Addressing the participants, the Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District stressed on the importance of indigenous cultural sports in Car Nicobar and mentioned that the District Administration will extend all support for the conduct of cultural activities and will also facilitate its wide publicity.

Member of Parliament requests to enhance honorarium for an amount of Rs.1500/- Per Lecture to the maximum of Rs. 50,000/- to all Guest Lecturers

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has taken up the matter of the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration regarding enhancement of honorarium for an amount of Rs.1,500/- per Lecture to the maximum of Rs. 50,000/- to all Guest Lecturers working under Andaman and Nicobar Administration. During a meeting with the Chief Secretary this morning, the Member of Parliament mentioned that he has got representations from the guest lecturers engaged in various colleges functioning under Andaman and Nicobar Administration for taking up the matter with the authorities concerned for payment of Rs 1500/- per lecture to the maximum of Rs 50,000/- which is extended only to those guest lecturers who possess pre requisite qualification of UGC regulations. "Such guest faculties having less qualification are around 90 constituting nearly 85% of the total Guest lecturers engaged in JNRM, ANCOL, MGGC and TGCE performing work similar

to regular lecturers," he mentioned. The Member of Parliament informed the Chief Secretary that most of them are engaged since 2004 and were working on meager monthly honorarium of Rs. 5000/- which was enhanced during the year 2009 to Rs. 250/- Per Lecture subject to the maximum of 10,000/- for the period upto March 2013. During 2013, the enhancement of honorarium to the Guest Lecturers was done for an amount of Rs.1,000/- Per Lecture subject to the maximum of Rs.25,000/- per month for UGC qualified candidates. However the matter for payment of equal honorarium to qualified and less qualified guest lecturers was taken up with the Andaman and Nicobar Administration and the administration was gracious enough to confer same honorarium of Rs.1,000/- Per Lecture subject to the maximum of Rs.25,000/- per month to both UGC qualified and less qualified guest lecturers. He added that now the Andaman and Nicobar Administration since December 2022 has enhanced the honorarium

to Rs 1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs 50,000/- per month for only UGC qualified lectures which has caused pain to left out lecturers who are also discharging duties with sincerity like other guest lecturers meeting to the teaching requirements at all these 4 (four) Government colleges. "The enhancement in honorarium to Rs.1, 500/- per Lecture to the maximum of Rs.50,000/- for all the Guest Lecturers working under A & N Administration including these 90 odd long serving guest lecturers though having less qualification than required by the UGC will considerably improve the financial condition and will motivate them to discharge their duty with much dedication and sincerity," the Member of Parliament said. Hence he requested to enhance honorarium to Rs.1500/- per lecturer to maximum of Rs.50,000/- per month for all guest lecturers working in the colleges of Andaman & Nicobar Administration at par with UGC qualified guest lecturers.

Port Blair, April 10 : The Directorate of Industries, A&N Administration organized a short term Skill Development Training Program on 'Handicrafts (Coconut Shell & Wood) products' at Gram Panchayat Mithakhari from March 15, 2023. Altogether, 22 candidates participated in the training program and were imparted basic skill and knowledge for making handicrafts, thus creating self-employment opportunities and avenues for their livelihood.

Member of Parliament requests Hon'ble Lt. Governor to construct a Jetty at Shoal Bay to promote tourism, generate employment and boost local economy of the region

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor to construct a Jetty at Shoal Bay, which could serve as a vital link to Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep, generate employment and also boost the local economy of Shoal Bay area. During a meeting with Hon'ble Lt. Governor on 11 April 2023, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma highlighted a number of burning issues and construction of Jetty at Shoal Bay was one of the prominent issues.

The Member of Parliament informed the Hon'ble Lt. Governor that Shoal Bay is slowly becoming one of the popular destinations for visitors in Andaman Nicobar Islands, as local residents now visit the area in large numbers on holidays. He pointed out that it is less well-known that Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep are located very close to Shoal Bay, and it takes only 30 to 35 minutes to reach these two tourist favourite Islands from Shoal Bay. The Member of Parliament added that the pro-

posed Jetty at Shoal Bay would serve three purposes. Firstly, it would make it easier for people of the South Andaman region as well as tourists to reach Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep from Shoal Bay, reducing travel time and making it more convenient. "Secondly, it would promote tourism in Shoal Bay and the entire South Andaman area, generate employment and provide a much-needed economic boost to the people of the region. The domestic and international tourists visiting Shoal Bay could also enjoy the natural

beauty of the area, making it a must-visit tourist spot in Andaman. Lastly, it will generate more revenue for Tourist Vehicles Owners and Small Boat Owners as they will get one more tourist destination to drop and pick tourists on a regular basis," he added. He said that construction of the proposed Jetty at Shoal Bay would benefit the people of Andaman in many ways. It would not only make it easier for them to travel but also help the tourism industry of Andaman to grow.

