Chandrayaan III spacecraft integrated with GSLV Mark III launch vehicle at Satish Dhawan Space Centre

Launch planned between 12th & 19th of this month

New Delhi, July 5

Chandrayaan III spacecraft has been integrated with GSLV Mark III launch vehicle at Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota spaceport today. The Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO informed this in a tweet. The launch is planned between 12th and 19th of this month. The Propulsion module will carry the lander and rover configuration till 100 kms lunar orbit. The Propulsion module will



orbit the Moon as was done in Chandrayaan I and II. ISRO is making a second attempt to gently drop the lander

on the surface of the Moon and the rover to move around the lunar surface. The Indian Space

Agency has made improvements in the lander after learning from Chandrayaan 2 mission of 2019 when

the lander crash-landed on the Moon's surface due to a software glitch. The payloads on the Lander of Chandrayaan 3 will soft land on Moon and measure the thermal conductivity and temperature, seismicity around the landing site and estimate the plasma density. The Rover payload will derive the elemental composition in the vicinity of the landing site. (Source: india.gov.in)

UGC makes PhD optional for recruitment to post of Assistant Prof. in institutions of higher education; NET, SET or SLET made minimum criteria

New Delhi, July 5

University Grants Commission (UGC) has set NET, SET or SLET as the minimum criteria for the direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor for all Higher Education Institutions. In a notification, the UGC also stated that PhD qualification for appointment to the same post would be optional from this month



onwards. Earlier in 2021, the Commission announced that PhD was not mandatory for

Interview of Secretary (DM) broadcast through Akashvani Secretary highlights disaster preparedness in Isles to tackle any eventualities during disasters

Port Blair, July 5

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS has directed all Secretaries of the Departments concerned to give interviews in Akashvani Port Blair and Doordarshan (DD) and highlight the initiatives taken by the Departments involved in public delivery services to improve public delivery system, social infrastructure and social benefit schemes. As per the roster, the interview of Secretary (DM), Shri A.S.P.S. Raviprakash, IAS was broadcast through Akashvani Port Blair and the same is being reproduced in Q&A format for the wider reach of the people of A&N Islands.



Interviewer: Are Andaman and Nicobar Islands prone to Disasters?

Secretary (DM): Andaman and Nicobar Islands comes under seismic Zone-V and are prone to earthquakes. In the year 2022, a total of 45 earthquakes hit the Islands and the magnitude of which were 4.5 and above on Richter scale. This year, more than 20 earthquakes of the magnitude of 4.5 and above shook the Islands. The Andaman and Nicobar Islands is located in the Sunda Subduction Zone which is very vulnerable. The coast line of Andaman and Nicobar Islands is 1962 km, which is 1/4th of the total coast line of India, due to which there are chances of water related calamities in A&N Islands. There also exist the lone active volcano of India i.e. Barren Island. All these situations prompt us to keep our disaster preparedness and disaster management at the highest level.

Interviewer: How prepared is the Disaster Management Department to tackle natural calamities?

Secretary (DM): Disaster preparedness is vital for A&N Islands. The A&N Administration is putting its best efforts to equip the Disaster Management Department with best infrastructure. The Department is working 24x7 and the monitoring and operations is done round the clock. The Department has one State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) which functions 24x7 and is operational on all the 365 days. The SEOC gets all the information regarding the situations and events taking place and are being monitored promptly. Apart from the SEOC, the Department has 6 Emergency Operation Centres (EOCs) in different Islands which are manned by the staff 24x7 by alerting the general public from time to time. The Department is in active coordination with Andaman & Nicobar Command and NDRF. The Department has 40 Incident Response Teams involving all the Departments. The team consists of Government Officials working in different Departments in all the three Districts of A&N Islands. These teams are well trained and they have the Standard Operation Procedure (SOP) ready to tackle any emergency arising out of any natural

calamities. The Department is providing regular training to these Officials so that they can respond to any natural calamity without waiting for any instructions. These Officials have the SOPs based upon the nature of natural calamity which is also known as Disaster Management Plan. The role of each Official is specifically mentioned in the Disaster Management Plan, which has been prepared as per the guidelines of the NDMA. Regular review of the DM Plan is done by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration and Deputy Commissioners of the respective districts.

Interviewer: Elaborate on the communication network of the Disaster Management Department?

Secretary (DM): The Department is having the State of the Art Communication equipment besides 40 Satellite Phones. The Department is connected with MHA, NDMA and BSNL with 4 V-Sat which works even if the ordinary/normal network fails. It also has 9 hot lines which are used during emergencies. The disaster management issues alert warnings for thunderstorm, cyclone etc. received from NDMA, INCOIS. Subsequently, IMD Bulletins and warnings are issued for fishermen and farmers which are disseminated through our own network to those who are involved in Disaster Management. This is a continuous process of communication by the Department in the form of Press Releases and SMS. A review mechanism by the Secretaries of different Departments is also in place to tackle any untoward incidents during natural calamities. To ascertain the preparedness at highest level, mega mock drills are conducted once a year where mock Tsunami/ earthquake

situation is created. Observers/ consultants from NDMA, Delhi are appointed to monitor the mock drills and they suggest measures for further improvement as well as rectification of gaps noticed. This mock drill also help the Department to further improve its disaster mitigation system and the lesson learnt during mock drill. 35 GPS Observatory Centres are also being created to further strengthen the disaster preparedness. This automated early warning system triggers siren automatically. This will save many lives during natural calamities, as every second counts and time factor plays an important role in saving the lives of people. The Department is also setting up State of the Art Integrated Command Control Centre (ICCC). All the Control Rooms functioning in different Departments will come under one roof, once the ICCC starts functioning. This will help the Department to work in close coordination with all other Departments. The ICCC will come up at the newly built Disaster Management Bhawan which is expected to be functional by this year. The Department has also trained 300 Aapda Mitras and they help the Department during natural calamities. They are from the community and have all kinds of tools besides the required training imparted to them. These Aapda Mitras are also known as 'Community Volunteers'. These trained volunteers can play the role of leaders to help people during natural calamities. First Aid, protection and relief works are done by these Aapda Mitras and they are the immediate/ first responders during any natural calamities.

Interviewer: What measures have been adopted by the Disaster Management Department in creating awareness among the common people about disaster preparedness?

Secretary (DM): 'More awareness means more safety of the people'. With this motto, the Disaster Management Department creates awareness about the disaster preparedness among the general public and students as well. Each and every life is precious. If the community is aware, then many lives can be saved during natural calamities. The Department is making best efforts to create awareness among each and every individual including the student community. The Department has done an outstanding work by creating awareness among the entire population of Nicobar District including Campbell Bay. Our aim is to replicate the same in other two Districts of A&N Islands in terms of creating awareness. School safety programme has also been devised to create awareness among students. Higher Educational Institutes have also been covered under this initiative. Due to the better reach of the Self Help Groups (SHGs) in the community, efforts are on by the Department to reach out to the people through SHGs in creating awareness. Teachers, Engineers and people from all walks of life are being educated regarding disaster preparedness. Aapda Mitras have also been roped in for creating awareness among communities. One training programme by Aapda Mitras is currently underway at Nicobar and such training will be very helpful in disaster preparedness.

Interviewer: What message would you like to convey to the people of A&N Islands?

Secretary (DM): One cannot do much post disaster, however, if a person is well prepared to face natural calamities, then loss of life and property can be minimized. A little preparation such as keeping first aid boxes, maintaining patience and an attitude of compassion for others will be of great help to tackle disasters. Helping the Disaster Management Officials, listening to the alerts being broadcast through Radio and following the directions of the State Government for the relief of the people is very essential during natural calamities.
