सूत्रों से मिली खबर के मुताबिक मायाबंदर पुलिस सभी हदों को पार करते हुए अब उन सभी महिलाओं की पहचान को भी उजागर कर रही है जिन्होंने पुलिस को बताया था की कौन कौन लोग और कहाँ कहाँ पर शराब का अवैध । काराकोबार चला रहे है ।

इस क्षेत्र में रहने वाले महिलाओं का कहना है की मायाबंदर पुलिस ने पहले यह कहा था की उनकी पहचान को पूरी तरह से गुप्त रखा जाएगा और अब उन सभी शराब के अवैध रूप से काराकोबार करने वालों को उनकी पहचान बता रहे है जिस वजह से उन्हें उनकी और उनके परिवारों की जान को खतरा हो गया है ।

इस क्षेत्र में रहने वाले बहुत सारे लोगो ने अपना नाम छुपाते हुए पीपुल्स व्यू के संवादाता को बताया की एक कुमार नामक व्यक्ति सुबह तीन बजे से अपनी दुकान में शराब का अवैध रूप से बिक्री शुरू कर देता है और देर रात तक यह सिलसिला जारी रहता है । इस क्षेत्र में रहने वाले बहुत सारे स्कूली बच्चों को शराब की बुरी लत लग गई है । इस क्षेत्र में रहने वाले लोगो ने हैरानी प्रकट करते हुए कहा की जिस कुमार की वजह से पूरा क्षेत्र दुषित हो रहा है मायाबंदर पुलिस उसे गिरफ्तार करने की बजाए उन्हें शराब का अवैध कारोबार करने की पूरी छूट दी हुई है ।

## Ayyappan Visits Composite Regional Centre Brookshabad

On getting complaints of shortage of Faculty and staff, Shri D. Ayyappan, Secretary, CPI (M) Andaman & Nicobar State Organising Committee visited the Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Brookshabad, Port Blair today (30.11.2022) and discussed the issue with the Resident Nodal Officer of the Centre. It was noticed that although 365 Children with Special Needs have registered with the Centre, only 40 - 45 are attending the Centre. It was found that the important posts of Speech Therapist, Clinical

Psychologist, Physiotherapist and Occupational Therapist are lying vacant. Faculty/Special Teachers are posted to the Centre from Chennai by the National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan) on contract basis. On completion of the contract period, the services of these Faculty/Special Teachers are not extended by the National Institute and such Faculty/Special Teachers are returned to mainland, thereby paralyzing the functioning of the Centre. A number of children who need the services of Speech Therapist are facing problems due to the reason that such Faculty/

Special Teachers are reportedly not available in these islands. It was learnt that out of the 14 sanctioned posts of Faculty and staff, only 6 persons are presently available in the Centre. Shri Ayyappan met some parents in the Centre and heard their grievances. He assured the parents and the officials in the Centre that the non-availability of sufficient Faculty/Special Teachers will be taken up with the above-mentioned National Institute and Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India.

## Composite Regional Centre implementing Assistance to Disabled Persons Scheme for purchase/fitting of aids/appliances Eligible and interested Divyangjan urged to contact the Centre

Port Blair, Nov. 27 : Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fitting of Aids/ Appliances (ADIP Scheme) is one of the major initiatives of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India to assist the needy Divyangjan in procuring durable and scientifically manufactured standard aids and appliances to promote their physical, social and psychological rehabilitation. Assistive devices are given to PwDs with the aim to improve their independent functioning, to arrest the extent of disability and occurrence of secondary disabilities.

A person with disabilities fulfilling the conditions mentioned would be eligible for assistance

under ADIP Scheme viz. an Indian citizen of any age, holds a 40% Disability Certificate, his monthly income from all sources is up to Rs. 22,500/- per month, he or she shall be eligible for getting an assistance the full cost of the Aids and Appliances under ADIP Scheme. And if the total income is between Rs. 22,501/- to Rs. 30,000/- per month, he or she shall be eligible for getting 50% subsidy of the cost of Aids/ Appliances under ADIP Scheme.

Income certificate from Revenue Agencies / BPL Card / MGNREGA Card / Disability Pension Card / Certificate by M.P./MLA/Councilor/Gram Pradhan failing which Notarized Affidavit C/o Implementing Agencies may be accepted for

providing aids/ appliances to PwDs. Income certificate of beneficiaries staying in orphanages and half-way homes etc. may be accepted on certification of District Collector or Head of the organization concerned.

The documents required for availing the benefits under ADIP Scheme are recent colour passport size photograph (2 Nos), Disability Certificate (photo copy) and original for verification and entry purpose, Ration Card/ Voter ID/Driving License (any one photo copy)- (of Parents/ beneficiaries), Aadhaar Card (photo copy) for (beneficiaries/ parents), valid mobile number (for beneficiaries/parents) and

## Member of Parliament demands to resolve the power crisis issue of Shaheed Dweep

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the intervention of the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration in the severe power crisis issue of Shaheed Dweep and demanded to resolve the issue immediately. In a letter addressed to the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration, the Member of Parliament mentioned that the Shaheed Dweep is facing a severe power crisis for the last nearly four weeks.

He pointed out that a DG of a private power producer set was sent to Shaheed Dweep to supply power in Island but now the said DG set has developed some technical problems because of which the power situation has worsened in the Island.

He added that presently residents of Shaheed Dweep are witnessing multiple load sheddings in the Island and power is reportedly being supplied to different parts of Shaheed Dweep on rotational basis for only two hours. The General Public are witnessing power cuts for nearly 10 to 12 hours a day, which is making their life difficult.

The Member of Parliament mentioned that many students of Shaheed Dweep are preparing for their exams and due to such indiscriminate power cuts, it has become impossible for students to focus on studies moreover as Kerosene has been banned in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the students are unable to use lantern or any other lamps.

He added that Shaheed Dweep is also known as the vegetable

bowl of South Andaman region but due to power cuts farmers are unable to use motors for irrigation and are suffering losses. Unemployed youths who are now dependent of Tourism are also unable to operate their business because of lack of power as they are unable to operate computers to mail customers and complete other online formalities.

He further added that small hotel/ Bed and Breakfast owners are also witnessing huge losses as their guests are leaving their rooms due to power cuts and shifting to bigger hotels, who have their own power backup system. The Member of Parliament noted that due to such power cuts visiting tourists are also going back with a bitter memory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The registered beneficiaries are entitled for a cashless treatment worth 5 lakh per family per year against secondary and tertiary hospitalization care at 28,000 empanelled public and private hospitals across the country.
