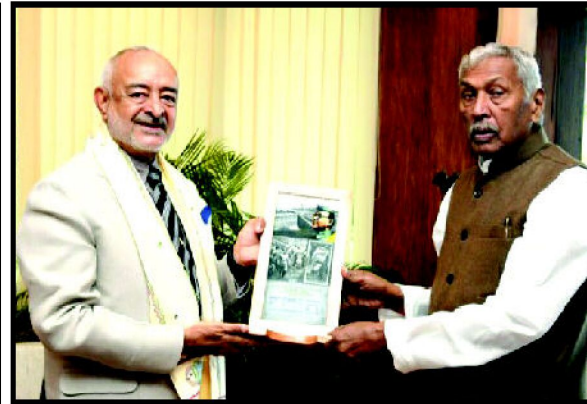
### Driving tests suspended in remote places in Nicobar District for past 8 months

Port Blair, Nov 22: In the absence of proper internet connectivity in remote regions of Nicobar District driving tests for issuance of driving licence have not been held for the past eight months. Non-conduct of driving tests in places such as Kamorta, Katchal and Teressa in the Nicobar District has been causing a lot of difficulties for the applicants from this region interested in getting a driving licence so that they can earn a living as drivers in government or private vehicles. Residents of Kamorta told The Andaman Express that driving tests have not been conducted by the Regional Transport Office of this region for the last 8 months. The last test was conducted in February after which no test has been conducted till date. Residents of Katchal said that about five months ago, a driving licence test was conducted by the RTO, but thereafter no tests are being conducted now. A good number of educated unemployed youths who are willing to make a living by working as drivers in commercial or private vehicles and have applied for

the driving licence are facing uncertainty. Due to non-conduct of driving tests, these youth are unable to procure a driving licence by the RTO. The Motor Vehicles Amendment Act-2019 envisages strict provision for offences relating to driving without licence. Youth driving commercial vehicles without valid licences have to pay heavy fines, if caught by the traffic cops. Sources in the Transport department told EOI that before February 2022, the RTO used to conduct driving tests on a regular basis, probably after every two months. But now, the department has issued an order mentioning that the learning driving tests will be conducted only through online mode leaving the in-charge of RTO in this region to suspend conducting driving licence tests. Since most of the RTO in this region lack proper internet/broadband connectivity, online test for issuance of driving licence is not possible in this region. Residents have demanded that the Transport department connect all the RTOs in these places with broadband



connection so that the process of conducting driving licence tests through online mode can be resumed. In places like remote Teressa, mobile networks have emerged as the biggest issue. This is precisely why the online process for conducting the driving licence test cannot be held by the RTO. Residents of this region now wanted the Transport department to conduct the test manually as a short gap arrangement or till the online process gets started which will be beneficial for the villagers of this remote region of the islands.

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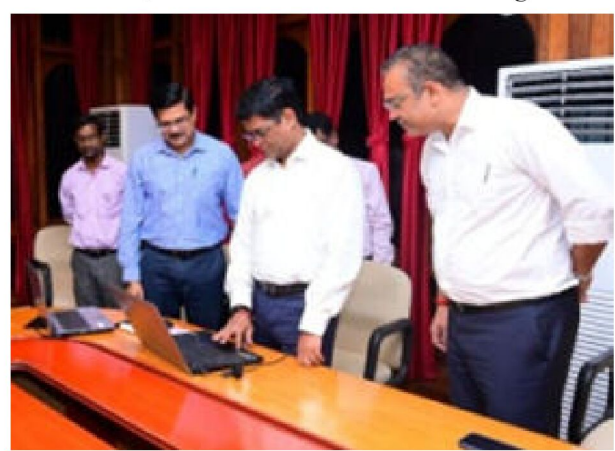

