ety are unable to pull on the days due to this unchecked price rise. Civil Supplies Department has completely failed to arrest the spiraling prices. She informed the Chief Secretary that CPI (M) Port Blair Area Committee in its meeting held on 29th December, 2022 reviewed this situation and expressed concern

रेस्टोरेंट में काम किया, गाड़ी-फंक्शन में डीजे बजाया. आज बना गिनीज बुक में दर्ज होने वाला इंडिया का पहला टैटू आर्टिस्ट

पापा दिल्ली में गार्ड की नौकरी करते थे, तो घर बमुश्किल चल पाता था। आर्थिक हालत ऐसे थे कि पढ़ाई करने के लिए मैं 10वीं बोर्ड एग्जाम खत्म होने के अगले दिन से ही सड़का. पर, रेस्टोरेंट में काम करने लगा।

16-17 साल की उम्र रही होगी, पहली



नौकरी पर्या बांटने से शुरू की थी। दिहाड़ी में मुझे प्रतिदिन के 100 रुपए मिलते थे। फिर रेस्टोरेंट में कई सालों तक पढ़ाई के साथ-साथ काम करता रहा, बाद में पार्टी-फंक्शन में जाकर डीजे भी बजाने लगा। मैं लोकेश वर्मा, गिनीज बुक ऑफ वर्ल्ड रिकॉर्ड में शुमार इंडिया का पहला टैटू आर्टिस्ट हूं। मेरी गिनती वर्ल्ड के टॉप-10 टैटू आर्टिस्ट में होती है। इस वक्त इंडिया में तीन और यूरोप के लंगेनबर्ग में एक टैटू स्टूडियो है। मेरे लिए दिल्ली की एक लोअर मिडिल क्लास फैमिली में पैदा होकर यूरोप तक पहुंचने का सपना देखना आसान नहीं था। फिर भी मैंने दिल्ली की तंग गलियों से यूरोप तक का सफर तय किया, अपनी अलग पहचान बनाई, नाम कमाया। हर चुनौतियों को बतौर अवसर लिया, जिसकी बदौलत मैं यहां तक पहुंचा। पापा आर्मी से रिटायर्ड हैं, लेकिन वो लो टैक पर थे। सैलरी इतनी भी नहीं कि घर-परिवार का बेहतर तरीके से गुजर-बसर हो सके। पापा अपनी नौकरी के दौरान अहमदाबाद पोस्टेड थे, यहां के अहमदाबाद मिलिट्री हॉस्पिटल में पैदा हुआ। सामान्य बच्चों की तरह मेरी भी परवरिश होने लगी, मां बच्चों को पढ़ाने का काम करती थीं, लेकिन मेरी देखरेख के लिए उन्होंने वो काम भी छोड़ दिया। पापा आर्मी में थे, इसलिए सेंट्रल स्कूल में आसानी से एडमिशन हो गया। जब बड़ा हुआ तो पता चला कि हम एक्स्ट्रा खर्च नहीं कर सकते हैं। बाहर कहीं रेस्टोरेंट में जाकर खाना भी नहीं खा सकते हैं। जो घर पर मम्मी बनातीं, वही खाना पड़ता। ये 1990 के आस-पास की बात है। जब मुझे पता चला कि घर में पैसे की काफी दिक्कतें हैं। पापा भी तब तक रिटायर हो चुके थे। उसके बाद उन्होंने दिल्ली में ही गार्ड की नौकरी करनी शुरू कर दी थी। स्कूल की पढ़ाई भी खत्म नहीं हुई थी, मुझे अपना खर्च, किताब-कॉपी के पैसे भी निकाल पाना मुश्किल हो रहा था। इसके बाद मैंने काम करने का फैसला किया। बमुश्किल 17 साल की उम्र रही होगी मेरी। मुझे याद है 10वीं बोर्ड का एग्जाम खत्म होने के अगले दिन से ही मैं नौकरी खोजने लगा था। पहली नौकरी स्कूल-कॉलेज के बाहर पर्चे बांटने की थी। मैं हर रोज दोपहर में सड़क किनारे खड़े होकर पर्चे बांटता, बदले में मुझे 100 रुपए दिहाड़ी मिलती थी। मैं 12वीं में एडमिशन ले चुका था। मुझे लगा कि इस कमाई से न घर का खर्च चल सकता है और न अपना। मैंने रेस्टोरेण्ट्स में काम करने का फैसला किया। दिल्ली के कई रेस्टोरेण्ट्स के चक्कर लगाने लगा, लेकिन काम नहीं मिला। आखिर में मुझे मैकडोनाल्ड्स (मैक डी) की एक यूनिट में काम मिल गया। यहां ट्रेनिंग के दौ. रान झाड़ू-पोछा से लेकर टॉयलेट तक साफ करना होता था। मेरा काम हर दिन रेस्टोरेंट की साफ-सफाई करना, झाड़ू-पोछा करना, बाथरूम साफ करना होता था। कुछ महीने के बाद मैं बर्गर बनाने और काउंटर संभालने का काम करने लगा। दरअसल, उस वक्त मुझे पैसे की सबसे ज्यादा जरूरत थी। इसलिए जो भी काम मिलता था, मैं करने के लिए तैयार रहता। रेस्टोरेंट में काम करने के साथ ही मैंने B Com के बाद MBA कर लिया, लेकिन कहीं भी नौकरी नहीं मिली। एक दोस्त के कहने पर DJ का काम शुरू कर दिया। पार्टी-फंक्शन में DJ बजाने जाता था। बचपन से ही मुझे स्केचिंग का भी शौक था, कई तरह के पोर्ट्रेट बनाता। एक रोज दिल्ली में ही मैं DJ बजाने के लिए गया था, यहां एक व्यक्ति ने अपनी बांह पर टैटू बनवा रखा था। जिसके बाद मैंने भी टैटू में अपना करियर आजमाने की ठानी। मैंने सेविंग के कुछ पैसे बचाकर रखे थे, उससे मशीनें खरीदीं और अपने ऊपर ही टैटू बनाना शुरू कर दिया। फिर पापा को टैटू बनाया। दोस्तों को जब पता चला, तो वो भी टैटू बनवाने लगे। फिर मैं जबरदस्ती दोस्त और उनके फ्रेंड्स को पकड़-पकड़कर टैटू बनाने लगा। दोस्तों पर, अपने ऊपर प्रैक्टिस कर-करके मैंने टैटू बनाना सीखा, खुद का टीचर खुद ही था। इसलिए कोई गलती और डर की गुंजाइश नहीं थी। टैटू बनाने के बदले पैसे तो नहीं मिलते थे, लेकिन टैटू बनाना धीरे-धीरे सीख गया। दिल्ली के वसंत विहार इलाके में एक सैलून की दुकान चलती थी, उसके एक हिस्से में छोटा सा कमरा था, जिसमें मैंने टैटू बनाने का स्टूडियो सेटअप किया था। उस वक्त इंडिया में न तो टैटू का कोई खास चलन था और न ही कोई पोर्ट्रेट टैटू बना रहा था। मैं इंडिया का पहला कलर पोर्ट्रेट टैटू बनाने वाला आर्टिस्ट हूं। लेकिन, इसके बदले में मुझे ताने मिलने शुरू हो गए। दरअसल, अपने यहां के सभी पेरेण्ट्स चाहते हैं, उनके बच्चे डिग्री के मुताबिक ही जॉब करें। घरवाले भी उतने श्योर नहीं थे कि मैं टैटू में अपना करियर बना पाऊंगा। रिश्तेदार कहते थे- MBA करने के बाद टैटू का काम करेगा? लेकिन मुझे इसमें मजा आने लगा। 2010 बीत रहा था, एक यूरोपियन टैटू आर्टिस्ट इंडिया आए हुए थे, उनसे मेरा मिलना हुआ। तभी से मैं यूरोप जाने लगा। इस दौरान मैंने 17 देशों

