PM inaugurates Sri Madhusudan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research in Karnataka

India to become a developed country by 2047 with joint efforts of people: PM

New Delhi, March 25 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated Sri Madhusudan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research at Chikballapur today. SMSIMSR will provide medical education and quality medical care - completely free of cost - to all. The institute will start functioning in the academic year 2023. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister noted that Chikballapur is the birthplace of one of the architects of modern India, Sir M M Visvesvaraya and expressed gratitude for getting the opportunity to pay tribute to his samadhi and visit his museum. "I bow my head before this virtuous land", the Prime Minister remarked. The Prime Minister called Satya Sai Gram a wonderful model of service. He lauded the mission being undertaken by the institution through education and health initiatives. He said that today's inauguration of the medical college has further strengthened



this mission.

The Prime Minister referred to the nation's resolution to be a developed nation during the Amrit Kaal and people's curiosity about accomplishing such a mammoth resolution in such a short time. "There is just one answer, a strong, resolute and resourceful answer i.e Sabka Prayas. This is going to be surely realized by the effort of every countrymen", the Prime Minister said. The Prime Minister pointed out that

there were less than 380 medical colleges in the country before 2014 but the numbers have gone up to more than 650 today. He also underlined that 40 medical colleges have been developed in aspirational districts of the country that were once lagging behind in terms of development.

In the last 9 years, the Prime Minister mentioned that the number of medical seats in the country has doubled. He noted that the number of doctors produced by the country in the next 10 years will be the same as the number of doctors produced in India since the time of independence. Underlining that Karnataka is also reaping the benefits of the development carried out in the country, the Prime Minister informed that the State is home to roughly 70 medical colleges in the country. Cabinet approves 4 % hike in Dearness Allowance to Central Govt. employees

New Delhi, March 25

Central Government has increased the Dearness Allowance by four per cent, taking the total to 42 per cent of the Basic Pay for Central Government employees and pensioners. Briefing media in New Delhi yesterday after the Cabinet meeting, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Anurag Singh Thakur said, this will benefit over

47 lakh Central Government employees and more than 69 lakh pensioners.

He said, Union Cabinet has given its approval to release an additional installment of Dearness Allowance to Central Government employees and Dearness Relief to Pensioners with effect from 1st January this year. Shri Thakur said, the combine

impact on the exchequer on account of both Dearness Allowance and Dearness Relief will be over 12 thousand 815 crore rupees per annum. The Minister said, this increase in the Dearness Allowance is in accordance with the accepted formula which is based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission. (Source: india.gov.in)

Union Cabinet extends subsidy of Rs. 200 per cylinder for 12 refills annually for Ujjwala Yojana beneficiaries for one year

New Delhi, March 25

In a major relief to Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana beneficiaries, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has extended the subsidy of two hundred rupees per LPG cylinder for a period of one year. As on 1st March this year, there are nine crore 59 lakh Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana beneficiaries. Briefing

media in New Delhi yesterday after the Cabinet meeting, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Anurag Singh Thakur said, that the subsidy of two hundred rupees per LPG cylinder will be provided to the beneficiaries for up to 12 refills per year. He said, there has been a sharp increase in international prices of LPG due to various

geopolitical reasons and it is important to shield Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana beneficiaries from high LPG prices. Shri Thakur said, the total expenditure on it in 2022-23 will be six thousand 100 crore rupees and in 2023-24 will be seven thousand 680 crore rupees.

develop more than 150 nursing institutions in the country as part of this year's Budget and said that it will create new opportunities for the youth in the nursing sector.

"Our Government works for the welfare of the poor. It has given an option of medical education in all Indian languages including Kannada", the Prime Minister said.

"Our Government has considered serving the poor as its highest duty. We have given priority to the health of the poor and middle class", Shri Modi said. He gave the example of Jan Aushadhi Kendras or low-price medicine and informed that there are about 10,000 Jan Aushadhi Kendras across the country today, out of which more than 1000 are located in Karnataka. He added that such an initiative has allowed the poor to save thousands of crores of rupees on medicines.

"We are giving top priority to mothers and sisters in health-related policies", the Prime Minister remarked. Underlining that the health of the whole generation improves when the health and nutrition of our mothers improve, the Prime Minister said that the Government is giving special emphasis towards this and gave the example of schemes to build toilets, provide free gas connections, provide tap water to every household, provide free sanitary pads and send money directly to the bank for nutritious food. He underlined the special attention given by the Government towards breast cancer and informed that health and wellness centers are being opened in the villages and efforts are being made to screen such diseases in the early stages itself. "When the country is healthy and 'Sabka Prayas' is devoted to development, then we will achieve the goal of a developed India faster", he said.

Companies namely Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited have already been providing this subsidy since the 22nd of May last year. The subsidy is credited directly to the bank accounts of the eligible beneficiaries. The average LPG consumption of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana consumers has increased by 20 percent from 3.01 refills in 2019-20 to 3.68 in 2021-22. To make Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) available to rural and deprived poor households, Government had launched Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana in May 2016, to provide deposit-free LPG connections to adult women of poor households. Pest survey conducted by CIPMC at Nimbutala

Port Blair, March 25

Pest monitoring and surveillance with emphasis to forewarn the farmers on the potential epidemics of pest is a significant activity of Directorate of Plant Protection, Quarantine & Storage (DPPQS), Faridabad, Minister of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare. As part of this, a pest survey was conducted by Central Integrated Pest Management Centre (CIPMC), Port Blair to assess the damage and spread of coconut slug caterpillar in Nimbutala area in collaboration with Zonal Agriculture Office, Rangat.

A team comprising of Dr. Shiva Kumar H.D., Assistant Plant Protection Officer of CIPMC along with Smt. S.C. Rekha, Asst. Director (Agri.), Shri Santhosh Kumar, AFA, Shri Azmat Qadir, SCFA visited the farmers' fields at Nimbutala, Amkunj and surrounding area. The team observed that the coconut orchards were infested with slug caterpillar and now it is spreading to adjoining arecanut



palms and other forest trees. The experts advocated Integrated Pest Management (IPM) through balanced nutrition along with MOP and application of Neem Cake. They also suggested to spray Neem Seed Kernel Extract (NSKE) 5%, Neem Oil 3 %, use of Light traps and Petromax light from 7 pm to 3 am. Installation of lights traps is highly profitable as it is difficult to adopt chemical control measures for the management of this pest due to the residual toxicity and limitations of large scale adoption of pesticidal recommendations and more number of female moths were attracted to the light traps.

They stressed on the need to provide supplemental irrigation in the absence of rain, a press release received from Plant Protection Officer (E) said.
