## 59 per cent of India's land mass is prone to earthquakes of different intensities: Minister National Centre for Seismology plans to install Earthquake early warning systems in targeted areas

New Delhi, April 5  
Minister for Earth Sciences, Dr. Jitendra Singh has said that considering the recorded history of earthquakes in the country, 59 per cent of the land mass is prone to earthquakes of different intensities. In a written reply in Lok Sabha, the Minister said that presently, no proven system exists in the country to provide early warning of earthquakes. He said, there is no scientific technique available anywhere in the world to predict an earthquake precisely in terms of time, location and its magnitude.



However, the National Centre for Seismology NCS is planning to install Earthquake early warning systems in the targeted areas, initially in the Himalayas as a pilot project. He said, National

Disaster Management Authority has been conducting regular awareness campaigns every year. The Minister said the Bureau of Indian Standards, Building Materials and Technology Promotion Council and Housing and Urban Development Corporation has issued guidelines for the design and construction of earthquake-resistant structures to minimize the life and damage to property caused by the earthquake. ## Coastal Aquaculture Authority (Amendment) Bill 2023 introduced in Lok Sabha

New Delhi, April 5  
The Coastal Aquaculture Authority (Amendment) Bill 2023 was introduced in the Lok Sabha today. The Bill was introduced by Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Minister, Shri Parshottam Rupala which seeks to amend the Coastal Aquaculture Authority Act 2005.

The Bill seeks to decriminalise the offences under the Act for promoting ease of doing business and to fine-tune the operational

procedures of the Coastal Aquaculture Authority. It also aimed at promoting newer forms of environment-friendly coastal aquaculture including cage culture, seaweed culture, marine ornamental fish culture and pearl oyster culture which has the potential for

creating additional employment opportunities. The Bill also has a provision to prevent the use of antibiotics and pharmacologically active substances which are harmful to human health in coastal aquaculture. (Source: india.gov.in)

It is brought to the kind notice of general public that due to increase in ambient temperature, there has been a substantial increase in power demand which has created a shortage of power during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman. All the consumers of Electricity Department have been advised to use the available energy judiciously in view of shortage of power particularly during the evening peak hours.

Further, it is also requested that usage of major power guzzlers like ACs, Motors, OTGs, Geysers, Garden lighting may kindly be avoided during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM. This would help the Department to maintain power supply in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman without curtailment. The Electricity Department will be closely monitoring for the compliance of above by conducting surprise checks to ensure effective Demand Side Management by all consumers, a press release from SE, Electricity Department said.

New Delhi, April 5 Education, Dr. Higher Education. The Education Subhash Sarkar The Minister Ministry today said under the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 it has fixed a target of 50 per cent Gross Enrolment Ratio in Higher Education by 2035. In a written reply to a question in Rajya Sabha, Minister of State for Education, Dr. Subhash Sarkar informed that to achieve this significant target various steps are being taken like new regulations for open and distance learning programmes and online learning programmes to good quality education. Govt. to invite bids for 50 GW of renewable energy capacity annually for next five years

New Delhi, April 5 The Government has decided to invite bids for 50 GW of renewable energy capacity annually for the next five years. These annual bids of ISTS (Inter-State Transmission) connected renewable energy capacity will also include setting up of wind power capacity of at least 10 GW per annum. The plan was finalised by the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) at a meeting chaired by Union Minister for Power, Shri R. K. Singh last week. The bid was invited in accordance with the Prime Minister's announcement at COP26, of achieving 500 GW of installed electricity capacity from non-fossil fuel sources by 2030. Speaking during the meeting, Shri R. K. Singh, said that the declaration of the trajectory of short-term and long-term RE capacity addition by the Government is a significant step towards achieving the goal of 500 GW of non-fossil fuel capacity by 2030. He said that India has emerged as one of the world leaders in Energy Transition and this is evident in the growth that we have achieved in the area of Renewable Energy. Shri Singh added that the Government is committed to achieve 500 GW of target by 2030 and the bidding trajectory will provide a further stimulus towards this. India currently has a total renewable energy capacity of 168.96 GW with about 82 GW at various stages of implementation and about 41 GW under tendering stage. This includes 64.38 GW of Solar Power, 51.79 GW of Hydro Power, 42.02 GW of Wind Power and 10.77 GW of Bio Power. (Source: india.gov.in)