### Arrest dysfunction

CJI Chandrachud flagged a critical issue when he observed that the district judiciary is "hesitant" about granting bail in heinous offences for fear of being targeted. Only constitutional court judges can resolve this matter. Most district judges and magistrates, despite the powers bestowed by laws, are relatively powerless in the judicial hierarchy. CJI also spoke of the need for bringing to the district judiciary "a sense of dignity, sense of self-worth, sense of confidence". If this is missing, some blame lies with the judiciary's steeply hierarchical nature, which is in part a reflection of broader social reality. Far from being considered as equal stakeholders as CJI Chandrachud referred to them, district judges are treated as subordinates. They function under great fear of high court judges who perform administrative superintendence. While HC and Supreme Court judges are protected by the Constitution, district judges don't have such protections. To make it worse for lower court judges, many laws discourage bail. No surprises then that many judges prefer to play safe in bail pleas, custody remand, etc. The downside is that undertrial prisoners (UTPs), even when framed by police, languish in jail interminably. Note that conviction rates are just 42% for murder, 28% for rape, and 29% in economic offences. Denying bail amid such dismal figures is rank injustice. But as SC observed in July when suggesting Parliament frame a Bail Act, low conviction rates have spurred undertrial imprisonment, reversing the "innocent until proven guilty" dictum. A fit case for denying bail is when witnesses/citizens are in danger from the accused or the accused can abscond. Western countries have for years used technologies like ankle bracelets for real-time monitoring to avert both possibilities. Few UTPs can plead for bail to HCs. Most are too poor to afford legal assistance. Despite that, 3,000 bail pleas are pending in SC and 1 lakh in HCs. Over 75% of prison inmates are undertrials. In most categories of crime, courts are disposing of less than 10% of total pending cases annually. We need more judges but if the current judges applied the bail rule properly, the criminal justice system will see a huge upgrade.

# VP HARRIS URGES RESPECT OF SOVEREIGNTY IN SOUTH CHINA SEA

Vice President Kamala Harris called on countries Tuesday to stand up for territorial integrity and freedom of navigation in the South China Sea, which has been challenged by China, and said Washington would press an international campaign against irresponsible behaviour in the disputed waters.

Harris did not cite China by name but was obviously referring to Beijing when she underscored America's support to treaty ally the Philippines in the face of intimidation and coercion in the South China Sea.

She spoke aboard a Philippine coast guard patrol ship docked in Puerto Princesa in the western island province of Palawan, which lies at the edge of the disputed waters. The highly symbolic visit was the last leg of a two-day visit that kicked off in Manila on Monday for talks with

President Ferdinand Marcos Jr.

Citing the profound stakes for America and the international community in the region, particularly in the busy South China Sea, she called for a broad effort to fight for unimpeded commerce and freedom of navigation and overflight in the disputed waters.

We must stand up for principles such as respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, unimpeded lawful commerce, the peaceful resolution of disputes, Harris said.

We will continue to rally our allies and partners against unlawful and irresponsible behaviour, she said. When the international rules-based order is threatened somewhere, it is threatened everywhere.

A new confrontation erupted ahead of her visit to Palawan when the Philippine navy alleged a Chinese coast guard vessel had forcibly seized

Chinese rocket debris as Filipino sailors were towing it to their island.

Marcos Jr told reporters without elaborating that he was inclined to send a diplomatic protest to China over the incident. He added that he wanted a clarification because China denied there was a forcible seizure of the debris.

The long-seething territorial conflicts involving China, the Philippines, Vietnam, Malaysia, Taiwan and Brunei have long been regarded as an Asian flashpoint and a delicate fault line in the US-China rivalry in the region.

In her talks with Marcos Jr on Monday, Harris reaffirmed Washington's commitment to defend the Philippines under the 1951 Mutual Defence Treaty, which obligates the allies to help defend any side which comes under attack.

An armed attack on the

Philippines armed forces, public vessels, or aircraft in the South China Sea would invoke US Mutual Defence commitments, Harris told Marcos Jr. And that is an unwavering commitment that we have to the Philippines.

Marcos Jr thanked Harris, saying that with the upheavals in the region and beyond, this partnership becomes even more important.

