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Need of direct flight to Port Blair from Kochi and Madurai advocated

Sky high price of air travel tickets and limited connectivity to cities a matter of concern

Port Blair, Nov. 16: Availability of appropriate and affordable transport mode for travel between mainland and island has always been a matter of concern for islanders. With recent boost in the air travel sector several airlines started operating to Port Blair which added up to the options of transport mode to the mainland for islanders. But the soaring air prices deprived several islanders to avail the service. Owing to high fares, several islanders preferred to avail shipping services to travel between mainland-island. With

reduction in frequency of shipping services to the mainland, such islanders are deprived of any affordable transport mode for the mainland. Cry of islanders for reduction in air fare from the past few years failed to yield any outcome. Runways closer for maintenance added fuel to the crises. As such, Air fares are almost unreachable for a common man. Availability of direct flight to cities like Bangalore, Hyderabad, Chennai, Kolkata and Delhi offers a little bit of relief to islanders as the air fares are relatively lesser compared to connecting flights. Islanders and visitors commuting

to cities directly connected to Port Blair and lucky enough to have affordable flight services. There are several islanders commuting or connected to cities or its nearby areas of Madurai and Kochi. They all have to pay excessive air fare due to non-availability of direct flights. They all have been demanding the addition of new sectors in Madurai-Port Blair and Kochi-Port Blair but nothing has been done on this line. As the Government of India is planning to make air travel reachable and affordable to every citizen and new airlines are keen to start their services for Islands, their

advocacy for starting direct flight service between Kochi-Port Blair and Madurai-Port Blair is on rise. Islanders demand that direct flight services or flights with layover shall be started on these sectors for ease in travel for islanders belonging to or commute from these cities and areas around it. AS the air fares for travel to islands is touching sky, it is high time for the Administration to approach the Civil Aviation ministry, GOI for introduction of direct flights for Madurai and Kochi from isles and also take measures for regulating air fares for the island sector.

For these errors there is no fault from their end. He added that all these candidates are now deeply worried that due to these spelling

errors in the name, printed on the admit card, they might not be allowed for the written test, on the day of exam. In this regard, he has requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor to intervene in this matter and arrange to allow all candidates for this written test even if there are errors in the name, printed on the admit card, by validating the person based on the photograph of the candidate printed over the Admit Card and the ID card. He pointed out that this exam is a lifetime opportunity for most of the candidates and hence personal intervention of Hon'ble Lt. Making G20 relevant

The ongoing G20 leaders' summit in Bali is of special significance to India. Tomorrow, Indonesian President Joko Widodo will formally ask India to take over G20 presidency. From next month, India will officially assume the presidency, host next year's G20 meetings and most importantly set the agenda for the next annual leaders' summit. G20 is a unique global body. Comprising 19 countries and the EU, it represents 85% of global GDP and 66% of the world's population. In terms of composition, it's well represented.

Formed in 1999 in the wake of the Asian financial crisis, it got its left in 2008 when the G20 leaders' summit was held in the midst of the challenges posed by the global financial crisis. Designed to be a flexible body, without a permanent secretariat, decisions are based on consensus. It was most effective in 2008 and 2009, when coordination in policymaking mitigated the economic fallout of the financial crisis and also laid the platform for subsequent agreements on sharing tax data to curb tax evasion. Since then, the core goal of improving the economic policy environment has expanded to tackling climate change and terrorism, among other things. But recent results are disappointing.

India has the opportunity to get the G20 back on track. It's far too important a platform to be allowed to sink into irrelevance like some other global governance bodies with a permanent secretariat. Framing an appropriate agenda that can be realised through concrete measures will bring back the spirit of 2008-09. Given the last decade's failures with an ever-expanding agenda, it's best to stick to the founding aim of creating a more positive environment for the global economy.

The long-term implications of the strategic rivalry between US and China, and the events since 2020 have cast a shadow on global trade. Dismantling protectionism was perhaps the single most important reason that more than 1 billion people globally escaped extreme poverty in the three decades before Covid. India's G20 presidency can contribute to preserving those gains and finding a way to build on it. An agenda that revolves around preserving an enabling environment for world trade is more likely to meet with success than one with issues where solutions require painstaking negotiations over years. A unique feature of G20 is the rotating presidency. This is India's moment—and it must make something substantive of it.

