London lesson

The key takeaway from the chaotic and short-lived premiership of the UK's Liz Truss also has wide global applicability – in a globalised world with vast financial markets, political legitimacy and ability to govern are intertwined with economic and financial credibility. The policy credibility crisis arising from an economic plan that was out of sync with fiscal reality snowballed into political crisis. Britain is in the grip of stagflation, a combination of high inflation and collapsing economic growth. Markets and the country needed prudence first, some plans to cut spending next and smart policy tweaks for growth third. They got a mad mix of unfunded tax cuts and a discredited growth model. That even the complete reversal of those policies didn't save Truss shows how deeply policy mistakes can cut politically.

Every government must conclude that there is a price to be paid for reckless fiscal – as well as monetary – policies. Western countries have been merrily borrowing and, until recently, cutting rates for years. Britain is a warning to them that being developed economies doesn't mean you will never face a crisis. The only partial exception is the US, because the dollar is the global reserve currency. And if advanced economies such as the UK and Italy are struggling to cope with poor economic policies, the consequences are worse for those emerging markets that believe that they can spend their way to economic growth. Crisis after crisis have proved otherwise. It also serves as a lesson for India where economic populism has gained traction. The UK's predicament should make us pause and rethink populism. Two decades ago, with memories of the 1991 balance of payments crisis still fresh, there was political consensus to legislate fiscal safeguards through the FRBM Act. Over time, this consensus has broken down and FRBM has been diluted. Economic crises always engulf the political system and widen social fault lines. If India needs to avoid these crises, it needs durable economic growth. That won't come through fiscal populism. Growth needs an environment of macroeconomic stability. That's why India's politicians need to rediscover the spirit that catalysed a grand bargain for the greater common good. The clock's ticking.

DHANTERAS BEGINS ON POSITIVE NOTE; JEWELLERS EXPECT FOOTFALLS TO INCREASE

Dhanteras, spread over two days of the weekend, got off to an auspicious start on Saturday as consumers began trickling in to markets, with jewellers expecting the momentum to increase towards the evening.

Dhanteras, which marks the first day of Diwali in India, is considered an auspicious occasion to buy gold and silver as part of Hindu festivities.

"Since the day has just begun, the footfalls are just trickling in. As this year Dhanteras is spread over the weekend, we expect the momentum to increase towards the afternoon and evening and tomorrow."

"Mainly, since morning people who had pre-booked, are coming to pick up the items to avoid the crowd," All India Gem And Jewellery Domestic Council chairman Ashish Pethe told PTI.

Since the last 3-4 days the consumer sentiment has been good and the sales momentum has been positive. The industry expects a good two days of business, he

added.

PNG Jewellers Chairman and Managing Director Saurabh Gadgil said in Maharashtra, the footfalls have been quite good since morning as people are coming in to either pick up their pre-booked jewellery or to buy gold and silver coins.

"We are seeing a good amount of people flocking in to pick up their pre-booked items. Also, a lot of young people are coming in to purchase gold and silver coins this year."

"Overall we expect a good



Dhanteras this weekend as the gold price at around Rs 47,000 per 10 grams is also supportive to the demand," he added.

Uttar Pradesh-based Aishwarya Gems and Jewels Director Vaibhav Saraf said the footfalls are slow as the day has just begun.

"But looking at the momentum of the last 3-4 days, we expect the footfalls to increase towards the afternoon and the evening. Overall we expect it to be a good Dhanteras this year," he added.

All India Gem And Jewellery Domestic Council Vice Chairman Saiyam Mehra said footfalls are just beginning in Zaveri Bazar in Mumbai and "we expect it to gather momentum after 2 pm when the Dhanteras muhurat (auspicious time) begins till 6 pm on Sunday."

Senco Gold and Diamonds Managing Director and CEO Suvankar Sen opined that there has been a lot of positivity since Friday.

"Moreover, as this year Dhanteras falls on a weekend, we expect it will be very good. Footfalls are steady since morning and are mostly for the pre-booked orders," he noted.