In Palawan's main city of Puerto Princesa, Harris visited a small fishing community and discussed with impoverished villagers the impact of illegal fishing on their livelihood.

The US would provide an additional aid of \$7.5 million to Philippine maritime law enforcement agencies to boost their capacity to counter illegal fishing, carry out sea surveillance and help in search and rescue efforts, including in the South China Sea, according to a statement issued by her office.

The Philippine coast guard would also get additional US help to upgrade vessel traffic management system for better safety at sea. The Philippines is also now receiving real-time surveillance data to be able to detect and counter illicit activities at sea in a project by the Quadrilateral Security Dialogue, an informal strategic bloc that involves the US, India, Japan and Australia, according to Harris's office.

While the US lays no claims to the strategic waterway, where an estimated \$5 trillion in global trade transits each year, it has said that freedom of navigation and overflight

is in America's national interest.

In March, US Indo-Pacific commander Adm John C Aquilino told The Associated Press that China has fully militarised at least three of several islands it built in the disputed waters and armed them with anti-ship and anti-aircraft missile systems, laser and jamming equipment in an increasingly aggressive move that threatens all nations operating nearby.

In Sunday's incident in the Spratlys, the most hotly contested area, Vice Adm Alberto Carlos, commander of the Philippine military's Western Command, said a Chinese coast guard ship twice blocked a civilian boat manned by Philippine navy personnel before seizing the debris it was towing off Thitu Island.

China denied there was a forcible seizure and said the debris, which it confirmed was from a recent Chinese rocket launch, was handed over by Philippine forces after a friendly consultation.

Chinese coast guard ships have blocked Philippine supply boats delivering supplies to Filipino forces in the disputed waters in the past but seizing objects in the possession of another nation's military would constitute a more brazen act. In July, US Secretary of State Antony Blinken called on China to comply with a 2016 arbitration ruling that invalidated Beijing's vast territorial claims on historical grounds in the South China Sea. China has rejected the decision.

It was a huge setback for Aaditya and Uddhav Thackeray, who had thought there would be no defections from Worli as Aaditya had taken good care of the cadre and the people during

his two and half years tenure as a minister.

The emotional note took a dig at the BJP and CM Shinde without naming them directly. "I had promised you that I will make Worli 'A+' constituency in Mumbai. So much work has been done that everyone is entering Worli to share the credit," Aaditya wrote. He further wrote that the opposition played dirty politics and toppled the people-centric government of Uddhav Thackeray. "But they cannot stop us from providing selfless service to people. With your blessings and love, I will continue my work for development in Worli."

Just before Shiv Sena (UBT)'s Dussehra rally in October, hundreds of Shiv Sainiks had

joined the Shinde group. Many of them were from Worli Koliwada, a fishermen's settlement. The fishing community has been upset with Aaditya's pet Mumbai coastal road project. They felt that the Thackerays were not responsive enough to their grievances that coastal road will affect their livelihoods. They were happy about the change in power in Maharashtra and felt that the new government would take into consideration their demands. Chief Minister Shinde had assured them that he will listen to all their problems pertaining to the coastal road project. "Kolis are the sons of the soil of Worli and we will resolve their problems," Shinde had said. - Source : The week

## WHY INDIAN FOREIGN SECRETARY'S RECENT VISIT TO MYANMAR HAS LARGER RAMIFICATIONS

Foreign secretary Vinay Mohan Kwatra completed a two-day visit to Myanmar on Monday. The visit came at a time when Myanmar is being increasingly isolated in the region, with the ASEAN leaders at a conference on November 11 issuing a warning to the country to make measurable progress on a peace plan or face the risk of being barred from the bloc's meetings.

"Held discussions on important bilateral issues relating to border management, security and ongoing bilateral cooperation projects and India's support to democratic transition in Myanmar," Arindam Bagchi, spokesperson of the ministry of external affairs, tweeted.

This is the first high-level Indian visit to the country in almost a year. The last visit to the country—the first since the coup—was by previous foreign secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla in December 2021.