NATO REFUSES TO BITE, SOFT-PEDALS POLAND MISSILE LANDING INCIDENT

The US-led North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) has chosen to take a conciliatory position by not taking a strong stand on the incident of a reportedly Russian-made missile landing in eastern Poland on Tuesday, indicating a marked 'reluctance' for a direct confrontation with the Russians.

The missile landed about 24 km away from the Polish-Ukraine border in a town called Przewodow on Tuesday and killed two Polish nationals.

Poland is a member of the 30-member NATO military alliance.

Under Clause 5 of the NATO Charter, the member countries "agree that an armed attack against one or more of them in Europe or

North America shall be considered an attack against them all" which would necessitate collective action including "use of armed force".

Under Clause 4, member states "consult together whenever, in the opinion of any of them, the territorial integrity, political independence or security" of a member is threatened.

Clause 4 allows preventive diplomacy to help avoid an escalation that may lead to military conflict. It does not mandate member states to carry out follow-up action.

The onus is upon the aggrieved country—Poland in this case—to call for a meeting citing the clause.

On Wednesday, an emergency meeting was held in Bali that was attended by G7 leaders—from the

US, UK, Germany, France, Canada, Italy, and Japan—and leaders of Spain, the Netherlands and the EU—all of whom were in Indonesia attending the G20 Summit.

US and Polish Reaction What is interesting is the initial reaction of both President Joe Biden and Polish President Andrzej Duda.

Biden was quoted by agencies as saying that preliminary information contests that (the missile was fired from Russia). "It is unlikely in the lines of the trajectory that it was fired from Russia, but we'll see," Biden is reported to have said.

On the other hand, Duda was quoted by agencies as saying that the incident was probably "a one-off" incident and there was no clear evidence as to who fired it.

It was the Polish foreign ministry which first said that the missile was of Russian make.

While Russia has been vehement in its denial that it didn't fire the missile, Ukraine insists the missile had been fired by the Russians. Incidentally, on Tuesday, Russia had let rain about 100 missiles on Ukraine.

Notwithstanding the facts on the ground, President Biden wants NATO and the EU to have a common position on the incident which might not be easy to

achieve because of lack of consensus on the Russian action in Ukraine which has seen various shades of opinion.

Already reeling under gas and fuel shortages in the face of an advancing winter, many EU members—like Serbia, The Netherlands, and Austria—are not keen to escalate the conflict.

Spy chiefs Meeting in Ankara

In a rare move, the chiefs of the CIA and the SVY—William J. Burns and Sergei Naryshkin—had met in the Turkish capital of Ankara on Monday purportedly to defuse threats of the use of nuclear weapons that the Russians have threatened to resort to.

SVR-RF (Sluzhba vnesheyy razvedki Rossiyskoy Federatsii) is the Russian foreign intelligence agency and the Russian counterpart of the CIA. The reported top spymasters' meeting came in the backdrop of recent parleys between US national security adviser Jake Sullivan and senior Russian officials largely focused on limiting the ongoing war.

If indeed the incident in Poland was a Red-flag operation initiated by Ukraine, it would have as its immediate aim the declaration of Ukraine by NATO as a no-fly zone which would bar Russian planes and

assets from entering Ukrainian airspace.

With Russia steadfast on flying its military assets in Ukraine, the declaration of a no-fly zone will only escalate the crisis where the US and its allies would be forced to direct confrontation with the Russians.

The final aim would be to draw in the NATO countries to take a direct role in the ongoing war. On October 18, the UN's Independent International Commission of Inquiry (COI) on Ukraine, while coming down heavily on Russian violation of human rights in Ukraine, had not spared the latter. The COI found that "war crimes, violations of human rights and international humanitarian law have been committed in Ukraine since 24 February 2022. Russian armed forces are responsible for the vast majority of the violations identified." "Ukrainian forces have also committed international humanitarian law violations in some cases, including two incidents that qualify as war crimes," the report pointed out. If it is established beyond doubt that Ukraine had indeed fired the missile into Poland, it will put Ukraine in a bad light which in turn may also lead to dilution of support for its cause more so among fence-sitting countries.

