Chief Secretary on three-day visit to Little Andaman Interacts with Nicobarese Community at Harminder Bay and assures redressal of grievances highlighted Inspects Electricity Sub-Station; visits White Surf Waterfall and eco-tourism site at Kalapathar beach

Hutbay, March 19

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS arrived on a three days visit to Little Andaman today. On arrival at Hutbay Helipad, the Chief Secretary was received by Tehsildar Hutbay, Shri Gopal Chandra Mosid, ZP Member, Shri Vasudevan Nair, Pradhans of Little Andaman, PRI Members and officials of different Departments. Soon after arrival, the Chief Secretary visited Light House at Harminder Bay being maintained by Department of Light House & Light Ships. This Light House which is 45 metres in height, has a width of 20 diameter and is one of the highest Light Houses in India. Shri Pabitra Kr. Halder, Navigational Assistant of the Department informed the Chief Secretary that the



Light House is fully operated through solar energy which covers 22 nautical miles and helps in navigation of vessels crossing Little Andaman. The Chief Secretary also inspected the road from Hutbay Jetty to Harminder Bay and directed APWD to complete construction of the road work before the onset of monsoon.

At Community Hall, Harminder Bay, the Chief Secretary was received by the First Headman, Village Tribal Council, Harminder Bay, Shri Andrew Moses. During the interaction with the Nicobarese Community, the Chief Secretary was informed that the Nicobarese were settled in Harminder Bay in the year 1973.

In his welcome address, the First Headman expressed his deep gratitude to the Chief Secretary



for visiting Harminder Bay, an abode of the Nicobarese. He requested for construction of a Tribal Council Office in the village, construction of Mortuary Home/death house in graveyard area, maintenance of septic tank of permanent shelter in the village among others.

Addressing the Nicobarese Community, the Chief Secretary congratulated the children for according him a warm welcome with their traditional Nicobari dance and melodious welcome song. Responding to their demands, the Chief Secretary stated that he has already took stock of the issues in Harminder Bay and informed them that the Administration is committed to liquidate all genuine demands of the Tribal Council. He further advised the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman



to have a detailed assessment of demands projected by Tribal leaders and work out action plans to fulfill their demands. The Chief Secretary praised the Nicobarese community for keeping their culture and lifestyle intact.

Thereafter, the Chief Secretary visited Electricity Sub-Station at Netaji Nagar which has an installed power generating capacity of 3 MW. He interacted with the Officials and Staff manning the Sub-Station. The Assistant Engineer, Electricity Department, Shri R.N Roy informed that the installed capacity is capable to meet the peak demand of power. The Chief Secretary appreciated the effort of the officials and staff of the Sub-Station for providing 24x7 power supply.

19 year old female patient with vague abdominal pain diagnosed as cancer successfully operated at G.B Pant Hospital/ ANIIMS Patient is on adjuvant chemotherapy and is doing well

Port Blair, March 19

The incidence of cancer is rising globally and the same is true as far as our Andaman & Nicobar Islands too. The incidence is not only rising but the age group affected by cancer disease is decreasing. A 19 year old young lady who was referred from Rangat CHC with acute onset of pain in abdomen was admitted in the Surgery Department of G.B Pant Hospital/ ANIIMS. She was further investigated with blood and ultrasound in abdomen which revealed she had



gallstone. The patient was found that there was worked up and was a hard growth in was posted for the proximal surgery. She transverse colon with underw enlarged loco-laparoscopy and regional lymphnodes found to have dilated which was clinically small bowel and suggestive of dilated right half of cancerous growth. the large bowel and Hence, the decision there was abrupt was taken and the narrowing of the patient underwent transverse colon. On right extended table decision was hemicolectomy with taken to convert into ileo-transverse open surgery and it anastomosis which



lasted for 4 hrs and the patient was shifted to Surgical ICU for recovery and the patient has recovered well and has been discharged. After two weeks, the biopsy report came as malignant adenocarcinoma colon. Now, the patient is on adjuvant chemotherapy and is doing well. As the patient was

very young, the diagnosis of malignancy was not considered in the initial work up because colon cancer usually effect people above 50 years of age and they have symptoms of bleeding per-rectum and recurrent pain abdomen and anemia which were not seen in this particular case.

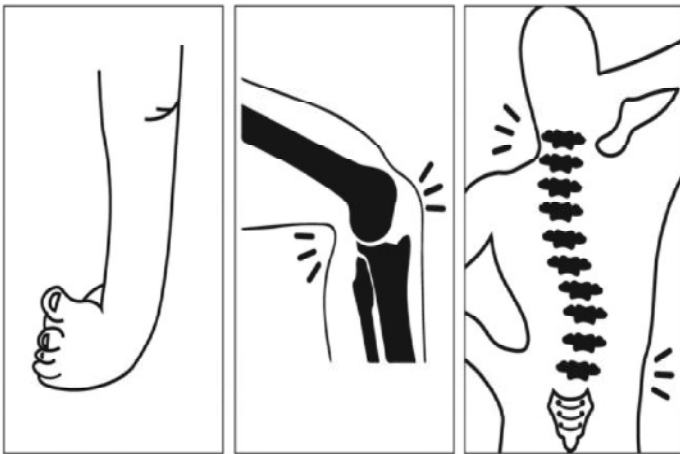

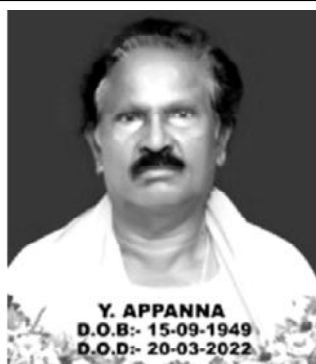
