Global storm

Indian financial markets were battered on Friday, in line with major global markets. The BSE Sensex closed lower by 1.7% at 58,098.92, while the rupee-dollar exchange rate hit a record low to end Friday's trading at Rs 80.99. RBI's monetary policy committee, which will have its bimonthly meeting next week, has to contend with risks coming largely from overseas. Right now, uncertainty and volatility are worryingly high.

The main sources of risk are, first, the unclear trajectory of major central banks trying to pull back inflation and, second, fluid geopolitics. This week most major central banks increased interest rates and indicated more hikes are in store. Most currencies weakened against the dollar and Japan's central bank made its first foreign exchange market intervention in over two decades. The hardening of interest rates will trigger a sharp economic slowdown in major economies. India's exports will feel its impact. The unusual aspect of today's global economic scenario is that inflation is unlikely to quickly trend downwards even as demand falls. This is because of ongoing energy supply readjustments that have pushed economic activity and inflation in different directions.

For instance, European gas and electricity prices have risen 105% and 75%, respectively, since the period just before the Russian invasion of Ukraine. Business surveys published yesterday showed that Europe's economic activity is rapidly slowing as the energy shock undermines manufacturing. Price levels however are high. The UK's inflation, at 9.9%, is almost five times its inflation target. Economic policymaking in India will have to factor in an abnormal global scenario, with no clear signal about the near future behaviour of either revival or price stability. The good thing is India has fiscal space – gross tax revenue increased 25% to Rs 8.69 lakh crore in April-July. It's wise to keep the fiscal powder dry in an uncertain environment.

BIGGEST PSY-OPS IN RECENT TIMES: WHY XI JINPING'S 'HOUSE ARREST' TRENDED ON TWITTER

This was psychological warfare at its best. The world found Xi Jinping trending on Twitter on Saturday (the third top trend in India), albeit for reasons that did not make the Chinese happy. Twitter was full of unverified rumours about Xi being placed under house arrest in a palace coup. The reports said the Chinese president was detained after CCP seniors removed him as head of the People's Liberation Army (PLA). The coup reports emerged after Xi's return from Samarkand in Uzbekistan for the Shanghai Cooperation Summit (SCO).

This year's SCO summit will not be forgotten in a hurry. Rumour had it that Xi wasn't seen after the summit, he had skipped dinner. Soon after his return to Beijing, reports of massive cancellation of flights added to speculations that gripped Western and Asian media. The speculations also coincided with China sentencing two former ministers to death and four officials to life imprisonment.

The timing of the anti-corruption crackdown is important.

Coming ahead of the CCP's 20th Party Congress on October 16—the biggest event in which Xi will be seeking an unprecedented third term

in office—massive disinformation campaigns took several countries, including China, by surprise. Military watchers and strategists in US, Taiwan and Nepal showed special interest.

One of the reasons why the disinformation campaign around Xi's house arrest gained traction, as well as credence, is because the news depicted General Li Qiaoming as the

protagonist leader to organise the coup. Qiaoming, 61, a former commander of the PLA Northern Theatre Command, has been favoured by Xi in a way that created dissatisfaction among many senior military leaders in China, according to experts. He jumped to a post which normally takes five years or more of service.

"This was because Xi identified



him as the present generation Chinese military thinker and strategist," said a senior security official. The unconventional promotions given to a few juniors or younger PLA officers have been a sore point for PLA seniors, who had come up through proper channels with great patience, the official said.

The issue of promotions to be announced during 20th Party Congress is of great interest. Within China, the many aspiring, older PLA generals and officers are watching the developments closely; whether it is for the Americans or the Japanese, the outcome of the 20th Party Congress will determine future engagements.

In fact, General Li Qiaoming is likely to enter the Central Military Commission at the 20th National Congress. On September 8, he was replaced by Wang Qiang, the new NTC commander, and he attended the meeting of the CMC on September 21. Experts said he may become one of the vice chairman of the CMC, which opens the door to him becoming a politburo member.

Qiaoming's rise happened after 2013, when Xi came to power. He joined the PLA in December 1976, and is a member of the 19th CCP

Central Committee. With experience in the Sino-Vietnamese War, he held several key posts in artillery brigade, military affairs division and training division before being appointed as chief of staff of the PLA 41st Group Army in January 2010. In less than five years, he was appointed commander of the PLA 41st Group Army in 2013. During the military reforms in 2016, he was promoted to deputy commander of the NTC. In August 2017, he became commander of the NTC—a post he held for five years. Unlike other senior generals who rarely speak on major political issues, Qiaoming has been writing articles regularly. Interestingly, in 2013, he published an article 'The Historical Tragedy of the Non-Partyization of the Soviet Army', a lesson from the collapse of the Soviet Union. This was to illustrate the importance of the party to the leadership of the army. "The Soviet Union disintegrated because the party did not have its own army," he said.

