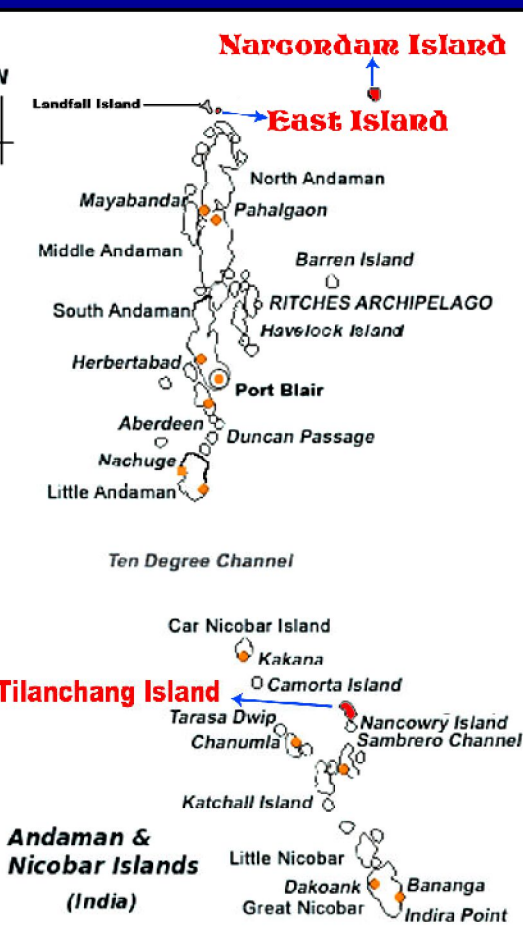

BORDER SECURITY OF A&N ISLANDS IN THREAT

Despite competent agency like ANC, security of far & remote Narcondum, East Island & Tillongchong still in the hands of A&N Police

Port Blair, Oct 9: It is hard to believe that international borders of Andaman & Nicobar Islands are secured by the Andaman & Nicobar Police, which lacks the skills, manpower and equipment & technology to do the same. Andaman & Nicobar Police tasked to guard far and strategically located islands such as Narcondum, East Island & Tillongchong was established in the year 1980 before the establishment of Andaman & Nicobar Command in these islands. Undoubtedly, in the 1980s, the Andaman Nicobar Police was the only agency to maintain Law & Order as also to protect foreign intruders to these islands. But after the establishment of the tri-service command in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands after October 2001, the border security of these islands is still in the hands of Andaman & Nicobar Police. If somebody tries to know about the status of the guards deputed to Narcondum, Tillongchong and East Island for protecting the borders of these islands, they will be shocked to learn that the condition of the barracks are awful. The guards lack quality arms & ammunition so that they can retaliate during emergencies. The barracks are in dilapidated condition and staff are not even provided with proper equipment to safeguard their own life during an emergency. The Officer at the helm is well aware about the condition of



the guard and security of staff. These are indicators that the UT Administration have miserably failed to provide better facilities nor they tried to handover the guard to ANC-the competent force having all technical know-how, skills and equipment to deal with foreign intruders. Days are gone but they never thought about the security of islands which pose a major threat to not only the Police guards performing duties here but to the islands. It is very clear that the Police are not the authorized agency to protect the borders of the Nation as they lack skills and swiftness like the Indian Army. As per the

relevant sources it is known that there is 24 hrs natural water supply in Narcondam Island but in fact it is worth mentioning that there are no bathroom facilities in the barrack. The staff has to go near the beach to respond to nature's call and to become fresh. It shows the inability or infamy negligence of officers to at least build a bathroom for guard personnel despite water availability in the guard. Another interesting fact is that IPS officers and administrative officers visit these islands for inspection but neither they sort out the problem faced by the guard

personnel nor they are interested to do the same. Basically, the bureaucrats are posted in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands for a few years and they just complete their tenure by living a life of king and some of them have a goal to plunder wealth without concerning the security of our islands. They visit these islands as a pleasure trip and leave as bureaucratic apathy for any strategic enhancement of securities to the islanders. Amidst the ongoing military confrontation with China in eastern Ladakh since April-May last year, India now finally plans to crank up

