14 Guidelines for Human-Wildlife Conflict Mitigation promoting harmonious coexistence between humans and wildlife released

Guidelines issued include 10 species-specific and 4 on cross-cutting issues

New Delhi, March 21 (PIB)

Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Bhopendra Yadav today released 14 Guidelines to address Human-Wildlife Conflict (HWC), which aim to facilitate a common understanding among key stakeholders, on what constitutes effective and efficient mitigation of HWC in India. The Guidelines are advisory in nature, and will facilitate in further development of site-specific HWC mitigation measures. These Guidelines are developed under the Indo-German cooperation project on HWC Mitigation, which is being implemented by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) together with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH and State Forest Departments of Karnataka, Uttarakhand and West Bengal.

The 14 Guidelines released include:

- 10 species-specific Guidelines- Guidelines for Mitigating Human - Elephant, -Gaur, - Leopard, -Snake, - Crocodile, -Rhesus Macaque, -Wild Pig, - Bear, -Blue Bull and -Blackbuck Conflict;
- 4 Guidelines on cross-cutting issues-
- Guidelines for Cooperation between the Forest and Media sector in India: Towards effective communication on Human-Wildlife Conflict Mitigation.
- Occupational Health and Safety in the Context of Human-Wildlife Conflict Mitigation.
- Crowd Management in Human-Wildlife Conflict Related Situations.
- Addressing Health Emergencies and Potential Health Risks Arising Out of Human-Wildlife Conflict Situations:

Taking a One Health Approach.

The development and intended implementation of these Guidelines is driven by a harmonious coexistence approach to ensure that both humans and wild animals are protected from the negative impacts of HWC. These Guidelines are strongly driven by field experiences, and take into consideration the

Chief Secretary visits Little Andaman Holds meeting with Public Representatives and Heads of Office

Gave patient hearing to grievances put forth by PRIs & emphasizes on the need for participatory management

Visits Dugong Creek & interacts with Onge PVTGs

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS on the last day of his visit to Little Andaman, held meeting with the P u b l i c Representatives and Heads of Office at APWD Guest House, Hutbay today. During the meeting, the P u b l i c Representatives highlighted their grievances pertaining to Health, Education, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Revenue, Civil Aviation, Electricity, Shipping, Road, Water, Rural Development etc. The Chief Secretary gave a patient hearing to the grievances and allowed all the PRI members present in the hall to put forth their grievances one by one.

Discussing on the Education Sector, the Chief Secretary emphasized that 100% result or better infrastructure does not make much difference in building career of the students. While appreciating the teachers for their efforts in achieving 100% results in such difficult areas, the Chief Secretary requested the teacher to go a step further in building career of the students. He said, the end result is much more important. He urged the parents and representatives to concentrate more on providing quality education and preparing students for competitive exams and better placement.

Deliberating on sectors like Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Industries, etc, the Chief Secretary emphasized the need for participatory management of people, elected representatives and Govt. functionaries. Govt. functionaries were advised to reach out to farmers in villages/farms and provide extension services like training, capacity building, technology transfer, supply of inputs, motivation, IEC activity, etc to make them self reliant. The PRIs were advised to motivate unemployed youth, Cooperative Societies, SHGs to take benefit of various Govt. Schemes and set up MSMEs in the available Industrial plots to make themselves employed rather than running after Govt. jobs which are limited.

He also urged the PRIs to shoulder the responsibility in the developmental process in the larger interest of the Islanders. He further stated that there are many issues which can be sorted out at the PRI level itself without depending much on the Administration for its redressal. This, he said, will enable general public in getting their issues resolved at the earliest.

The Chief Secretary assured the PRIs that the A&N Administration will go an extra mile to redress their genuine demands/issues.

The Chief Secretary further remarked that real development can be achieved only when every Department works in tandem. He urged the farmers to adopt new technologies in the sectors viz. Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, Agriculture and Horticulture and

Industries which will not only enable them to double their income, but also help in attaining self-sufficiency.

existing guidelines and advisories issued by various agencies and State Forest Departments, as well as their good practices, and build on them.

The Guidelines provide a framework to take a holistic approach, viz., not only addressing the emergency situations arising due to immediate HWC situations but also addressing the drivers and pressures that lead to HWC, guidance on establishing and managing prevention methods, and reducing the impact of conflict both on humans and wild animals.

The preparation of the Guidelines followed a participatory, inclusive, and integrated approach involving key relevant stakeholders and sectors including Agriculture, Veterinary, Disaster Management, District Administration,Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Institutions, NGOs, and Media. A total of 105 events-workshops, regional and national consultations, meetings, and field missions were organized, under the Indo-German Project on HWC Mitigation, during August 2018 to February 2022, with more than 1600 participants. An intensive and systematic process of pilot testing of the Guidelines was facilitated for the States to test and report on the feasibility and acceptability of their recommendations expressed in the draft Guidelines.

This set of Guidelines is not a static document; rather, it is a living document, where feedback from field practitioners and other wildlife experts is planned to be analysed to assess the specific elements and sections that need to undergo changes. A review of these Guidelines is planned to take place every five years from 2023 onwards.

Over Rs 2 lakh 41 thousand crore disbursed to over 11 crore farmers in country under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi scheme

New Delhi, March 21

The Government has so far disbursed over two lakh 41 thousand crore rupees to over 11 crore farmers in the country under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, PM-KISAN.

In a written reply in the Lok Sabha, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Minister, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar said under the scheme an amount of six thousand rupees per year is transferred in

three 4-month installments of two thousand rupees directly into the bank accounts of the farmers.

The Minister said PM-KISAN is a flagship scheme of the Centre and one of the world's largest Direct Benefit Transfer Schemes. He said, according to a study, the funds received by recipients under PM-KISAN are not only helping them with agricultural needs, but

it is also catering to their other expenses such as education, medical and marriage.

He said, the scheme aims at providing financial assistance to cultivable landholding farmers across the country to enable them to take care of expenses related to agriculture and allied activities as well as other incidental expenses. 