Port Blair, Dec. 31 : The 18th Round of HIV Sentinel Surveillance (HSS) 2022-23 will be carried out in Andaman & Nicobar Islands from 1st January, 2023 to 31st March, 2023 along with the rest of the country. Surveillance is an ongoing, systematic collection, analysis interpretation and dissemination of data regarding a health related event for the use in public health action to reduce morbidity and mortality

In her address, the chief guest remarked that HIV Sentinel Surveillance has been the basis for tracking of HIV/AIDS since its inception and it has been the mainstay of epidemic monitoring among ANC, High Risk Group and Bridge population under the National AIDS and STD Control Programme.

Department of Agriculture is implementing Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Scheme in A & N Islands.

Port Blair, Jan. 2 : The Department of Agriculture is implementing Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Scheme in A & N Islands. The Department in coordination with the PRIs are working in tandem in all the Zones of A&N Islands continuously from the day of launch of the scheme for its better reach to the farmers.

To make the integrated platform available in the country to assist in benefit transfer, a platform named PM-KISAN Portal was launched for uploading the farmers' details at a single web portal in a uniform structure. Accordingly, a facility is provided in PM-KISAN portal in which any grievances related to PM-KISAN scheme can be submitted. The Department of Agriculture has requested the farmers to submit their grievances in PM-KISAN Portal/ Mobile App and they can also contact the respective Agriculture Extension staff/Agriculture office.

It is to mention that there are various factors owing to which, the farmer does not receive the benefit of PM-KISAN. The main reason being mismatch in the spelling of the name in the bank account and the name entered on the Aadhaar Card due to which farmers fail to get the money. To facilitate farmers, the Govt. of India has decided to undertake e-KYC verification of all the eligible registered farmer-beneficiaries of PM-KISAN Scheme for smooth transfer of benefits.

The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries can be done by both e-KYC OTP mode as well as e-KYC biometric mode. The e-KYC authentication of the beneficiaries through OTP mode can be done on PM-KISAN portal, free of cost by the beneficiaries or State functionaries. For e-KYC biometric authentication facility, the beneficiary may visit the nearest CSC. The CSC will charge for bio-metric authentication

tion from each beneficiary. For any query/doubt related to e-KYC, the beneficiaries can also contact the concerned Zonal Agriculture Office/ Field functionaries of Agriculture Department.

Farmers have been advised to use only the official website of PM-KISAN portal and not to download any other App for e-KYC authentication.

As per the guidelines of the scheme, the following categories of beneficiaries of higher economic status are not eligible for benefit under the scheme:

- (b) Farmer families in which one or more of its members belong to following categories :
 - Former and present holders of constitutional posts

Health Advisory for COVID-19