"During his meetings with the senior leadership of Myanmar, foreign secretary discussed maintenance of security and stability in the border areas of India and Myanmar, raised the issue of human trafficking by international crime syndicates in the Myawaddy area of Myanmar in which many Indian nationals have been caught, and reviewed bilateral development cooperation projects," the ministry of external affairs said in a release.

Close to 200 Indians have fallen prey to the fake job racket being run by the crime syndicate in the area. The stories of those who were lured with jobs were chilling—being forced to work 15 hours a day and subjected to electric shocks if they couldn't. India has been working with the Myanmar government to curb this.

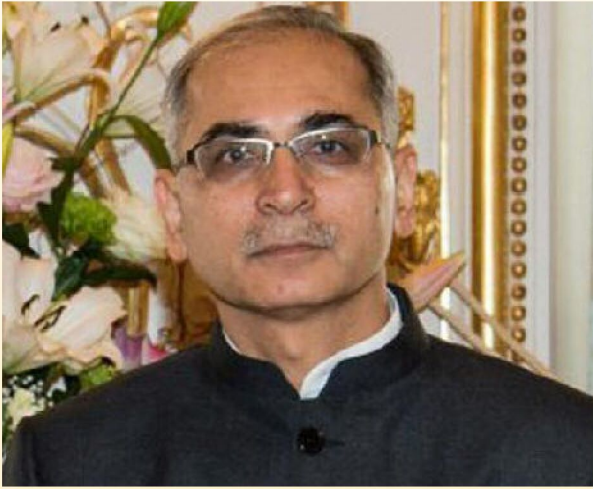

Bagchi had told a news briefing in Delhi last month.

Beyond the immediate domestic concerns, the visit of the foreign secretary has larger ramifications. With Cambodia, which is the chair of ASEAN, also altering the stance, and pressure on the junta mounting—with plenty of US push—the visit will certainly get noticed. India will be hoping to keep the channels of communication open

as China has close relations with the junta. To make matters more complicated, there has been an increasing warmth between Pakistan and the junta. The country purchased JF-17 multi-role combat aircraft from Pakistan, which is jointly developed with China. There have been reports of Pakistani military officers visiting Yangon in September last year. "Foreign secretary expressed India's continued support to people-centric socio-economic developmental projects, including those along the India-Myanmar border areas, as well as India's commitment towards expeditious implementation of ongoing connectivity initiatives such as the Kaladan Multimodal Transit Transport Project and the Trilateral Highway," the MEA said.

## Study of lung cancer patients suggests increase in cases among non-smokers

A study of 300 lung cancer patients by a team of doctors from Medanta Gurugram suggests a possible increase in non-smoker lung cancer cases and a rise in incidence of lung cancer among women.

Dr. Arvind Kumar and team from Medanta Gurugram studied 304 lung cancer patients and the hospital has launched #BeatLungCancer campaign to create awareness on the disease which is currently responsible for the largest number of deaths due to any cancer in India.

According to the study, doctors found an overall increase in the incidence of lung cancer in men and women. According to Globocan, in terms of prevalence and mortality among women, lung cancer has jumped to no.3 from no.7 over a period of 8 years.

Nearly 20 per cent of patients were found to be less than 50 years of age. The trend