Administration's clarification contrary to its action

Despite provisions, allowing continuation of appointments on invalid degrees

Port Blair, Oct 9: In a response to clarification sought by the Andaman Nicobar Teachers Association (ANTA), the UT Administration has said that wherever it is found that a Government servant, who was not qualified or eligible in terms of Recruitment Rules, etc. for initial recruitment in service or had furnished false information or produced a false certificate in

order to secure appointment, he should not be retained in service. If he is probationer or a temporary Government servant he should be discharged or his service should be terminated. It further said that if the Government servant so appointed has become permanent Government servant, an enquiry as prescribed in Rule 14 of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965, may be held and if the charges

are proved, the Government servant should be removed or dismissed from service. In no circumstances should any other penalty be imposed. Further, as per para 3, such discharge, termination, removal or dismissal from service would, however, be without prejudice to the right of the Government servant to prosecute such Government servants. These clarifications have been

furnished with reference of Government of India's decision and provisions under Rule 11 (2) of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 based on observation of Honourable Supreme Court's judgement in the case of District Collector, Vizianagaram v. M. Tripura Sundari Devi [1190(4)SLR 273]. Contrary to these clarifications, the UT Administration has

Oil slick ahead?

Two independent developments this week again highlight the challenges facing the global economy in the near future. Oil prices are likely to remain elevated as the supply cartel Opec plus, which includes Saudi Arabia and Russia, decided to trim production in a bid to keep the price high. The grouping, which produces a little more than 50% of the world's crude, plans to reduce output by 2 million barrels/day beginning November by using August's production as a benchmark. It's about 2% of production. Therefore, the planned cut will most likely set a floor to any price decline. Separately, WTO forecast growth in merchandise trade volume will slow in 2023. It's now projected to grow at 1%, lower than 3.4% forecast a few months ago. Trade volume growth is being dragged down by the economic slowdown in three major economic engines, the US, Europe and China. WTO thinks the ongoing monetary tightening in the US will soon bite hard, while the energy shock in the form of a 350% year-on-year increase in gas prices in Europe will lead to reduced consumer spending. China's zero-Covid strategy has taken a toll on its growth. The energy shock is partly on account of self-defeating economic sanctions imposed by the US and Europe on Russia following its invasion of Ukraine. While Europe took the biggest hit because of its dependence on Russian gas, the rest of the world felt the impact through both an oil price surge and upward pressure on prices of key food items. Supply pressure on key commodities can keep domestic inflation elevated while a global slowdown will act as a drag on growth here. The monthly average price of the Indian basket of crude peaked at \$116/barrel in June and later declined to \$91/barrel in September. Pump prices of petrol and diesel, however, remain unchanged since May 22, ring-fencing the domestic economy from global oil price movements. What may emerge as the main challenge again is a relative slowdown – a purchasing managers' survey for services in September showed the lowest reading in six months. Monetary and fiscal policies need to be flexible to adapt to a highly uncertain scenario.

continued two Class-1 officers in the Department of Education, who were appointed to the post on the basis of invalid Degree. As per Recruitment Rule, the essential Educational qualification for recruitment to the posts includes three year graduation level Degree from a recognised university, but appointments were given to two candidates possessing two year graduation level degree. Graduation level Degree of aforesaid two candidates was declared invalid for the post by the honourable court of law. As the Department of Education didn't make any appeal against the verdict of the court of law, the Department accepted that Degree of aforesaid two candidates is invalid for the post. To safeguard the daily bread of aforesaid two government servants, they may be reverted back to their parent post of Post Graduate Teacher.

Well aware of the status of validity of Graduation level Degree Certificate of aforesaid two Government servants and relevant rules under which action is to be taken, the UT Administration is keeping mum. This ignorance has dragged the Department of Education to a situation where almost all the Secondary and Senior Secondary schools are functional without a full time Headmaster (SS), Vice Principal and Principal. Due to this, the quality of education is badly affected and the future of students enrolled in government schools is at stake. Very recently, the Department of Education initiated the process for filling of vacant posts of Headmaster (S)/ Vice Principal/Principal. But the completion of this process is doubtful till the issue of two class-1 officers appointed on the basis of invalid degree is settled.

WHY CRIMEA BRIDGE BLAST IS A MASSIVE SETBACK FOR RUSSIA

An explosion caused the partial collapse of a bridge linking the Crimean Peninsula with Russia on Saturday, damaging a key supply artery for the Kremlin's faltering war effort in southern Ukraine. Three people were killed in the blast, Russian authorities said.

The speaker of Crimea's Kremlin-backed regional parliament immediately accused Ukraine, though Moscow didn't apportion blame.