Interaction prog by Unnati at Chouldhari



Port Blair, Nov 17: A special session of interaction programme organised by Unnati at Chouldhari with the support of NABARD for the trainees of Food Processing by involving official of Industry Department and Pollution Control Committee on 15.11.2022 at 10:30 AM considering the problems of Food Processing of more than 1500 trainees already trained by Unnati with the support of ENI-India, RGF, ATMA and NABARD from the 03 Districts of A&N Islands. At the outset one hand Shri. Janak Rao Nodal Officer Food Processing Industry Department explained various concessions being extended by the Industry Department for setting-up Food Processing units and he further said that Unnati is working in the field of Food Processing associating Industry Department since last 20 years and also conducted various training programmes in the remotest part of the islands including Nancowry group of Islands, Diglipur etc. and on the other hand Shri. Raj Babu Technician A&N Pollution Control Committee narrated that the clearance of pollution is mandatory before starting any Food Processing units for which the entrepreneurs will have to submit 11 documents for pollution clearance. The problems raised by the trainees are in obtaining food license, various clearances including pollution clearance, arrangement of packing materials and preservatives, assured marketing outlet, adequate 02 separate spaces required for preparing veg and non-veg Food

Various Clearances for

Obtaining License: The Single Window System for obtaining various clearances to set-up industrial units need to be arranged by the Industry Department for which Single Window System was set-up in the year 2000 by the Department.

Marketing Support: For providing marketing support to

women groups a marketing outlet was set-up by the Administration/ Directorate of Social Welfare at Goalgarh on the representation of women groups under plan schemes of Directorate of Social Welfare which need to be started besides SHGs may be permitted to display their products at Sagatika Emporium of Industry Department at concessional rate.

Setting-up Common

Production Centre: The Food Processing trainees/entrepreneurs particularly from weaker section may not set-up Food Processing units at their own considering the requirements to be fulfilled to obtain license and construction of 02 separate rooms for preparation of veg and non-veg items/marine and coconut based products may not be able to afford by entrepreneurs/trainees. Earlier, these groups used to utilize the infrastructures of Unnati's Food Processing training centre at Industrial Estate Dollygunj which was closed due to some disputes between Industry Department and Unnati. Now either Industry Department or Panchayat may create necessary production centre with the provisions of all Food Processing machines and equipments to use by the trainees at commercial scale. Smt. Tapasi Saha Pradhan Chouldhari Gram Panchayat in her address thanked NABARD and Unnati for arranging such excellent Food Processing training programme and also demanded to start another training programme for which a number of women are pressing for undergoing training seeing the quality of training being imparted. - Source : UNNATI

IFS, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, A&N Islands, and Dr. P. Vijayachari, Director, ICMR-Regional Medical Research Centre, Port Blair. Addressing the gathering, the Chief Secretary thanked the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India for taking the initiative in providing skill training under Accelerate Vigyan. He elucidated the most basic of bird watching definition, aside from simply watching or listening to birds, most birders go a few steps by documenting their observations, identifying the birds, and sharing their findings with fellow bird enthusiasts. The Chief Secretary also mentioned that birding meaning is inextricably rooted in an appreciation and sense of wonder at the avian species in bird watchers and this is what everyone from novice bird watcher to expert birder has in common. He also highlighted how he expanded his species list with every trip and experience birding in different habitats. He also shared his passion for photography and remarked that landscape photography is his passions which has taught him to wake up before sunrise, and later he has shifted to Bird Photography also. He beautifully described how bird watching can shape an individual's personality by developing the perseverance

and patience of the watcher. He concluded by giving remarks upon the serenity and pristine beauty of these islands which attracts many bird watchers and flourishes an unimaginable biodiversity and wished ZSI for taking up this kind of activities. The Chief Secretary further stated that A&N Islands are the abode of certain birds viz. Narcondum Hornbill, Megapode etc. which are absolutely endemic found only in islands and nowhere in the World. It's a great opportunity for the participants to learn the nuances of Bird Watching during this workshop, the CS said urging them to take maximum advantage out of it. The Chief Secretary also visited the Regional Museum of ZSI and took keen interest in the zoological collection on A&N Islands. In his address, the guest of honor, Dr. R.S.C. Jayaraj, said that the trainees must know the ecological as well as the economic aspects of bird watching. He highlighted about the collaboration between the Forests Department and ZSI in which they have carried out surveys from Landfall to Indira Point. The PCCF is also emphasised about the bird tourism and the value of education in this industry. He also mentioned to the students about the various new job opportunities waiting in the tourism industry and others etc. He highlighted the