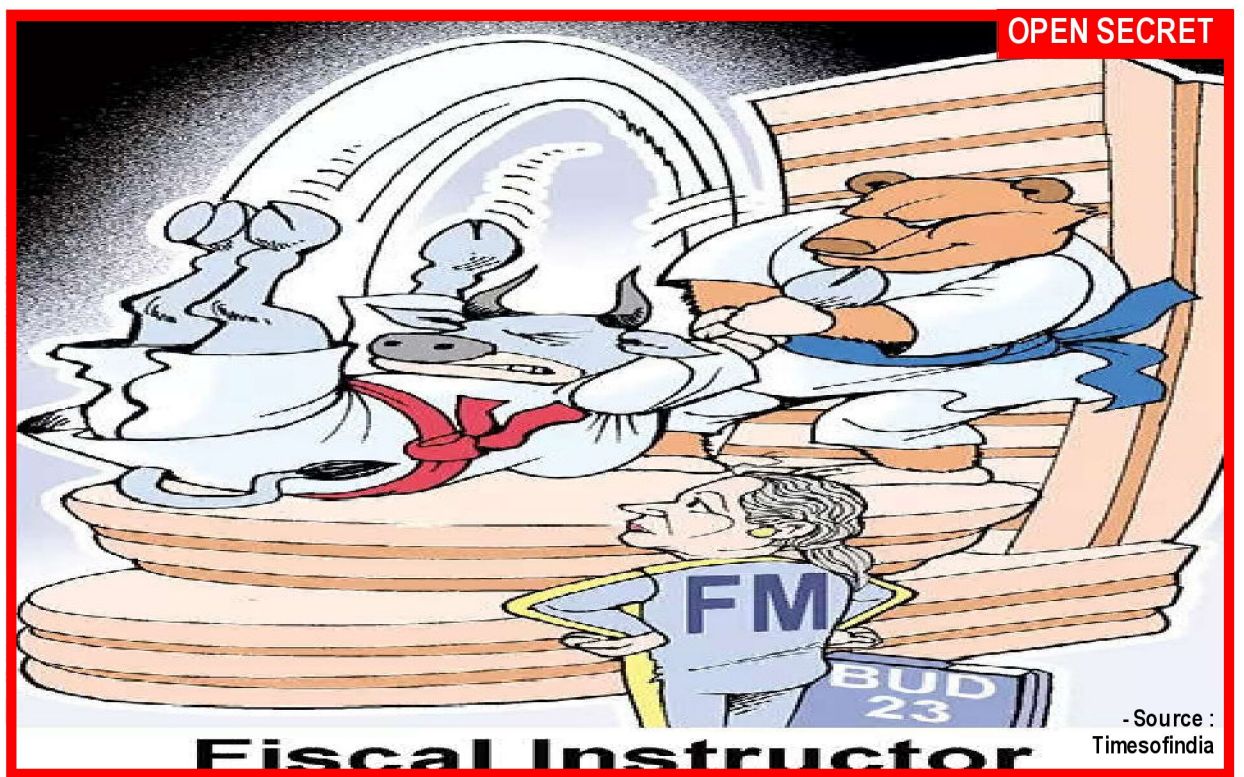
showed lung cancer developing in Indians about a decade earlier than their western counterparts. Nearly 10 per cent of all patients were less than 40 years of age with 2.6 per cent in their 20s.

Nearly 50 per cent of these patients were non-smokers. Of this, 70 per cent of patients were in the younger-than-50-years age

group and 100 per cent of patients under 30 years of age were non-smokers, the study found.

The study said more than 80 per cent of patients were diagnosed in the advanced stage of the disease when complete treatment is not possible, and the intent of treatment gets restricted to palliative.

The study also found majority of patients presented with Adenocarcinoma against Squamous Carcinoma that dominated earlier reports. Adenocarcinoma forms when cells lining the outside of the lungs become cancerous, whereas Squamous Carcinoma impacts the cells that line the surface of airways. The former is known to have a relatively poorer outcome. The study recommended that there was an urgent need to raise awareness about the risk of lung cancer across different sections of society. They suggested that effective measures to reduce tobacco consumption and control air pollution will help in controlling the rising graph of lung cancer cases. The study also recommended that measures must be taken to create awareness among the public, medical fraternity and policymakers. - Source : Theweek



## Youth World Boxing Championships: Seven Indians confirm medals

NEW DELHI: Reigning youth Asian champions Ravina, Vishwanath Suresh and Vanshaj secured medals along with four other Indians by entering the semifinals of the Youth men's and women's World Boxing Championships in La Nucia, Spain. Bhawna Sharma (48kg), Kunjarani Devi Thongam (60kg), Lashu Yadav (70kg) and Ashish (54kg) are the country's other boxers who are also assured of at least bronze medals after securing the last four berths.