Ukrainian officials have repeatedly threatened to strike the bridge and some lauded the attack, but Kyiv stopped short of claiming responsibility.

The bombing came a day after Russian President Vladimir Putin turned 70, dealing him a humiliating blow that could lead him to up the ante in his war on Ukraine.

Russia's National Anti-Terrorism Committee said that a truck bomb caused seven railway cars carrying fuel to catch fire, resulting in a partial collapse of two sections of the bridge.

A man and a woman who were riding in a vehicle across the bridge were killed by the explosion and their bodies were recovered, Russia's Investigative Committee said. It didn't provide details on the third victim.

The 19-kilometre (12-mile) bridge across the Kerch Strait linking the Black Sea and the Sea of Azov opened in 2018 and is the longest in Europe.

The USD 3.6 billion project is a tangible symbol of Moscow's claims on Crimea and has provided an essential link to the Crimean Peninsula, which Russia annexed from Ukraine in 2014.

The peninsula holds symbolic value for Russia and is key to sustaining its military operations in the south of Ukraine.

If the bridge were made inoperable, it would make it

significantly more challenging to ferry supplies to Crimea. While Russia seized the areas north of Crimea early on during the invasion and built a land corridor to it along the Sea of Azov, Ukraine is pressing a counteroffensive to reclaim them.

The bridge has train and automobile sections. Russia's National Anti-Terrorism Committee specified that the explosion and fire led to the collapse of the two sections of one of the two links of the automobile bridge, while another link was intact.

Russia's Energy Ministry said Crimea has enough fuel for 15 days, adding that it was working on ways to replenish stock.

Authorities suspended passenger train traffic across the bridge until further notice. Putin was informed about the explosion and he ordered the creation of a government panel to deal with the emergency.

The speaker of Crimea's Kremlin-backed regional parliament blamed Ukraine for the explosion, but downplayed the severity of the damage and said the bridge would be promptly repaired.

Now they have something to be proud of: over 23 years of their management, they didn't manage to

build anything worthy of attention in Crimea, but they've managed to damage the surface of the Russian bridge, Vladimir Konstantinov, chairman of the State Council of the Republic, wrote on Telegram.

The parliamentary leader of Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy's party on Saturday stopped short of claiming that Kyiv was responsible but appeared to cast it as a consequence of Moscow's takeover of Crimea and attempts to integrate the peninsula with the Russian mainland.

Russian illegal construction is starting to fall apart and catch fire. The reason is simple: if you build something explosive, then sooner or later it will explode, David Arakhamia, the leader of the Servant of the People party, wrote on Telegram.

And this is just the beginning. Of all things, reliable construction is not something Russia is particularly famous for, he said. Other Ukrainian officials were more celebratory while still stopping short of claiming responsibility. The Ukrainian postal service announced that it would issue stamps commemorating the blast, saying in a statement that the images would draw on classic film posters to highlight the bridge's sacred

significance to Moscow. The postal service previously released a set of stamps commemorating the sinking of the Moskva, a Russian flagship cruiser, by an Ukrainian strike in late May.

The secretary of Ukraine's National Security and Defense Council, Oleksiy Danilov, posted a video on Twitter with the Kerch Bridge on fire on the left side and video with Marilyn Monroe singing her famous Happy Birthday Mr. President on the right.

An adviser to Zelenskyy, Mykhailo Podolyak, tweeted: Crimea, the bridge, the beginning. Everything illegal must be destroyed, everything stolen must be returned to Ukraine, everything occupied by Russia must be expelled: In Moscow, Russian Foreign Ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova said that the reaction of the Kyiv regime to the destruction of civilian infrastructure shows its terrorist nature. In August, Russia suffered a series of explosions at an airbase and munitions depot in Crimea, which underlined its vulnerability. Local authorities in Crimea made conflicting statements about what the damaged bridge would mean for residents and their ability to buy consumer goods on the peninsula, a popular sun-and-sea destination for Russian tourists year-round that is home to Sevastopol, a key city and a naval base.

Reflecting the tensions, Mikhail Razvozhayev, the head of Sevastopol, initially announced a ban on sales of car fuel in canisters and said that the sales of groceries will be limited to 3 kilograms per person to avoid a panicky run on supplies, but then changed course just an hour later, saying that there will be no restrictions.

