New Delhi, July 8 (PIB) One District One Product (ODOP) programme under Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry collaborated with an e-commerce player, Groyyo to onboard aggregators selling ODOP-identified products on its platform consisting of several categories such as home textiles, home décor etc. The tagging on this one-stop online platform is intended to strengthen each district's identity, while giving a greater visibility to ODOP products. 20 % ethanol blended petrol, E20 to be available across the country by 2025: Minister

New Delhi, July 8

Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri has said that 20 percent ethanol blended petrol, E20, will be available across India by 2025. Addressing the AGM of Indian Merchants Chambers virtually yesterday, Shri Puri said the first E20 special fuel outlet was opened in February this year, following which the number has already crossed 600 and such stations will be available across the country by 2025.

The Minister informed that ethanol blending in petrol has gone up from 38 crore litres in 2013-14 to 433 crore litres in 2021-22. Shri Puri further informed that the number of fuel stations selling biofuels has increased from close to thirty thousand in 2016-17 to more than 67,640.



The Minister said, India has witnessed growth across every sector in the past nine years. He said, a growth-energy correlation is manifestly visible as the country now stands as the world's third largest energy

59818 persons insured under PMJJBY in A&N Islands 60 claims settled disbursing an amount of Rs. 120 lakhs to insured persons

Port Blair, July 8

The Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) is available to people in the age group of 18 to 50 years having a bank account who give their consent to join/enable auto-debit. Life cover of Rs. 2 lakh shall be for the one year period stretching from 1st June to 31st May and is renewable. Risk coverage under this scheme is for Rs. 2 Lakh in case of death of the insured, due to any reason.

As per the data provided by the Lead



Bank Port Blair, altogether, 59,818 persons have been enrolled under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) in these Islands as on June 30, 2023. A total of 62 claims have been received under this insurance scheme, out of which, 60 claims were settled while two claims have been rejected. Of the 60 claims settled, Rs. 120 lakh were disbursed to 60 insured persons (Rs. 2 lakh for each claim).

As per the salient features of the scheme, premium of Rs. 436 per annum will be auto-debited in one installment from the subscriber's bank account as per the option given by him on or before 31st May of each annual coverage period under the scheme. The scheme is being offered by Life Insurance Corporation and all other life insurers who are willing to offer the product on similar terms with necessary approvals and tie up with banks for this purpose.

IMO Level-I Training conducted by Pollution Response Team for CG personnel & stakeholders

Port Blair, July 8

Indian Coast Guard Component of ANC conducted an IMO Level-I course for various stakeholders responsible for Pollution Response Operations in the A & N Islands. The course was conducted by Coast Guard Pollution Response Team (A & N) from July 3 to 7, 2023 at Port Blair. The Indian Coast Guard (ICG), being the Central Coordinating Agency for combating oil pollution in the



Maritime Zones of India, conducts the course in line with the guidelines of OPRC Convention 1992 to which India is a signatory. Any oil spill in the seas around the A &

N Islands will have severe environmental impact on the pristine marine ecosystem and would adversely affect the dependent economic/ tourism activities. Accordingly,

the IMO level courses are structured and conducted by the Indian Coast Guard to provide effective training to all stakeholders for coordinated response operations against any marine oil spills at sea.

Biotech Startups are crucial to India's future economy: S&T Minister

India has huge wealth of bio-resources from the Himalayas to the oceans

New Delhi, July 8

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology, MoS PMO, Department of Atomic Energy and Department of Space and MoS Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr Jitendra Singh has said that the Biotech StartUps are crucial to India's future economy. "We had just about 50 Biotech Startups 8 to 9 years back, now we have around 6,000, so, I think, we still need to have more," said Dr Jitendra Singh, inaugurating a discussion meeting for fostering Biomanufacturing Initiative of the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), in New Delhi.

Dr Jitendra Singh said, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi awakened India to the merits and huge potential of Biotechnology in this country. "India's bioeconomy was just about \$8 Billion in 2014 and now under Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi we have at least awakened to the merits of Biotechnology and Bioeconomy. it has grown up to \$100



Billion, now we are targeting \$150 Billion by 2025. This is going to be the 'future value addition' to India's economy in the years to come," he said, adding, "We rank 12th in the world, 3rd in the Asia Pacific as far as bioeconomy is concerned and rank One in vaccine production."