Extending their spectacular show at the prestigious tournament, all four women boxers marched ahead by scoring identical 5-0 victories in their respective quarterfinal bouts.

While Ravina thrashed Romania's Alexandra Cretu in the 63kg contest, Bhavana and Kunjarani out-punched Venezuela's Evimir Brito and Aigerim Kabdolda of Kazakhstan



respectively. Lashu dominated Mexican boxer Zuzet Hernandez. Giviya Devi Huidrom (54kg) was the lone Indian woman to end up on the losing side as she went down to Kazakhstan's Elina Bazarova by 0-5. Meanwhile, it was a mixed day for India in the men's section as three of the five pugilists in action managed to

progress into the medal rounds. Vishwanath (48kg) and Vanshaj (63.5kg) posted unanimous wins over Australia's Jye Kerr and Omar Livaza of Kyrgyzstan respectively. Ashish, on the other hand, had to work hard against Scotland's Aaron Cullen as the result was declared 4-3 in the Indian's favour after the bout was

reviewed.

Deepak (75kg) and Mohit (86kg) were the two Indian male pugilists to suffer defeats in the quarterfinals. The ongoing event has been witnessing the participation of close to 600 boxers from 73 countries. 17 Indians qualifying for the last eight stage is the highest for any country at the event followed by Kazakhstan (16) and Uzbekistan (13). With seven medals already confirmed, Tamanna (50kg), Preeti Dahiya (57kg), Devika Ghorpade (52kg), Muskan (75kg) and Kirti (+81kg) will look to extend India's medals tally as they fight in the women's quarter-finals on eighth day of the competition. Rhythm (+92) and Jadumani Singh Mandengbam (51kg) will also battle it out in the men's Last-8 stage. The semi-finals will take place on Wednesday while the finals on Friday and Saturday.

## FIFA blocks "Love" detail on Belgium's World Cup jersey

FIFA has denied Belgium's request to wear team jerseys with a Love label at the World Cup in Qatar because of a commercial link to a rave festival.

Multi-colour detail on the white shirt was described as a symbol for mutual values on diversity, equality and inclusivity at the September launch by Belgium's signature electronic music event Tomorrowland.

But FIFA rules on team uniforms and equipment forced Belgium to change its World Cup plans for its first alternate jersey to the traditional red.

"We had to skip it for commercial reasons because of

referring to Tomorrowland," the Belgian football federation said on Monday. FIFA declined to comment on its ruling regarding the second-choice jersey, which was made several weeks ago.

The decision emerged on Monday after FIFA flexed its power to crack down on Belgium and six other European teams for wanting their captains to wear the One Love armband with a multi-coloured, heart-shaped logo in Qatar. The teams backed down when FIFA threatened instant yellow cards for each captain.

The armband, which breaks FIFA equipment rules, was to support a Dutch anti-

discrimination campaign that drew attention to the host nation's record on human rights.

The One Love campaign highlighted little-known FIFA rules that Belgium also fell foul of. All 32 World Cup teams had to seek FIFA approval for designs and colours of three contrasting team uniforms months ahead of the tournament. FIFA has now approved the white Belgium jersey with the same coloured trim but the Love label covered up on the inside of the collar.

"In principle, we could play in it (at the World Cup)," the Belgian soccer federation said, "but meanwhile we chose to play

in red for the group-stage matches." Belgium start its Group F programme against Canada on Wednesday. The 2018 World Cup semi-finalists then play Morocco and Croatia, the losing finalist from four years ago. A similar case enforced by European soccer body UEFA last year saw Ajax denied permission to include a "Three Little Birds" motif on a shirt inspired by reggae music icon Bob Marley for Champions League games. Ajax could wear the black shirt with gold, red and green trim to honour its fans' anthem but UEFA ruled the motif had to be removed from the back of the shirt.