At the same time, he sought to assuage residents, insisting they weren't cut off from the mainland. There are land corridors via the

new territories, and the ferry crossing near the Crimean Bridge has started operating, he said.

The Association of Russia's tourist agencies estimated that about 50,000 tourists were in Crimea on vacation at the time of the blast. The head of Russia's top tourism body, Ilya Umansky, told the Interfax agency that ferry links had been relaunched Saturday between the peninsula and the mainland but admitted that those seeking to enter Crimea in the coming days were set to experience some discomfort.

Sinehubov said Russia had deployed S-300s missiles in the strike. If true, this would mark the latest in a series of instances when Moscow was reported to have repurposed a weapon originally designed for air defense to strike ground targets, possibly because of a shortage of more suitable munitions. The death toll, meanwhile, from earlier missile strikes on apartment buildings in Zaporizhzhia rose to 17, Ukrainian emergency services reported. The State Emergency Service of Ukraine wrote on Telegram that 21 people had been rescued from the rubble of a four-story apartment block, and that search and rescue work was continuing. Russian missiles damaged more than 40 apartment buildings on Thursday in the Ukrainian-controlled city, which is nevertheless the official capital of a region Moscow moved to illegally annex last week. Zaporizhzhia lies across a wide reservoir on the Dnieper river from the nuclear plant with the same name, one of the world's largest. The deadly strikes came hours after Ukraine's president announced that his military had retaken three more villages in another of the four regions claimed by Russia, Moscow's latest battlefield reversal. - Source : Theweek

"force accretion" and "military infrastructure development" in the ANC as an effective counter to Chinese moves in the Indian Ocean Region. Henceforth the veracity of the effective implementation on the ground level here in Andaman & Nicobar Islands is something else like making parody in the name of border security. It is worth mentioning that security of border islands of A&N Islands remains in the hands of Andaman & Nicobar Police. The ANC was established as India's first joint geographical command in October 2001 but has not achieved its potential due to inter-service turf wars among the three Services and general politico-bureaucratic apathy. We are gravely concerned by reports that China has deployed surface-to-air missiles in Woody Island (South China Sea). Such actions negate China's earlier commitment not to militarize the South China Sea. These developments further erode trust and confidence and aggravate the already tense situation. Further if such things happen in our border islands being guarded by Police, then let us know how these Police personnel will retaliate during emergencies. Is the A&N Police trained for it or they are left to sacrifice their life for no cause? The Coco Islands are two islands in the north-eastern Bay of Bengal. They are part of Yangon region of Myanmar, which is 65 km near to the East Island of Andaman Islands territory. They were leased to the People's Republic of China in 1994. The maritime reconnaissance and electronic intelligence station on Great Coco Island, some 300 km south of Myanmar's mainland, is the most important People's Liberation Army Navy (PLAN) signal intelligence installation. The Chinese Army is also building a base on Small Coco Island in the Alexandra Channel between the Indian Ocean and the Andaman

Sea north of India's Andaman Islands. These facilities give China the ability to monitor Indian naval movements in the Bay of Bengal and missile tests that take place from the DRDO testing facility at Chandipur. These islands are located at a crucial point in the traffic route between the Bay of Bengal and the strait of Malacca and are at an ideal location for monitoring Indian naval and missile launch facilities in Andaman and Nicobar Islands to the south and movements of the Indian navy throughout the eastern Indian ocean. It is therefore important to understand the strategic significance of the location of these islands and why China has constructed a series of military installations on them. Radars, anti-aircraft guns, missiles and a functional airport are just a sample of the infrastructure development that is discernible on satellite imagery. The show of muscle must cause more than a ripple of concern in the Defense ministry & Andaman administration, seeing as how Chinese maps depict the Andaman & Nicobar Islands as Chinese territory. We are largely ignorant of this fact and also the possible upset in the balance of powers in the Southeast Asian hemisphere. If the New Delhi & Andaman Administration is taking note and creating a response to the situation, it is pretty much under the radar. In these circumstances with China fully committed to ruling the waves what could India do if China engages in adventurism? Very little really except read the writing on the wall and begin to build its own navy as a deterrent to the string of pearls that was the label given to its forays in establishing bases in the region. If it won't get started now, it may never catch up. To manage the borders effectively, surveillance must be carried out in the form of regular patrols by the border

