## Mann Ki Baat: PM urges people to come forward for organ donation; says Govt. working on uniform policy for organ donation in the country

### Organ donation in the country has increased

New Delhi, March 26


Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today urged people to come forward for organ donation. Addressing the nation in the 99<sup>th</sup> episode of his Mann Ki Baat programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi said there are a large number of needy people who are waiting for organ donors. He noted that in India, selfless charity, also known as Parmarth, has been placed so high that people do not hesitate to donate their all for the happiness of others. He expressed satisfaction that his Government is working on a uniform policy in the country for organ donation. He further stated that it has been decided to remove the condition of domicile of the States.

It will enable patients to go to any State and register for receiving organs. The Government has also decided to abolish the age limit of

below 65 years for organ donation. Shri Modi highlighted that awareness about organ donation is also rising in the country. In 2013, there were less than five thousand cases of organ donation in the country. This number increased to more than fifteen thousand in 2022.

Prime Minister spoke of his long-standing desire to know the Mann Ki Baat of people who do such noble deeds. In today's Mann Ki Baat, he spoke to the parents who donated the organs of their 39 day old baby girl after she passed away. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu and his wife Supreet Kaur are residents of Amritsar in Punjab.

They were blessed with a beautiful girl child who they named Ababat Kaur. Sukhbir ji told Prime Minister that the baby had a bunch of nerves in her brain due to which the size of her heart got bigger. When



she was only 39 days old, she suffered a heart attack. Sukhbir ji told Shri Modi that they felt that the child had some purpose in being born and decided to donate her organs. The Prime Minister praised them for their good deeds saying many people will come forward to save someone's life after hearing their story. Sukhbir ji said that they held their heads high with pride when the doctors told them that their daughter had become the youngest donor in India whose organs had been successfully transplanted.

Prime Minister also had a conversation with Abhijit Chaudhary, son of Snehlata Chaudhary of Jharkhand, who donated her heart, kidney and liver

at 63 years of age. Abhijeet ji told the Prime Minister that four people got their lives back due to the organ donation and two people got back their eyesight. Shri Modi saluted them for their service to the society.

Touching upon the subject of renewable energy, Shri Modi said that the speed with which India is moving forward in the field of solar energy is a big achievement. He said that there is a lot of talk about clean energy and renewable energy all over the world these days. He added that people across the world are talking about India's phenomenal success in this field.

Shri Modi said the people of India have had a special relationship with the Sun for centuries. He pointed out that the scientific understanding Indians have about the power of the Sun, and the traditions of worshipping the Sun, are

rarely seen at other places. He expressed happiness that every person understands the importance of solar energy today and wants to contribute towards clean energy. He emphasized that this spirit of 'Sabka Prayas' is taking India's Solar Mission forward.

He added that in the month of April, birth anniversaries of two great personalities of India are celebrated - Mahatma Jyotiba Phule, and Babasaheb Ambedkar. Prime Minister said that both these great men made immense contributions to eradicate discrimination from society. He said that in 'Azadi Ka Amrit Kaal', there is a need to learn from such great personalities and take constant inspiration from them. He stressed that people must keep their duties at the forefront.

## Directorate of Disaster Management implementing Up-scaling Aapda Mitra Scheme in A&N Islands

Port Blair, March 26 'Up-scaling Aapda Mitra Scheme' is an approved scheme of Government of India which is being implemented by National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) in partnership with State / UT Governments and State Disaster Authorities. The scheme aims to provide community volunteers with the

basic skills they will require for responding to their community's immediate needs during and in the aftermath of a disaster. These trained volunteers can assist in saving lives using the basic techniques of disaster response, coordination and management.

The A&N Administration is implementing the Scheme in all three

Districts of A&N Islands targeting to train 300 community volunteers under the scheme, out of which, 191 Aapda Mitra Volunteers of South Andaman and N&M Andaman were trained by organizing 12 days trainings at Port Blair, Rangat and Mayabunder. ## UIDAI makes online document update in Aadhaar free of cost under Digital India Initiative

### Free service will be available till June 14

Port Blair, March 26

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has decided to allow residents to update documents in their Aadhaar online free of cost, a people-centric move that will benefit millions of residents. As part of Digital India Initiative, the UIDAI took the decision and is urging residents to get benefit of free document update facility on myAadhaar

portal. The free service is available for the next three months i.e. 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 to 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2023.

The UIDAI has been encouraging residents to upload Proof of Identity (PoI) and Proof of Address (PoA) documents to revalidate their demographic details, especially if Aadhaar was issued 10 years back and never got updated. This will help in improved ease of living, better

service delivery and enhance authentication success rate.

Residents of Andaman & Nicobar Islands may login to <https://myaadhaar.uidai.gov.in/> using their Aadhaar Number and update their Aadhaar Card free of cost. If not possible, they may visit the nearest Aadhaar Centre for Document update by paying a fee of Rs. 50/-, a press release from CS&CA said.

**ISRO successfully launches LVM 3 -M3 rocket with 36 satellites from Sriharikota**

Sriharikota, March 26

India's LVM 3 -M3 satellite with 36 satellites of the One Web India - 2 mission took off from the second launch pad of the Sathish Dhawan Space Centre Sriharikota successfully at 9 this morning. The 43-metre-tall launch vehicle successfully completed the three stages in the prescribed time limit including the involvement of the ignition of the cryogenic engine.

The datas are being tracked by the ground stations at Thiruvananthapuram, Lucknow and Bangalore stations



and also at the ship station at Antarctica. Speaking after the launch, the Chairman of ISRO, Shri Somnath said that the first 16 satellites of the one web India - 2 series were placed at the right orbit as planned, the remaining 20 satellites will also be positioned soon. Asserting that it was a successful mission with no glitches, he looked forward to more such missions in future, he told that cryogenic engines which were used in these missions will be used in the Gaganyaan mission also. He said that ISRO will be having another commercial launch in April. (Source: india.gov.in)