The momentum is expected to increase in the afternoon and evening, mostly after 2 pm when the muhurat for Dhanteras begins, he added. - Source : Theweek

Hon'ble Supreme Court directions on bursting crackers

Port Blair, Oct. 23: In pursuance of order passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 29-10-2021 in the matter of LA. No. 44727/2021 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.728 of 2015 titled as Arjun Gopal and others -vs- Union of India and others (Firecrackers case), the directions issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court are reiterated below for compliance by the general public:



The crackers with reduced emission (improved crackers) and green crackers with QR code would be permitted to be manufactured and sold.

The manufacture, sale and use of joined firecrackers (series crackers or laris) is hereby banned as the same causes huge air, noise and solid waste problems.

No e-commerce websites, including Flipkart, Amazon, etc., shall accept any online orders and effect online sales. Any such e-commerce companies found selling crackers online will be hauled up for contempt of court

and the Court may also pass, in that eventuality, orders of monetary penalties as well.

Firecrackers with Barium salts is banned.

On Diwali days or on any other festivals like Gurupurab etc., when such fireworks generally take place, it would strictly be from 8 pm till 10 pm only. On Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, when such fireworks start around midnight i.e., 12 am, it would be from 11.55 pm till 12.30 am only.

Nobody would be permitted to flout and/or disobey the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Any willful and deliberated disobedience will be viewed very seriously and action as deems fit will be taken against the violators by the enforcement agencies.

Dialysis unit @ G B...

Those who have enough finance use it to travel to the mainland. Rest had to rely on the mercy of God. In view of hardships faced by islanders in absence of dialysis, in the year 1995 a delegation of patients and their attenders headed by Shri. K. Ganeshan Ex-Pradesh Council Member Andaman & Nicobar Island met the then Lt. Governor requested to make Dialysis service available at Port Blair. Instructions were issued from Raj Niwas to the Directorate of Health Services to make Dialysis service available at least at G. B. Pant Hospital. Dr. Shiv Shankar said that though the Dialysis was installed at G. B. Pant Hospital, it couldn't be brought to service for

want of Technician/expert in handling the machine. For seven years, i.e. up till 2002 the unit remained out of service, he added. Dr. Singh said that he took training from a technician at Sri Ramachandra Hospital, Porur Chennai and brought the Dialysis unit in service on 7th October, 2002. Since then the unit has been serving the patients of these islands restlessly. As on date the Dialysis unit at G. B. Pant is operated on a 24x7 basis. Detailing the expansion of Dialysis units in isles, Dr. Shiv Shankar Singh said that units are presently functional in Mayabunder (in the year 2013), Bambooflat (2021) and Rangat. Very soon the dialysis unit will

be made operational at Car Nicobar, R. K. Pur and Swaraj Dweep Island. He said that on the mainland, Dialysis units are available mostly at State and District Hospitals but isles, Directorate of Health services has made the Dialysis unit functional even at PHC level. Dr. Singh said that Health services in isles is best in the country and further expansions are in pipeline. He was placed on duty to Sri Ramachandra Hospital, Porur Chennai. Aneshan discussed the journey of Health Care Services in isles. Service is being in its endeavour to ensure availability of specialized health care services

HOME MINISTRY CANCELS FCRA LICENCES OF TWO NGOS HEADED BY SONIA GANDHI

The Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has cancelled the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) licences of the Rajiv Gandhi Foundation (RGF) and the Rajiv Gandhi Charitable Trust (RGCT), two NGOs headed by Congress leader Sonia Gandhi, for alleged violation of laws, officials said on Sunday.

The action came following investigations carried out by an inter-ministerial committee formed by the MHA in 2020.

"The FCRA licences of the Rajiv Gandhi Foundation and the Rajiv Gandhi Charitable Trust have been cancelled after investigations against these NGOs," an official said.

The investigators covered alleged manipulation of documents while filing income-tax returns, misuse of funds and money laundering while receiving funds from foreign countries, including China.

Former Congress president Sonia Gandhi is the chairperson of the RGF as well as the RGCT. The trustees of the RGF are former prime minister Manmohan Singh, former finance minister P Chidambaram, Congress MP Rahul Gandhi, Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, Montek Singh Ahluwalia, Suman Dubey and Ashok Ganguly.