guarding personnel. In addition, several electronic surveillance equipment such as night vision devices, handheld thermal imagers, battle field surveillance radar, direction finder, unattended ground sensor, high powered binoculars are used by the border guarding forces as force multipliers for greater surveillance. The new technologies that have emerged in the field of surveillance and security, such as the combination of infrared and thermal cameras, Surveillance drones, Internet and smart handheld devices, have become increasingly essential to border management agencies. It is imperative that the border management agencies develop and embrace these new innovations and, at the same time, put more focus on capacity building and change management. But there is no development in the case of Andaman and Nicobar Police guarding those border islands since 1970, neither they have technological surveillance equipment nor they have any life securities during emergencies they are left to those islands for do or die survival for the fittest. It is high time for innovative thinking and keep aside the bureaucratic apathy and to implement some strategic approach toward the security of our islands by giving the responsibility of border security to the Andaman & Nicobar Command for better security with technological infrastructure, drone technologies, radar stations to have a note in the movements of intruders and espionage the Chinese assailants into the Andaman sea. Since, ANC command has all the basic facilities like Naval ships, helicopters, highly technical equipments to safeguard borders islands. Hence, if not done today then Govt. of India as well as Andaman Administration will have to forfeit the lack of concern towards the security of islanders.

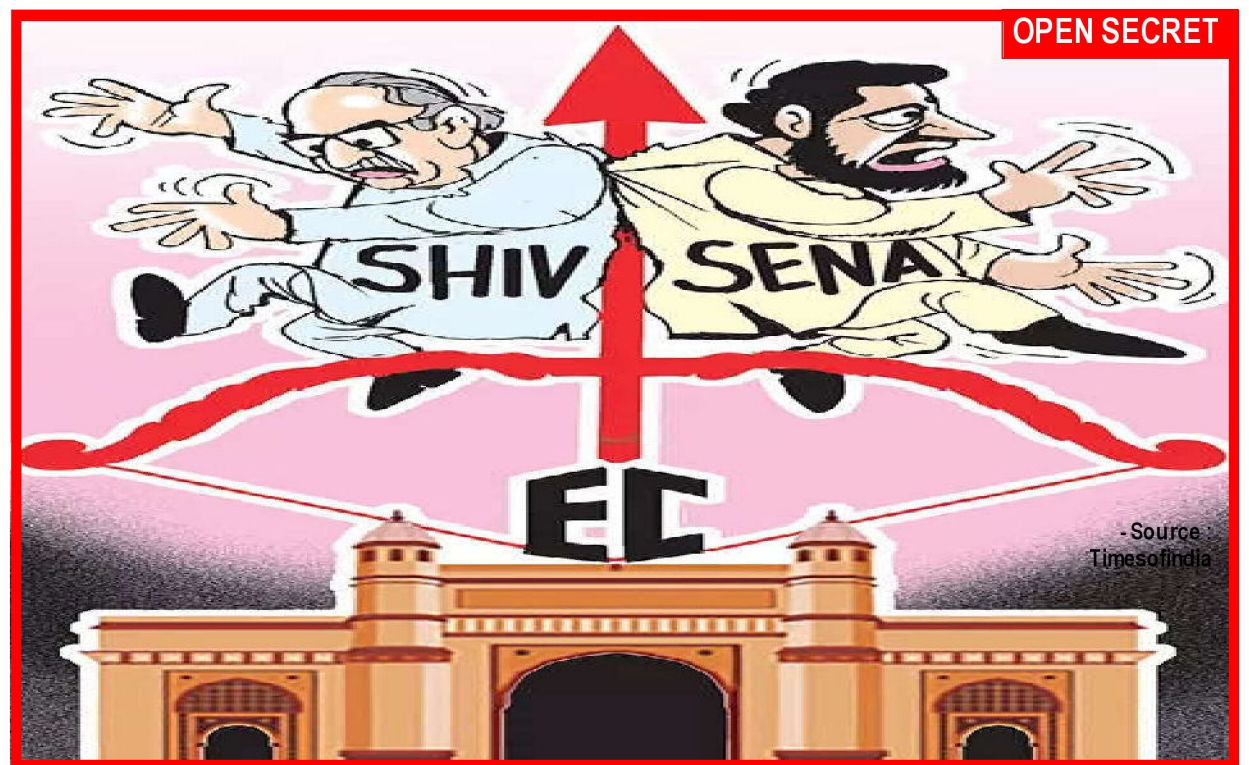
Revenue Camp Court by South Andaman District Administration
