Electricity Department appeals to electricity consumers of Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman to use power judiciously

Usage of major power guzzlers like ACs, Motors, OTGs, Geysers, Garden lighting may be avoided during evening peak hours

Port Blair, April 4

It is brought to the kind notice of general public that due to increase in ambient temperature, there has been a substantial increase in power demand which has created a shortage of power during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman. All the consumers of Electricity Department have been advised to use the available energy judiciously in view of shortage of power particularly during the evening peak hours.

Further, it is also requested that usage of major power guzzlers like ACs, Motors, OTGs, Geysers, Garden lighting may kindly be avoided during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM. This would help the Department to maintain power supply in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman without curtailment. The Electricity Department will be closely monitoring for the compliance of above by conducting surprise checks to ensure effective Demand Side Management by all consumers, a press release from SE, Electricity Department said.

Under Jan Shikshan Sansthans priorities are given to women, SC, ST, and OBC sections: Govt.

New Delhi, April 4 Minister of State Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Shri Rajeev Chandrasekhar has said that currently 288 Jan Shikshan Sansthans JSSs are functional in the country. In a written reply in the Lok Sabha, the Minister said the Ministry is implementing the scheme through the agencies to impart skill training to the non-literate persons with a rudimentary level of education, and school dropouts in the age group of 14-45 years, in the rural and urban slums. Under this scheme, priorities are given to women, SC, ST, minorities and other backward sections of society.