incredible significance of knowing the worth of bird watchers in various fields like conservation, management and agriculture etc. of which those will be achieved only by the imparting proper training of the local community. Speaking on the occasion, Dr. P. Vijayachari, Director, ICMR-RMRC, Port Blair mentioned the significance of Bird identification in basic and applied sciences and how these two embedded into medical sciences. He emphasized the status of inter-sectoral co-ordination between Animal Science, Veterinary Science, Health Science and local Community and also cited the interconnection between Zoonotic disease and biodiversity. Welcoming the chief guest and others present on the occasion, Dr. C. Sivaperuman, Officer-in-Charge, ZSI, Port Blair enlightened the gathering on the history of Zoological Survey of India through these hundred years and how it has shaped the survey methodologies. He also briefed about the Andaman and Nicobar Regional Centre, Zoological Survey of India and its jurisdiction and mentioned some collaborative research works carried out with Department of Environment and Forests and other research organizations. Dr. S. Senthil Kumar, IFS, CCF, Territorial also spoke on the occasion. Earlier, Shri Ashok Kumar Paul, IFS, DFO, South Andaman while welcoming the gathering informed

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that the Forest Station building for South Andaman Forest Division was constructed under the Scheme: Protection of Forest & Coastal Eco system at a cost of Rs.77.71,331/-. 

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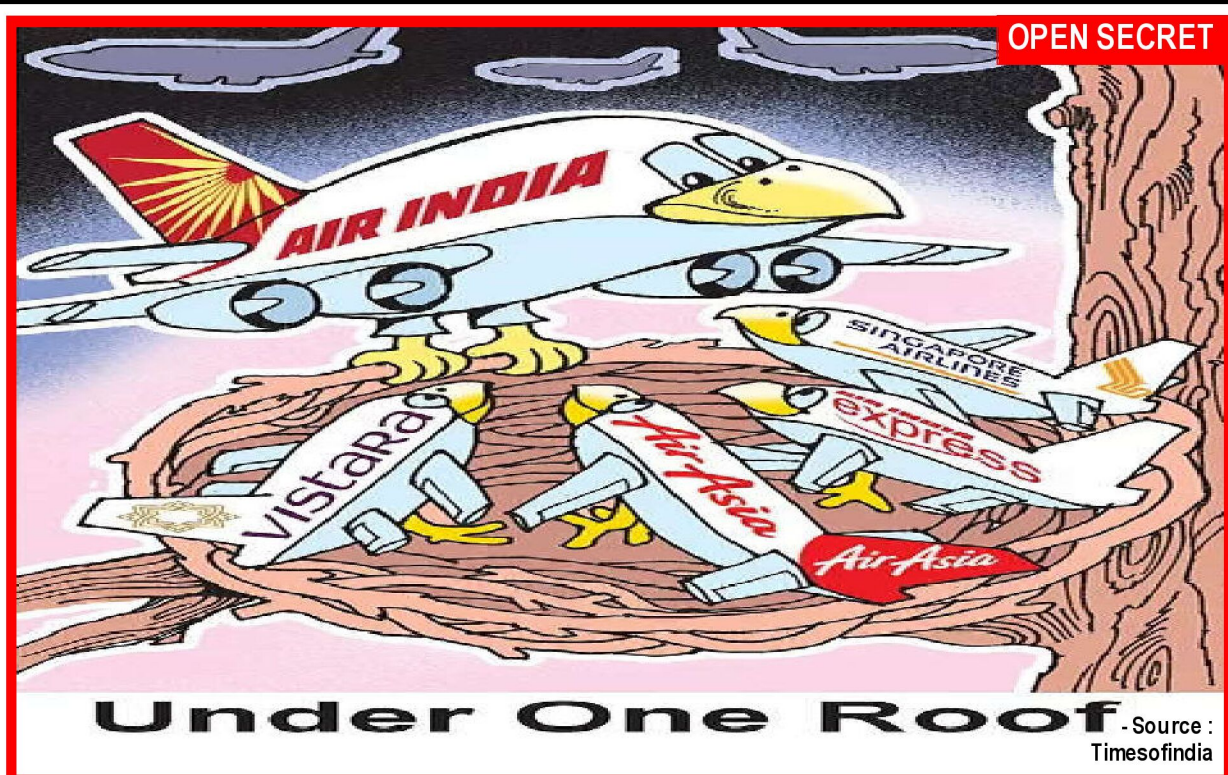
