Hon'ble Lt Governor leads from the front a huge participation in Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Open Sea Swimming Competition

Hon'ble Lt Governor inspired and motivated the participants by flagging off and himself participating in the event

A spectacular display of grit, determination & passion - swimmers from 12 to 70 plus years swam their way to glory covering 1.6 km from NSCB to RGWSC



Port Blair, March 18

Enthusiastic spectators both young and old, lined up the Marina Park stretch and RGWSC early morning to witness the Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Open Sea Swimming Competition here today. The mega event organized as part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' by the Directorate of Sports & Youth Affairs, A&N Administration, saw large turnout of swimmers from different age groups. As scheduled, at the dawn of day, 191 participants enthusiastically assembled and participated.

Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt Governor and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency as chief guest, flagged off the first event Men's Open (18 yrs to 50 yrs) from Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island in which 138 participants took part. The remaining events of the competition were flagged off by Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, Chief Secretary, Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

It is worth mentioning that for the first time in history of these Islands, Hon'ble Lt. Governor has himself participated in the open sea swimming competition and completed the race upto the finishing point at Rajiv Gandhi Water Sports Complex under the Senior Citizen category (60 to 70 yrs) which greatly boosted the morale of the participants and generated great enthusiasm for the Islanders. The event was held after a gap of over five years.

Covering a distance of 1.6 km from NSCB Island to RGWSC, Aberdeen Jetty, swimmers received thunderous applause and cheers from the onlookers as they approached the finishing line. Exhausted



but not defeated, every participant completed the event, passing through the finishing point, a deserving salute to their sportsmanship spirit. For some, it was a moment to remember and for many it's the zeal and spirit of sportsmanship that drove them to the finishing point, proving that participation and completion of the event is equally important.

Elaborate route arrangement was made with the help of dinghies with a width of 40 mtrs. As safety measures, rescue boats alongwith divers and lifeguards with sufficient safety equipments were placed at adequate distance.

Later, the prize distribution ceremony was held in the premises of Rajiv Gandhi Water Sports Complex in which, the Chief Secretary, Andaman and Nicobar Administration as chief guest gave away the cash awards (@ Rs.50000 for first prize, @ Rs.30000 for second prize @ Rs.20000 for third prize and @ Rs.1000 as consolation prize (for all those participants

who have completed the race) prize, trophies, medals and certificates to the winners.

Addressing the prize distribution ceremony, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra congratulated all the participants for the successful completion of the event. He also made a special mention of senior most participants, whose participation is nothing short of an exemplary performance for the youngsters that age is just a number, it's the zeal and enthusiasm that matter. Chief Secretary also congratulated the Department of Sports & Youth Affairs headed by Commissioner -cum- Secretary (Sports), Secretary (Sports) and all other line Departments for the successful conduct of the event.

The Chief Secretary stated that Hon'ble Lt Governor's participation in the event was a morale boosting for all participants, exhibiting how to accept challenge and complete the event. He thanked

Hon'ble Lt. Governor for his support and inspiration for successful completion of the event. The Chief Secretary said, participants from all age categories displayed a spectacular performance, proving their sportsmanship. He remarked that NSCB open sea swimming event will be an even bigger event in future and with the same spirit of enthusiasm, it shall be conducted. He lauded the performance of all the participants for making this event a grand success.

Earlier, in his welcome address, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Sports), Shri Nikhil Kumar said, this mega event was organized as part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' and is all the more important as India has assumed the Presidency of G20 this year. He mentioned that Open Sea Swimming Competition is an annual feature of the Sports Department. The last event was held in 2017 and due to COVID, it was stalled. He made a special mention of Hon'ble Lt Governor's guidance under which this event has been successfully conducted. He said, Hon'ble Lt Governor's participation was a motivating factor for all participants and the completion of the event is a big testament to his fitness, endurance and will power. The Commissioner also threw light on the benefits of swimming which helps the body in many ways, apart from being an activity of pleasure. No. 2-14/2014-OL. – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi Notification No. 14/3/60-ANL dated 11th April, 1960 and insupercession of Andaman and Nicobar Administration Notification No.33/2010/F.No.2-14/2004-OL dated 18-02-2010, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following amendment to the Recruitment Rules of GROUP 'C' post of "Instructor (Hindi Typing)", borne in the establishment of Official Language Department of Andaman and Nicobar Administration published in Andaman and Nicobar Extraordinary Gazette Notification No. 37 dated 18.02.2010: -

1. Short title and commencement:

i. These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Group 'C' Non-Gazetted and non-ministerial Post of Instructor (Hindi Typing) in the Official Language Department) Recruitment Rules, 2022.

ii. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc:

4. Disqualifications:

- No person-
- who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living, or
 - who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person; shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
- Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administration), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under any personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to Relax:

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving:

Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

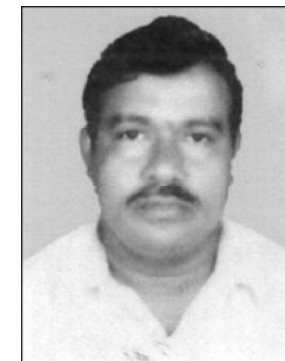
