working on regular basis under the Health Department of this Administration as on the date of publication of this rules in the Official Gazette, their services shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules and they shall be members of the service.

5. Disqualification:-

No person-

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living.

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administration), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the provision of these Rules.

Powers to Relax:-

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, if necessary, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

. Saving:-Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
