have also been asked to get their names enrolled immediately.

## Soil Health Card- addressing nutrient deficiencies in soil 3430 Soil Health Cards issued to farmers under UT Plan during 2022-23

### Farmers urged to get their soil assessed for issuance of Soil Health Card

Port Blair, Feb. 19

In the absence of scientific analysis of soil, blindfolded applications of fertilizer and growth supporters have been used on the farm lands. This not only results in unwanted expenditure for the farmers but also affects the soil health negatively. To address this problem, the Soil Health Card Scheme was launched by the Prime Minister on 19th of Feb, 2015 and is being implemented under Rashtriya

Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare. The main objective of this programme is to issue Soil Health Cards in every two years to all farmers, so as to provide a basis to address nutrient deficiencies in fertilizer application practices



besides it also aims to promote Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) through judicious use of chemical fertilizers including secondary and micro nutrients in conjunction with organic manures and bio-fertilizers for improving soil health and its productivity.

and pH, Electrical Conductivity (EC) & Organic Carbon(OC) (Physical parameters).

Based on these parameters, suitable fertilizer recommendations both in organic and inorganic forms and soil amendment required for the cultivable area is also indicated. A total of 3430 Soil Health Cards have been issued to the farmers under UT Plan during 2022-23(till date).

Timely application of all essential plant nutrients in readily available form, in optimum quantities and in the right proportion suitable for specific soil /crop condition is the prime objective of issuing Soil Health Cards to farmers. (Contd. on last page)

Accordingly, farmers were made aware through various farmer/field oriented activities under Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA) on balanced and efficient use of locally available nutrient sources from both Organic and in-organic forms at Farm and Community levels rather than dependence on Chemical fertilizers.

Farmers have been requested to use Organic manures, Bio-fertilizers, Farm Yard Manure and decomposed farm wastes for cultivation aspects to improve soil health and its fertility thereby ensuring adequate availability of nutrients in soils to meet the requirement of plants at critical stages of growth and to enhance soil microbial activity in abundance.

Farmers have been requested to contact the Assistant Director (Agri.)/Assistant Director (Soil) through the concerned Circle in-charge/Sub Depot in-charge of their respective areas to get their soil of farming area collected and analyzed in order to obtain the Soil Health Card with proper recommendation periodically, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

## India wins second test of Border Gavaskar trophy against Australia in New Delhi

New Delhi, Feb. 19

In Cricket, a career-best spell by Ravindra Jadeja has led India to win the second test of the Border Gavaskar Trophy against Australia in New Delhi.

The hosts have now taken a 2-0 lead in the four-match series, beating the visitors by 6 wickets in the second test in the four match series of the Trophy at Arun Jaitley Stadium today. India scored 118 runs. This is the second time in a row that India have beaten Australia in a Test match within three days. With the win, India have retained the Trophy. India all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja took 10 wickets in the match. He was



declared Man of the match.

Australia was all out for 113 runs in their second innings, setting India a victory target of 115. For India, spinner Ravindra Jadeja (7-42) took his career's best and devastated Australia. Between Ravindra Jadeja (7-42) and

Ravichandran Ashwin (3-59), the spinners shared the 10 wickets putting Australia on a sticky wicket. Australia suffered another embarrassing collapse losing nine wickets for 52 runs to all. With this, there is little hope that it had of a rare victory on Indian soil.

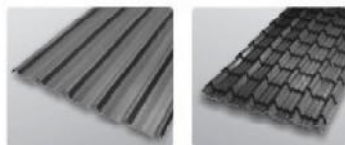

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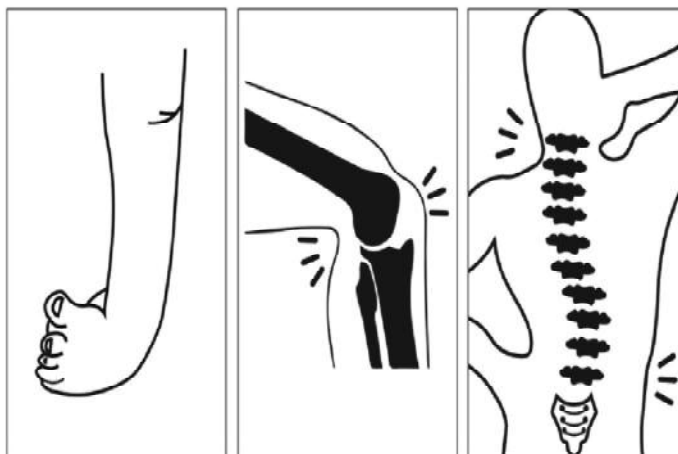

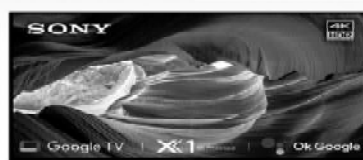