As it gets down to more serious business in China, social media aside, all eyes are now on how the 20th Party Congress strengthens the CCP's control over the army.

RBI SET FOR FOURTH STRAIGHT RATE HIKE TO QUELL INFLATION, SAY EXPERTS

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) may take cues from its global counterparts, including the US Federal Reserve, to raise interest rate for the fourth time in a row on Friday to tame stubborn inflation.

The RBI, which has since May raised the short-term lending rate (repo) by 140 basis points (bps), may again go for a 50-bps increase to take it to a three-year high of 5.9 per cent, say experts.

The central bank had raised the repo rate by 40 bps in May and 50 bps each in June and August. The present rate is 5.4 per cent.

The consumer price index (CPI) based retail inflation, which had started showing signs of moderation since May, has again firmed up to 7 per cent in August. The RBI takes into account retail inflation while framing its bi-monthly monetary policy.

The RBI Governor-headed Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) is scheduled to start its three-day deliberations on Wednesday. The decision of the rate-setting panel would be announced on Friday (September 30).

The US Fed delivered third consecutive rate hike after it raised the rates by 75 bps to take the target range to 3 - 3.25 per cent. The central banks of the UK

and the EU have also gone for rate hikes to tame inflation.

Madan Sabnavis, Chief Economist at Bank of Baroda, said inflation in India remains high at around 7 per cent and is unlikely to come down any time soon.

"This means that a rate hike is given. The quantum is what the market would be interested in. While a hike of 25-35 bps would have signaled that the RBI is confident that the worst of inflation is over,

per cent, with a margin of 2 per cent on either side.

Dhruv Agarwala, Group CEO, Housing.com, said reining in inflation will remain the RBI's top concern amid resilient economic expansion and robust credit growth.

"Any hike in rates would result in banks increasing home loan interest rates, too. But we are of the opinion that its impact would not be significant as demand for property remains robust. Demand is only going to accelerate further during this festive season," he said.

Global commodity prices have remained volatile after their fall from historical highs in June.

SBI in a special report said a 50 basis points hike in repo rate "looks imminent".

"We expect the peak repo rate in the cycle at 6.25 per cent. A final rate hike of 35 bps is expected in December policy," it said.

Aditi Nayar, Chief Economist, ICRA, too expects another 'new normal' 50 bps rate hike from the MPC in September 2022.

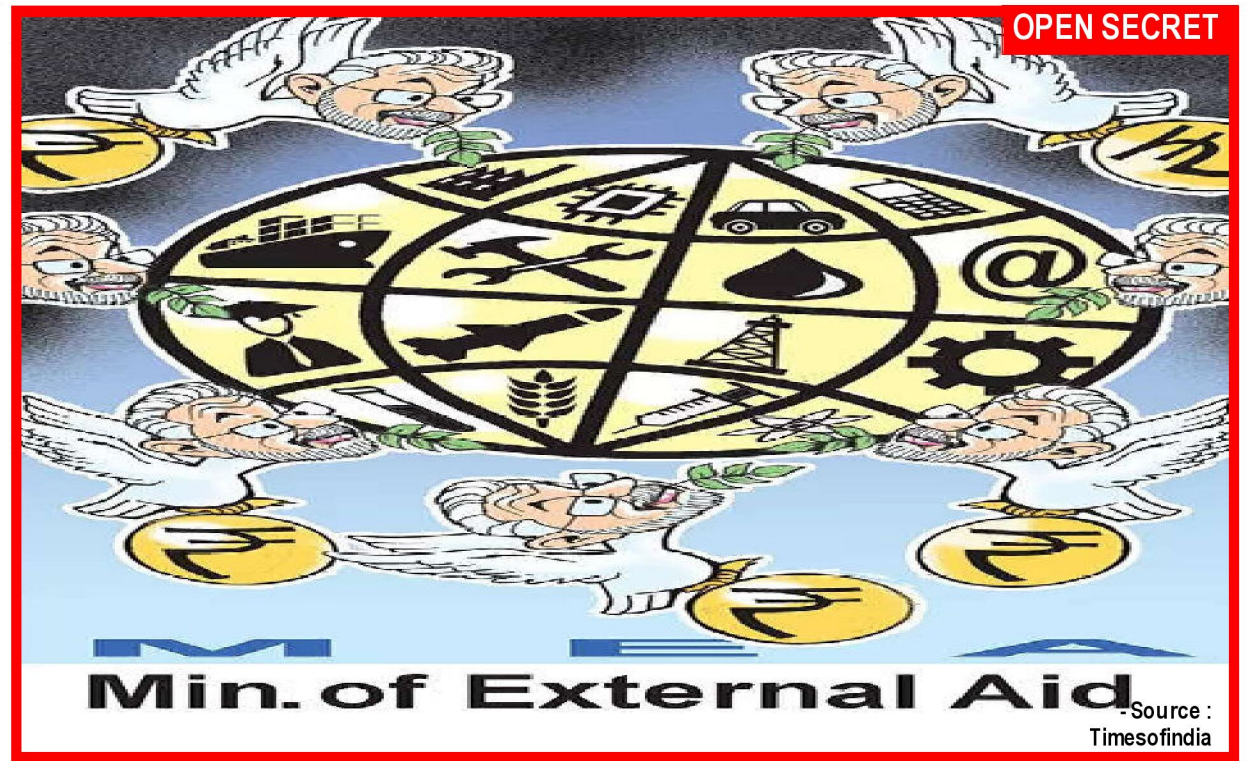
With inflation expected to soften in October 2022, the December policy decision is likely to be highly data dependent, she said.