The Science & Technology Minister said Biotechnology has the potential to become an instrument of global trade. "India has a huge wealth of bioresources, an unsaturated resource waiting to be harnessed and an advantage in Biotechnology especially due to the vast biodiversity and the unique bioresources in the Himalayas. Then there is the 7,500 kms long coastline and last year we launched the Samudrayaan which is going to dig the biodiversity beneath the

seas," he said. Dr Jitendra Singh said, Biotechnology has emerged as a trending career option among the youth. In a recent survey of Class 12 students in Delhi it was found that Biotechnology was ranked as the preferred stream at No.4/5 whereas earlier it didn't figure anywhere as a career option, he said.

"So this is something not widely known, and that's also the reason it took us so much of time to attract young minds into it," said Dr Jitendra Singh. "Tools like synthetic technology, genome editing, microbial bioresources and metabolic engineering are now talked about more often, particularly when we linked it (genetic engineering) with the management of diseases, people got more enthusiastic," he added.

Fares of AC chair car, executive classes of all trains, including Vande Bharat, to be reduced by up to 25 %: Ministry of Railways

New Delhi, July 8

The Ministry of Railways today announced that fares of AC chair car, and executive classes of all trains, including Vande Bharat, will be reduced by up to 25 percent. It said the decision is part of a discounted farescheme in trains that saw below-50 percent occupancy during the last 30 days.

With a view to optimise accommodation in trains, the Ministry said it has decided to delegate powers to Zonal Railways to introduce discounted fare scheme in trains with AC sitting accommodation. This scheme shall be applicable in AC Chair Car and Executive classes of all trains having AC sitting accommodation including Anubhuti and Vistadome coaches.

The element of discount shall be upto a maximum 25 percent on



the basic fare. Other charges like reservation charge, Super fast surcharge, GST, etc as applicable, shall be levied separately. The discount may be provided in any or all the classes on the basis of occupancy. The Ministry said the discount shall be implemented with immediate effect.

However, no refund of fare shall be admissible for already booked passengers. In case of those trains where the flexi fare scheme is applicable in a particular class and the occupancy is poor, flexi fare scheme

may be withdrawn initially as a measure to increase the occupancy. Tatkal quota shall not be earmarked in such trains for the decided period in case the discount is provided on end to end basis. Further, if the discount is provided for the part journey of the train, then Tatkal quota may not be provided for the part of the journey where the discount is given. This scheme will not be applicable on special trains introduced as holiday or festival specials etc. (Source: india.gov.in)

Port Blair, July 8

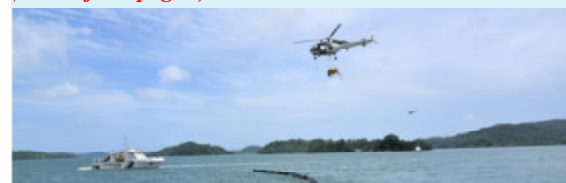

District Police of N & M Andaman conducts raids against illicit IMFL & liquor

Mayabunder, July 8

Continuing its crackdown on the illicit liquor, handia, & illegal sale of IMFL, the District Police of North & Middle Andaman with the help of local informers conducted regular raids and searches in jungles. During the month of June, 2023, the teams of various Police Stations, headed by SHOs and Sub-Inspectors conducted raids & massive jungle search

operation. In these search operations, around 25 litres of illicit liquor & 40 Kgs handia were destroyed and also 57 Nos. 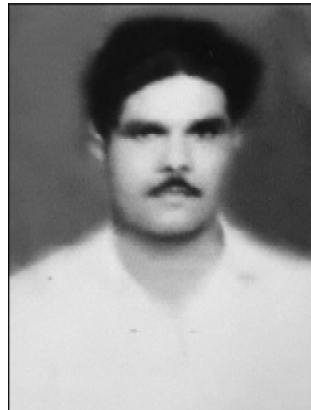