The trustees of the RGCT are Rahul Gandhi, Ashok Ganguly, Banshi Mehta and Deep Joshi.

Set up in 1991, the RGF worked on a number of critical issues, including health, science and technology, women and children and disability support, till 2009. It

also worked in the education sector, according to its website.

The RGCT was established in 2002 to address the development needs of the underprivileged people of the country, especially the rural poor.

It currently works in the poorest regions of Uttar Pradesh, one of the least developed states in the country, and Haryana through two development initiatives -- the Rajiv Gandhi Mahila Vikas Pariyojana (RGMVP) and the Indira Gandhi Eye Hospital and Research Centre (IGEHR) -- according to the RGCT website.

Both the RGF and the RGCT function from the same building -- Jawahar Bhawan -- located on Rajendra Prasad Road, near the Parliament complex, in New Delhi.

The NGOs came under the scanner in July 2020 after the MHA set up an inter-ministerial committee headed by an Enforcement Directorate (ED) officer to

probe possible violations of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), the Income Tax Act and the FCRA.

Another organisation that came under the probe was Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust.

However, no action has so far been taken against the third organisation.

The probe team comprised officers from the ministries of home and finance, the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), besides the ED, and was mandated to investigate if these trusts run by the Gandhi family and other Congress leaders allegedly manipulated any documents while filing income tax returns or misused and laundered money received from foreign countries.

During the Indian Army's face-off with China's People's Liberation Army (PLA) in Ladakh in 2020, ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) president J P Nadda had alleged that China gave funds to the RGF between 2005 and 2009 to carry out studies that were not in national interest.

Nadda had also alleged that money from the Prime Minister's Relief Fund was diverted to the RGF, which also received funds from fugitive businessman Mehul Choksi.

The BJP had also raised a question that whether the funds received by the RGF were a "bribe" for lobbying for a free-trade agreement (FTA) between India and China.

According to the RGF's annual report of 2005-06, which is available on its website, the embassy of the People's Republic of China is listed as one of its donors under "partner organisations and donors."

'Rescuers slithered down from chopper to reach Arunachal crash site'

The bodies of all five air warriors in the ill-fated ALH-WSI helicopter were recovered when last reports came in on Saturday after which the Search and Rescue (SAR) mission was called off.

"So inaccessible and difficult was the area of the Army helicopter crash site that rescue teams from the Army and the Indian Air Force had to slither down from hovering helicopters to reach the exact spot to search

for the bodies that were mangled beyond recognition," a military source told THE WEEK.

Inducted into the Army Aviation Corps in June 2015, the homemade armed Advanced Light Helicopter with an integrated weapon system (ALH-WSI) crashed into a mountain slope around 10:43 am on Friday in an area between Tuting and Yingkong. Tuting is about 30 km south from the Line of Actual Control

(LAC)—the de facto border between India and China.

The fallen have been identified as Major Vikas Bhambhu, Major Mustafa Bohara, and army technicians Aswin K, Biresh Sinha and Rohitshva Kumar.

An Army statement said that the pilots had more than 600 combined flying hours on ALH-WSI and over 1,800 service flying hours between them.

Prior to the crash, the Air Traffic Control had received a 'mayday' call suggesting a technical or mechanical failure.

The weather on Friday morning during the time of the crash has been reported to be perfectly clear and sunny.

While the ALH can ferry about 14 people including the two pilots, the armed 'Rudra' version carries a smaller crew because of the heavier payload

that includes weaponries.

"Of the four bodies that were located on Friday, only the remains of two could be brought back yesterday. Today, the remaining body was located and the remains of the three were brought back. The process of identification is now on," said the source, adding that the remains were mangled beyond recognition.

Two ALHs and one Mi-17 helicopter were deployed for the SAR operation.

The ill-fated chopper had taken off from Likabali airbase in the Arunachal foothills.

Friday's crash the Army chopper came 16 days after the crash of a Cheetah helicopter during a regular sortie near Arunachal Pradesh's Tawang where one pilot lost his life while another was grievously injured.

people requested for Primary School renovation including compound wall construction, and set apart land for development of Mini Stadium.