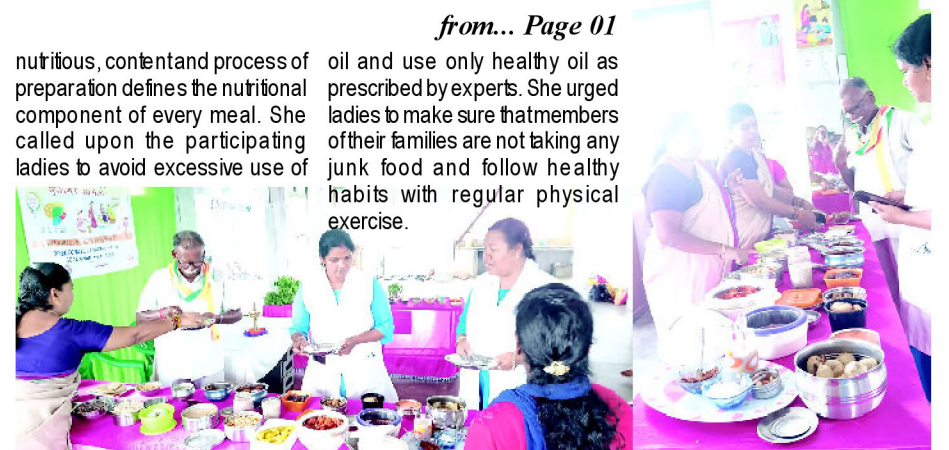

Russia backs India for permanent membership in UNSC

Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov, during his address at the 77th session of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) in New York, backed India as a worthy candidate for permanent membership in the UN Security Council.

"We see the prospects of making Security Council more democratic via representation of countries from Africa, Asia, and Latin America. India and Brazil, in particular, are key international actors and worthy candidates for permanent membership within the council," the Russian FM said.

India is currently a non-permanent member of the 15-nation UNSC. The five permanent members of the UNSC are the United States, United Kingdom, Russia, France, and China.

Over the years, India has been at the forefront of sustained

efforts to reform the Security Council. "India has always espoused a cooperative, inclusive and consultative approach to international relations," said External Affairs Minister (EAM) S. Jaishankar.

Earlier, India with 31 countries in a joint statement on reforms stated that an expansion of the Security Council in both permanent and non-permanent categories, as well as reform in its

working methods, is indispensable to making the body more representative, legitimate, and effective.

According to the statement, the head of delegations was convinced of the need to restore faith in effective multilateralism. "We stand united, as a group of pro-reform like-minded States, determined to work towards a more inclusive, responsive, and participatory international

governance architecture," the statement reads.

"We further recognise that the lack of progress in Security Council reform has serious implications, not only for the continued relevance of global governance institutions, but also for global peace and security and delivering on the purposes, principles, and promises of the United Nations Charter," it added.

During his address at the UNGA, Lavrov accused Western countries of "throwing a fit over the referendum that is being conducted in the Russian-controlled areas of Ukraine. He said the US was trying to turn the whole world into its 'backyard', and together with its partners, punishing dissenters, through what he called 'illegal, unilateral sanctions' which violate the UN charter.