Here are some do's and don'ts to help you stay safe during Hot Weather Condition:

Do's:
• Drink plenty of water: Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water and other non-alcoholic beverages throughout the day.
• Stay in a cool place: Stay in an air-conditioned environment, or if that's not possible, find a cool, shaded area, such as a tree-covered park or a building with air conditioning.
• Wear appropriate clothing: Wear light-weight, loose-fitting, and light-colored clothing to help your body stay cool.
• Use sunscreen: Protect your skin from the sun's harmful rays by

applying sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher.
• Check on others: Keep an eye on friends, family, and neighbours who may be more vulnerable to heat-related illnesses.
Don'ts:

FIRE SERVICE WEEK

Together with the rest of the country, the A & N Police Fire Service is observing the Fire Service week from 14th to 20th April, 2023 this year. The theme for this year is “**Awareness in fire safety for growth of National Infrastructure (AGNI)**”. The Fire Service Week is organized every year in memory of a major fire incident that occurred on 14th April, 1944 at Victoria Harbour in Mumbai, in which 336 persons died and 1040 were injured. Out of 336 who died, 68 were Officers and Jawans of Mumbai Fire Brigade. To commemorate the act of bravery of the officers and men of Mumbai Fire Brigade who lost their lives during the fire fighting operation, April 14th is observed as Fire Service Day. The week long programme will start with a Commemoration Day Parade on 14/04/2023 at 0700 hours at Fire Service Headquarters, Port Blair. Two minute silence will be observed to pay homage to those Fire Service personnel who had laid their lives for ensuring fire safety of our countrymen all over the nation. Soon after the parade, Fleet March of Fire Vehicles shall be taken out in and around Port Blair town. The rationale behind the week long programme is to aware general public with respect to fire safety, educational campaign through banners, pamphlets, lectures and demonstrations at various institutions including village community premises, hospitals, schools, hotels & resorts. Similar programme will also be conducted in Fire Stations located at far flung islands.

In the year 2022, a total of 223 fire calls and 587 special service calls were attended by A & N Fire Service and property worth about Rs. 85.46 crores was saved.

The A & N Police Fire Service is committed to generate public awareness about Fire Prevention by conducting special campaign in densely populated areas, government buildings, industrial establishments, hospitals, hotels and resorts during the Fire Service Week.

Member of Parliament requests PM to declare Car Nicobar Airfield as an alternative airport to Port Blair Airport

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Prime Minister of India to declare the Car Nicobar Defence Airfield as an alternative airport to the Port Blair Airport. “Alternate Airports” are airports that are marked along an aircraft’s flight plan that can safely accommodate the landing of the aircraft should the aircraft experience an emergency or if the landing at the intended airport becomes inadvisable. In his letter he mentioned that this would greatly benefit the residents of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, as well as tourists visiting the region. According to the Member of Parliament, currently, the only alternative airport to Port Blair is located in foreign countries, which greatly increases the cost of airfare for those travelling to and from the Islands. This makes it difficult for many residents to afford to travel, and also makes the islands less accessible to tourists. He pointed out that the Car Nicobar Defence Airfield, however, is located much closer to the islands and has the necessary infrastructure to support commercial flights. By making this airfield an alternative airport, the cost of airfare would significantly decrease, making it more affordable for residents to travel and for tourists to visit the islands. He added that he strongly believes that this change would greatly benefit the people of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and would also make these Islands more accessible to Tourists, which will in-turn help Andaman’s Tourism Industry as well as local economy.

Member of Parliament demands to schedule a ship from Great Nicobar to Port Blair via all ports of Nicobar District and a ship from Hut Bay to Port Blair on 26th April 2023 evening

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Hon’ble Lt. Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to schedule a ship from Great Nicobar to Port Blair via all ports of Nicobar District on 26th April 2023 evening. In a letter addressed to the Hon’ble Lt. Governor, the Member of Parliament added that this will help people who wish to reach Port Blair for vacation and those who want to plan their trip to the mainland to plan

their journey well in advance. The Member of Parliament also demanded a similar sailing from Hut Bay on 26th April 2023 evening. In his letter he mentioned that Summer Vacation is the time when a large number of families plan to visit their native places in mainland India and also seek medical treatment in mainland hospitals. Additionally, parents often take their children to mainland India for coaching and admission in various institutes.

He pointed out that for people living in remote Islands, especially in Nicobar District, planning trips to mainland India is not easy. “They have to wait for a ship to sail to Port Blair first, and then they have to arrange tickets for the onward journey from Port Blair. This can be a daunting task for them, causing them considerable inconvenience,” he added. To minimize the troubles of people living in remote islands, especially in various islands of Nicobar District, the Member

of Parliament requested to schedule a ship from Great Nicobar to Port Blair via all ports of Nicobar District on 26th April 2023 evening. He also demanded a similar sailing from Hut Bay on 26th April 2023 evening. He mentioned that the Port Blair Airport will remain closed for four days for runway resurfacing works during the first week of May 2023. Hence, such sailing is badly required for Islanders living in Nicobar District.
