## Big boost to rural employment as more than 31,000 jobs on the way under DDU-GKY

**Rural Development Ministry to sign MoU with 19 Captive Employers under RTD (Recruit, Train & Deploy) model**

New Delhi, March 27 (PIB)

In a big boost to rural employment, the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) is signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with 19 Captive Employers and provide them the target to train and provide gainful employment to 31,067 rural poor youth under the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) with minimum salary of 10000/per month for the minimum period of 6 months.

Union Minister of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj,

Shri Giriraj Singh will be the chief guest at the MoU signing ceremony in New Delhi tomorrow. On the occasion, he will also distribute appointment letters to few candidates who had got similar training under the DDU-GKY and placed with captive employers.

Based on the direction of Shri Giriraj Singh, MoRD launched the Captive Employment Guidelines under DDUGKY to ensure that the candidates are trained as per the industry requirement and employed. The Captive Employment model allows the

employer to select the rural youth, skill & deploy them in one of its own establishment/sister-concern/subsidiaries.

The RTD (Recruit, Train & Deploy) model has been developed to address the needs of the Industry on one hand and ensuring sustainable placement for rural youth on the another hand. The model will be a win-win situation for Employment Industry, Government & Rural Poor Youth. Industry will be able to provide more hands-on training at the job site itself as per its requirement while Government will

ensure longer placements (Minimum six months) for rural poor youth candidates.

The Captive Employment Guidelines will increase the direct involvement of the industry due to the benefits provided to the industries for encouraging them to participate in the DDU-GKY program thereby ensuring the

The A&N Administration is scheduled to conduct Tier-II (Typing speed test) & Tier-III (Shorthand test) to fill up the vacancies of LGC & Stenographer (OG) during the 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> week of April, 2023 at the designated centres at Port Blair based on the scores of Common Recruitment Examination held on 20.11.2022.

The A&N Administration will display/upload the list of candidates who are eligible for appearing in the aforesaid skill tests. The list of eligible candidates for Tier-II & III Test (Skill Test) will be uploaded in the Administration's portal i.e. <https://karmic.andaman.gov.in> and [www.and.nic.in](http://www.and.nic.in) on or after 1<sup>st</sup> week of April, 2023. All aspirants/candidates have been advised to verify/confirm their candidature from the portal, a press release from Deputy Secretary (R&E) said.

## Atal Pension Yojana: a boon for unorganized sector

## 17,327 persons enrolled under the pension scheme in A&N Islands so far

Port Blair, March 27

The Atal Pension Yojana (APY) is a pension scheme for the workers in the unorganized sector. As per the scheme, people can make contributions in their Atal Pension Yojana account till the age of 60 years and get a monthly pension. The APY focuses on all citizens in the unorganized sector, who join the National Pension System (NPS) administered by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development

Authority (PFRDA). As per the data provided by Lead Bank, Port Blair, altogether, 17327 persons have been enrolled under the universal social security scheme 'Atal Pension Yojana' in A&N Islands as on March 15, 2023.

Under APY, the subscribers would receive fixed minimum pension of Rs. 1000 per month, Rs. 2000 per month, Rs. 3000 per month, Rs. 4000 per month, Rs. 5000 per month, at the age of 60 years, depending on their

contributions, which itself would be based on the age of joining the APY. The minimum age of joining APY is 18 years and maximum age is 40 years. The age of exit and start of pension would be 60 years. Therefore, minimum period of contribution by any subscriber under APY would be 20 years or more. The benefit of fixed minimum pension would be guaranteed by the Government.

APY is open to all bank account holders with auto debit

facility to accounts, leading to reduction in contribution collection charges. The subscribers should keep the required balance in their savings bank accounts on the stipulated due dates to avoid any late payment penalty. Due dates for monthly contribution payment is arrived based on the deposit of first contribution amount. In case of repeated defaults for specified period, the account is liable for the foreclosure and the

GoI co-contributions, if any shall be forfeited. Also any false declaration about his/her eligibility for benefits under this scheme for whatsoever reason, the entire Govt. contribution shall be forfeited along with the penal interest. For enrolment, Aadhaar would be the primary KYC document for identification of beneficiaries, spouse and nominees to avoid pension rights and entitlement related disputes in the long-term.

large quantity employment for rural youth. Few of the benefits provided to the Captive Employers are: Top Most Priority in target allocation, Waiver of Performance Bank Guarantee, Waiver of Quality Appraisal Process and Fees, Due Diligence of Training Centre and few other mandates of DDU-GKY to ease the operations for industries, MoU with MoRD for the period of 3 Years, Industry to also get Trained Manpower on Work which may reduce wear and tear, better performance, training cost from Govt.

However, in turn Captive Employers are required to offer Captive (In-house) placement to all the trained candidates and provide captive employment to minimum 70% of trained candidates for the period of 6 months with Minimum Salary of Rs. 10,000 for training courses less than 6 months & Rs. 12,000 for training courses more than 6 months.

The basic objective of DDU-GKY is to provide gainful placement in sustainable manner to rural youth after skilling hence the concept of captive employment was envisaged and launched on the occasion of Antyodaya Divas in the year 2020.

**Department of Biotechnology is going to play an important part in integrated holistic healthcare approach against elimination of Tuberculosis: Minister**

New Delhi, March 27 (PIB)

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh today announced integrated strategy to achieve 'TB Mukht Bharat' and said, the Department of Biotechnology, which gave the world first DNA vaccine against COVID, is going to play an important part in this integrated holistic healthcare approach against elimination of Tuberculosis, in keeping with Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's commitment of 'TB Mukht Bharat' by 2025.

Inspired by Prime Minister, Shri

Narendra Modi's clarion call at the One World TB summit at Varanasi on 24<sup>th</sup> March, the Minister declared commencement of the pilot phase of Indian Tuberculosis Genomic Surveillance Consortium (InTGS) with successful completion of WGS of 182 strains of Mtb isolated from TB patients and development of a novel blood bag technology at DBT-InStem, Bengaluru.

Dr. Jitendra Singh said that considering the deep societal and economic impact caused by Tuberculosis, the Govt. of India has placed a high priority for 'TB Mukht Bharat' by 2025. Biotechnology is going to play a huge part in the integrated holistic healthcare approach against elimination of Tuberculosis.

Dr. Jitendra Singh said, this will be the first pan-India initiative at such scale to fully understand the biological characteristics of Mycobacterium tuberculosis (Mtb) and the effect of the mutations on transmission, treatment, and disease severity.

Presentations on new initiatives on improving Tuberculosis outcomes - a) AYUSH interventions to improve TB patient quality-of-life (QOL) b) Mapping drug resistance through genomics & Artificial
